



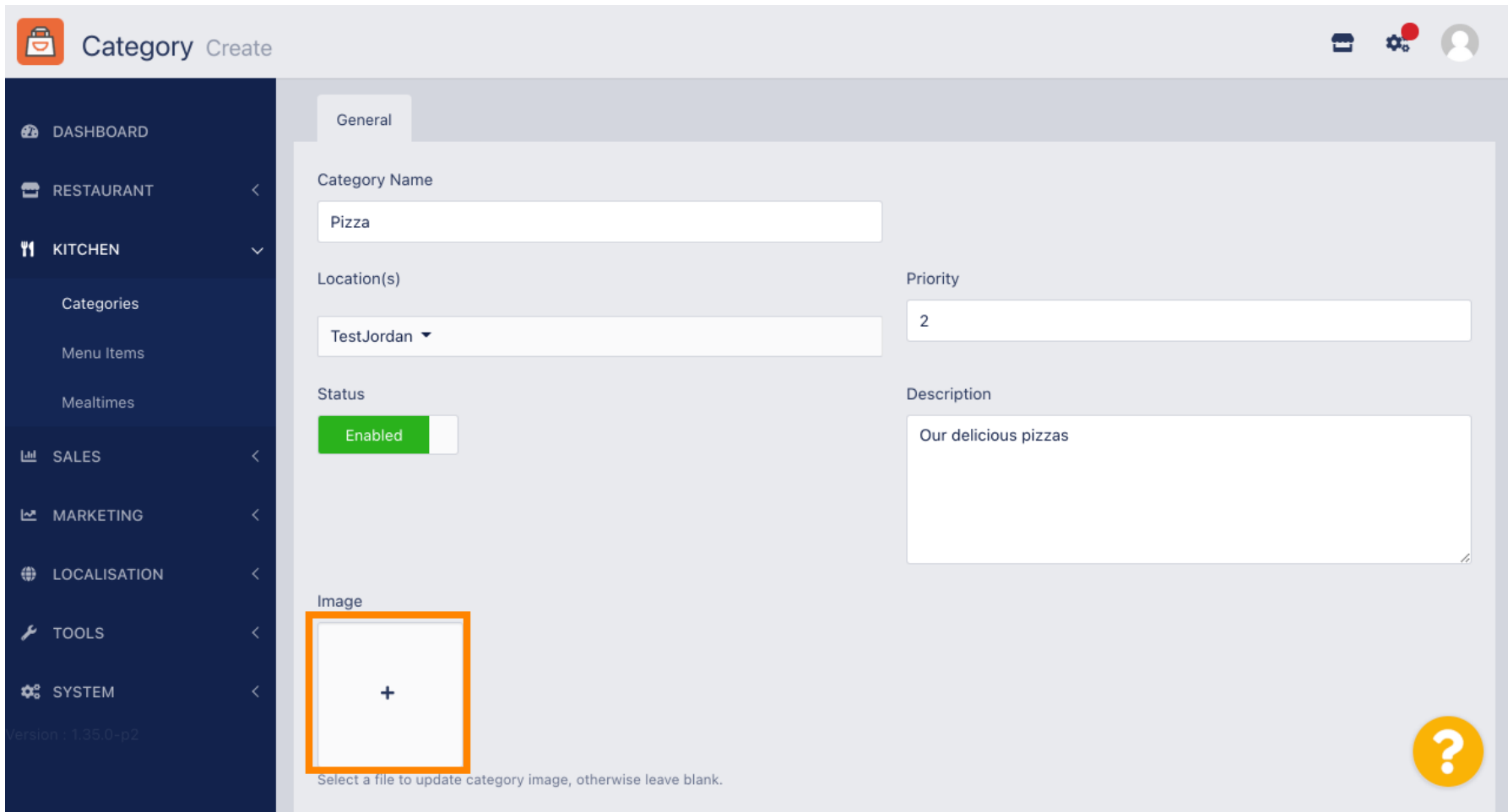

To assign an image to the category click on the empty square with the plus icon. **Note: Before assigning an image to the category the category has to be saved beforehand.**

