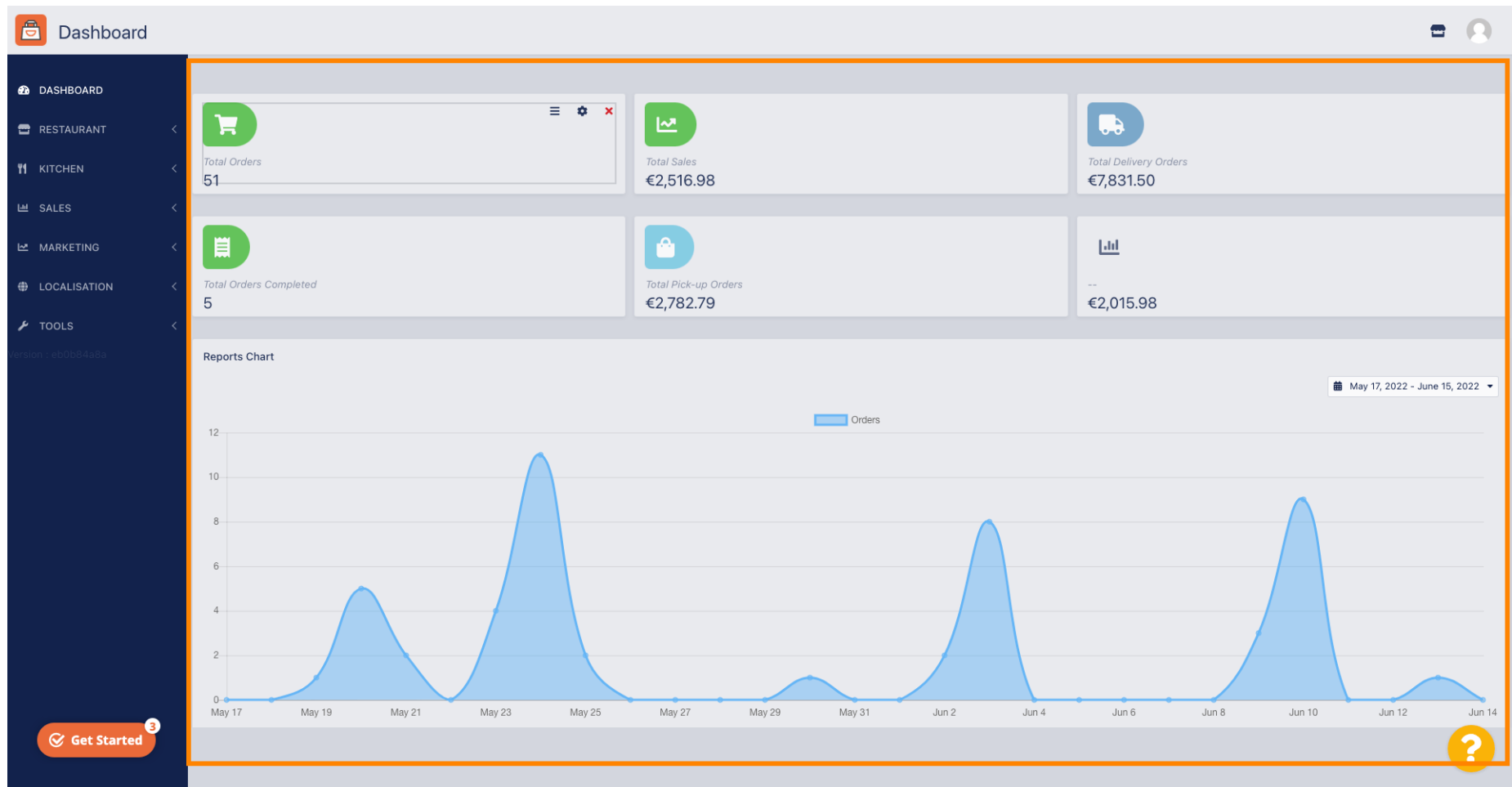


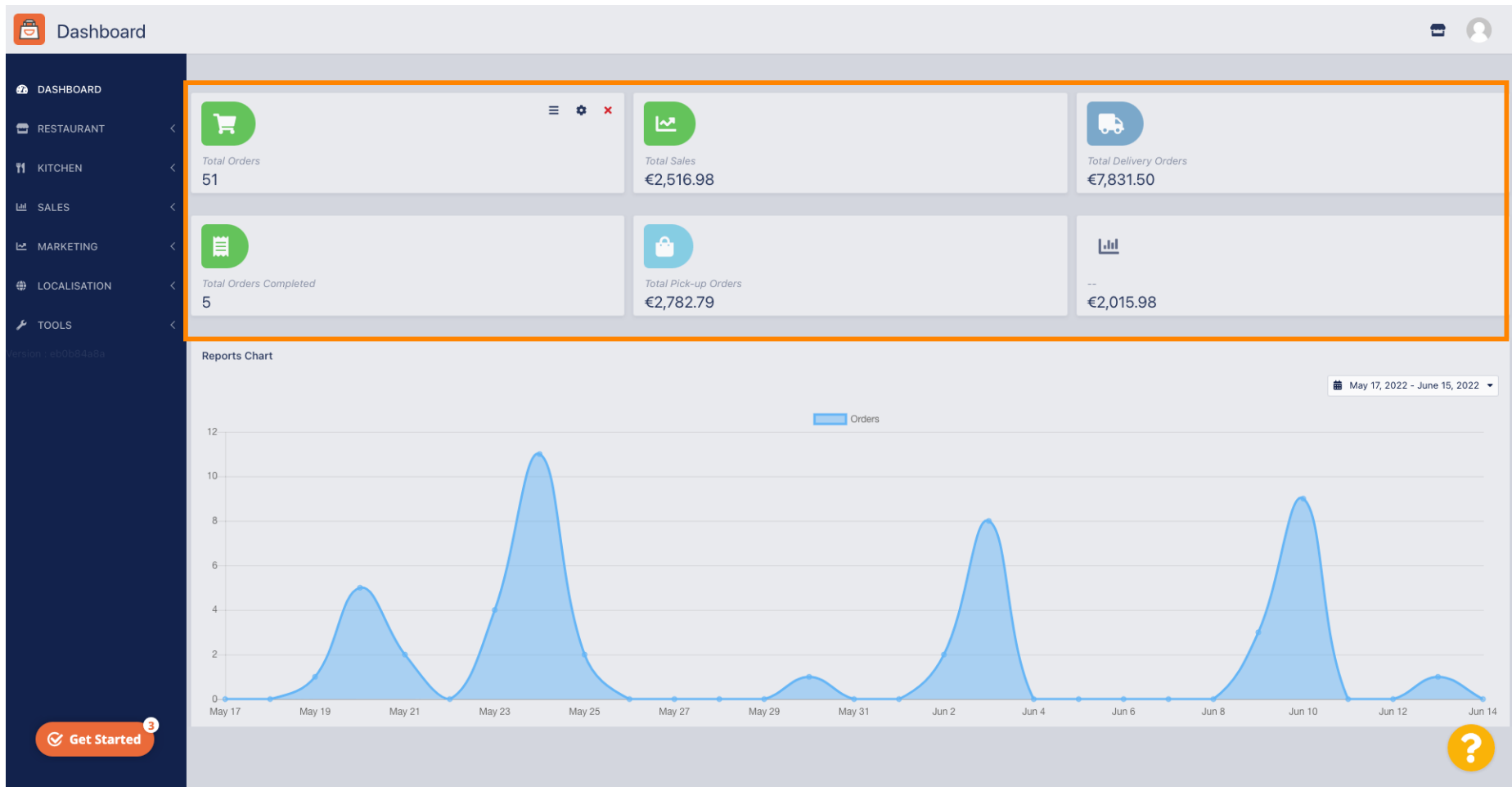


Welcome to the DISH Order dashboard. Here you can see information regarding to your orders. Presented in different widgets.