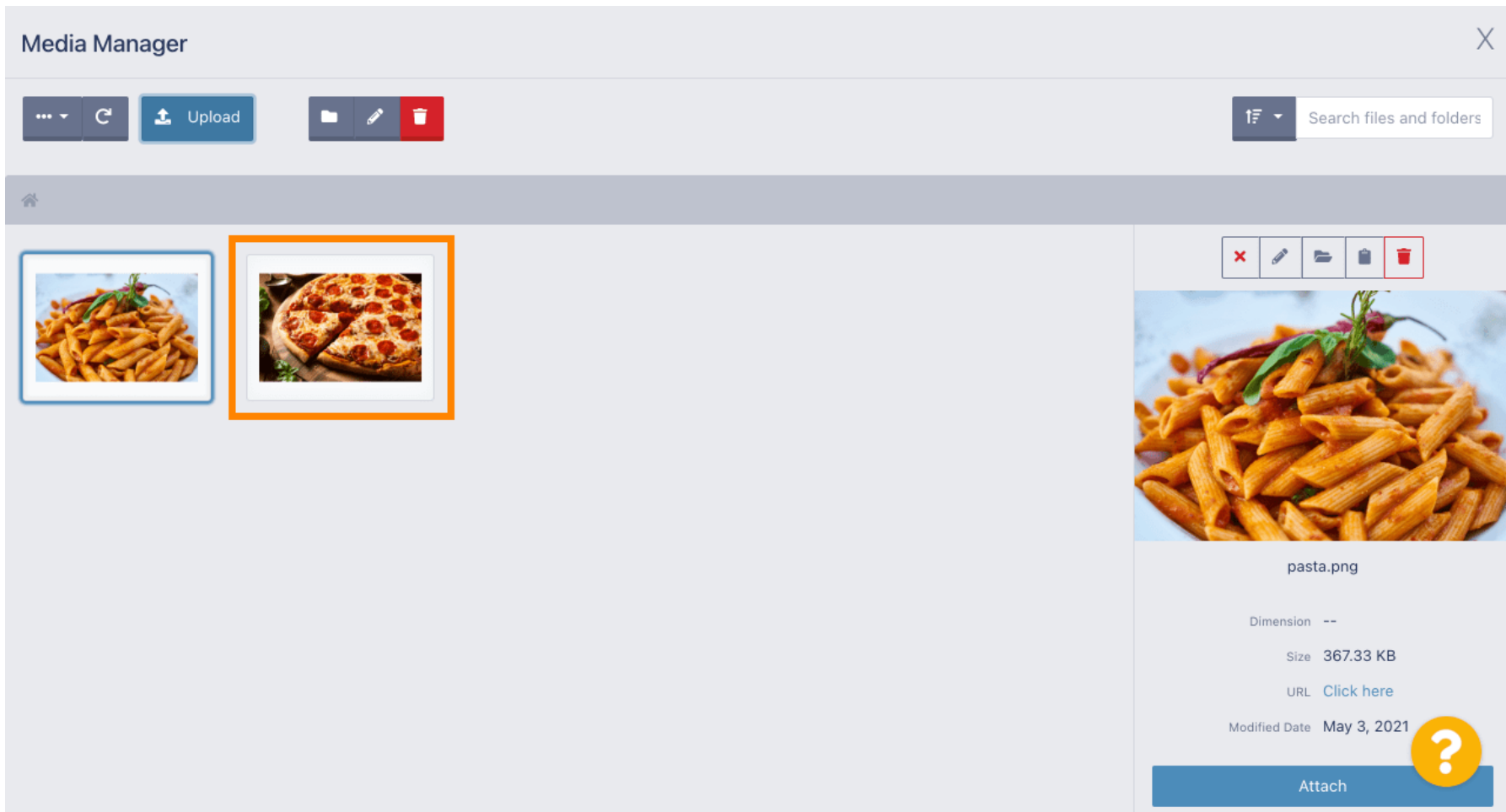


You are now in the media manager where you have access to your already uploaded images. To add a new image click on **upload**. **Note: Your file explorer will open up and you have to select an image.**