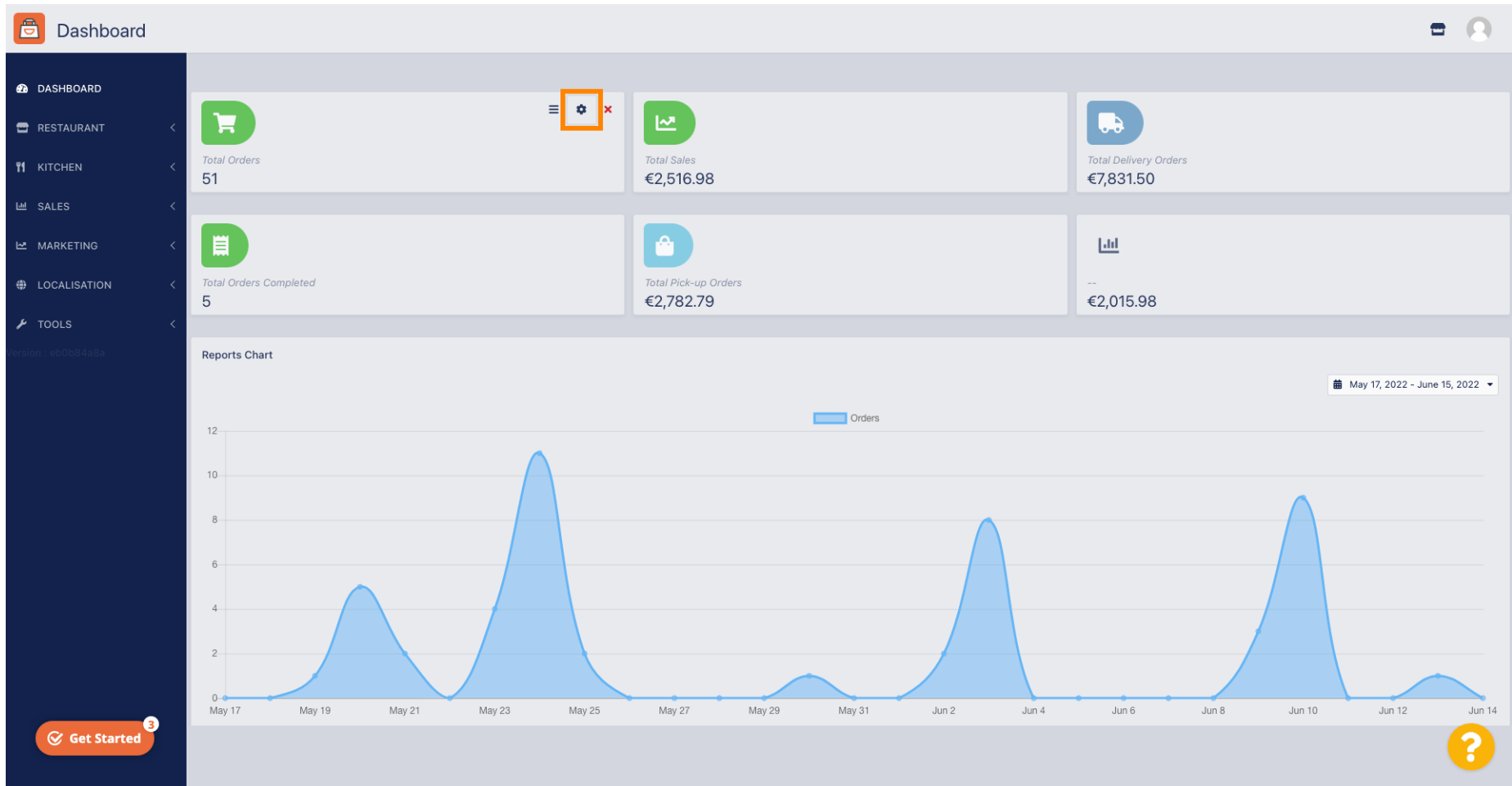


On the dashboard widgets are represented that gives you important information about the order activities of your restaurant.