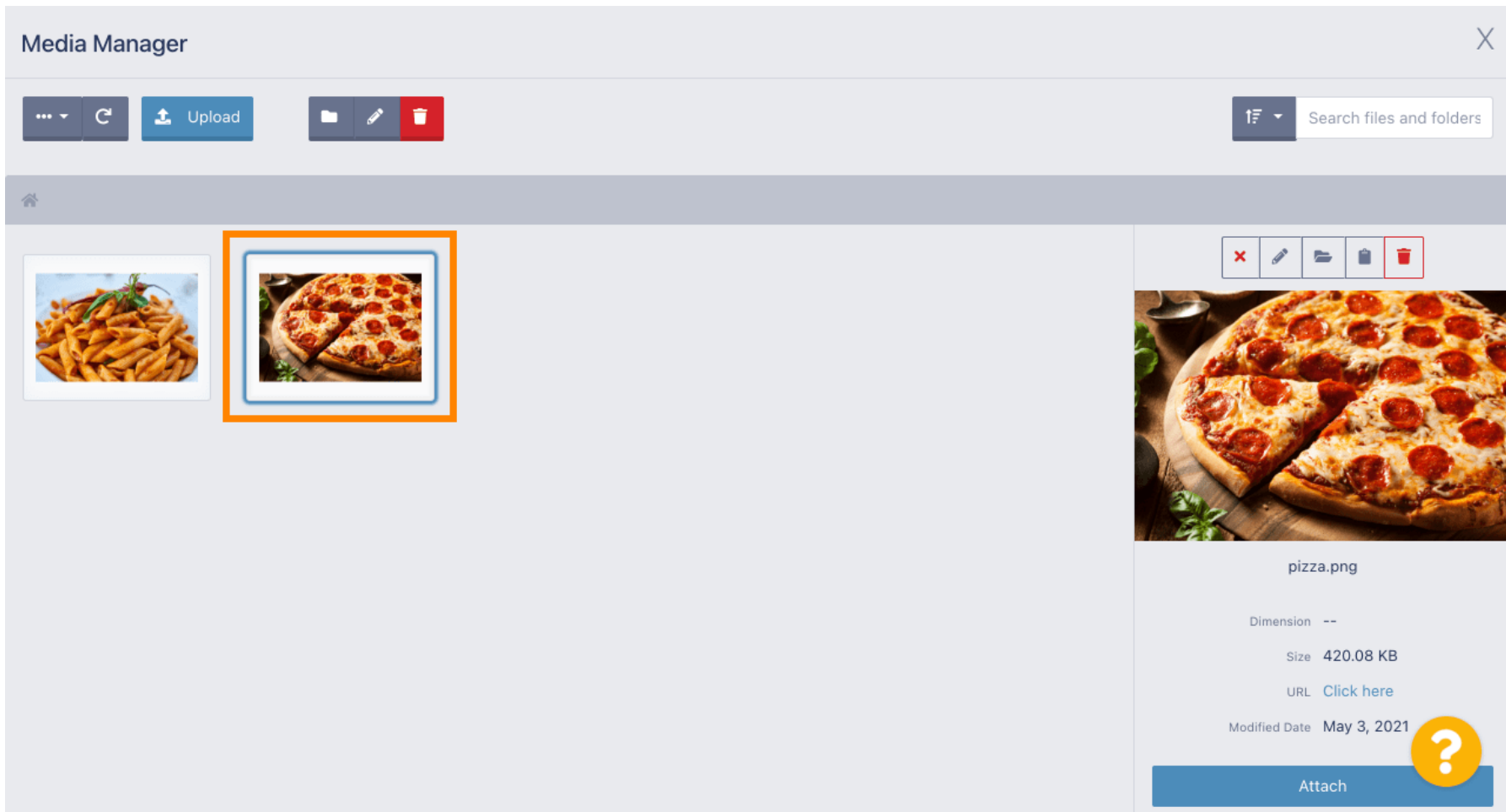




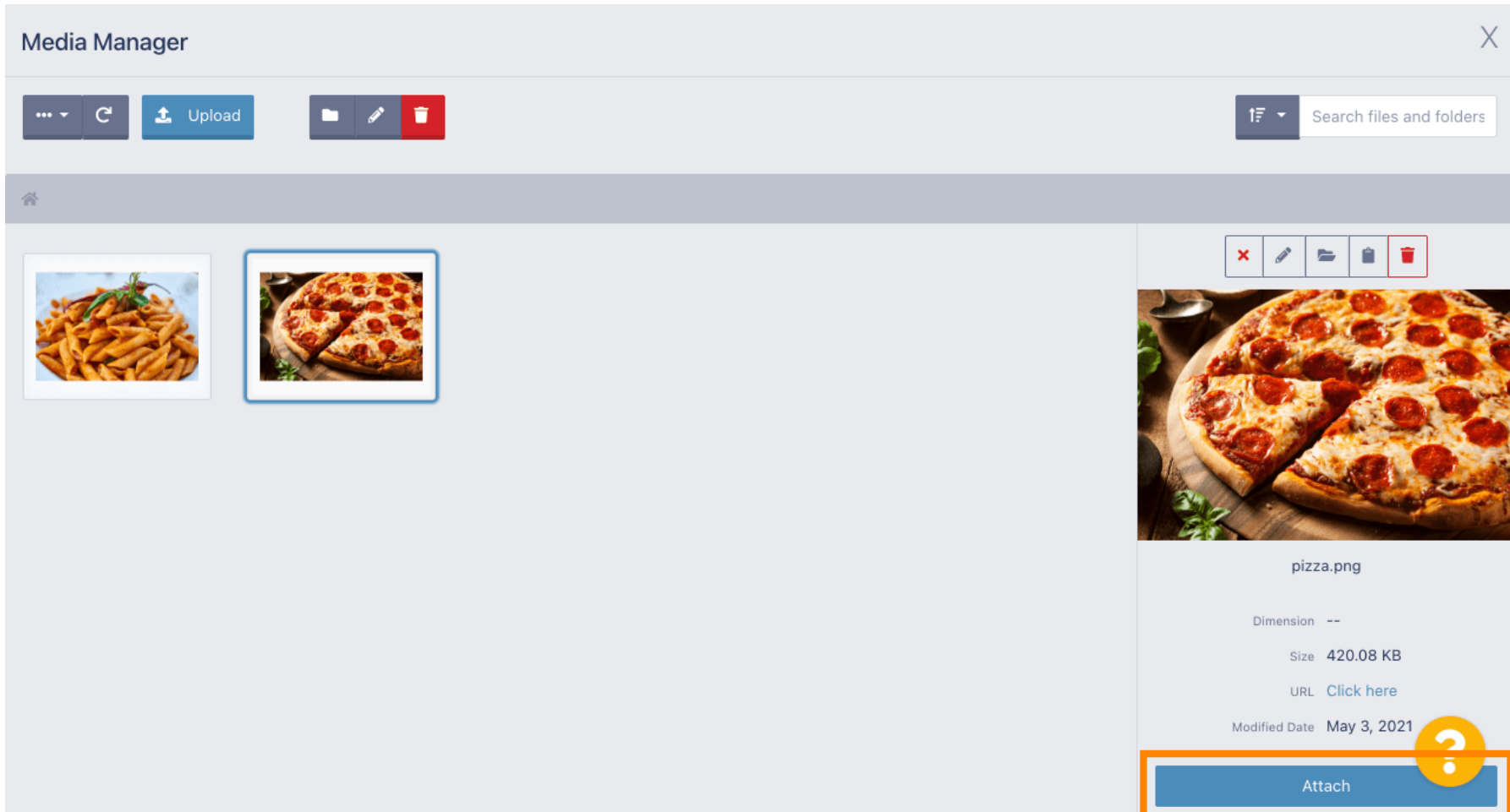
Once you selected your image from you file explorer it will be displayed in the media manager. **Note: For the best outcome we suggest an image with size of 690 x 80 pixels.**




Now click on the **image** to select it. **Note: The blue frame around the image indicates that you have selected that image.**