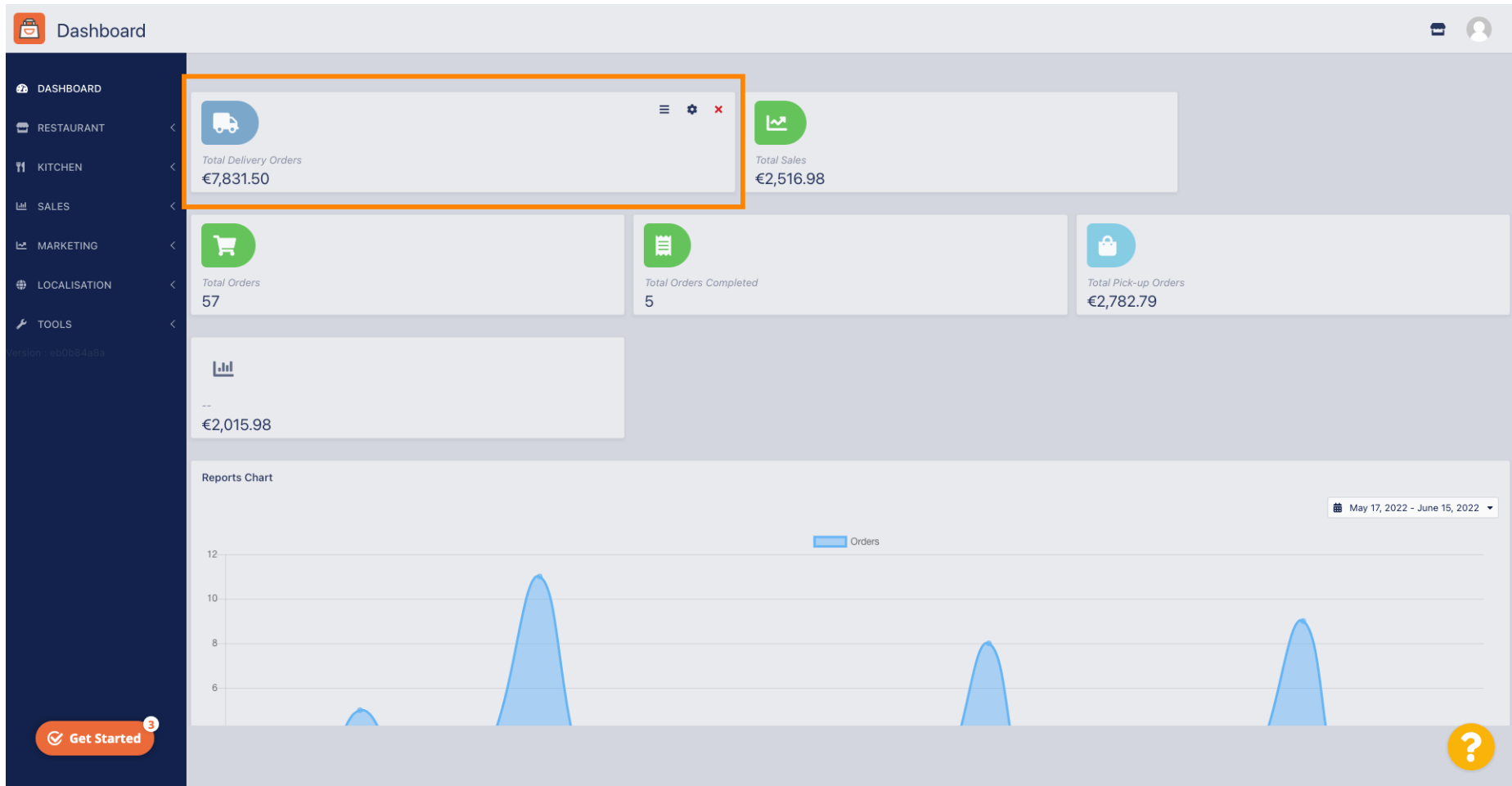

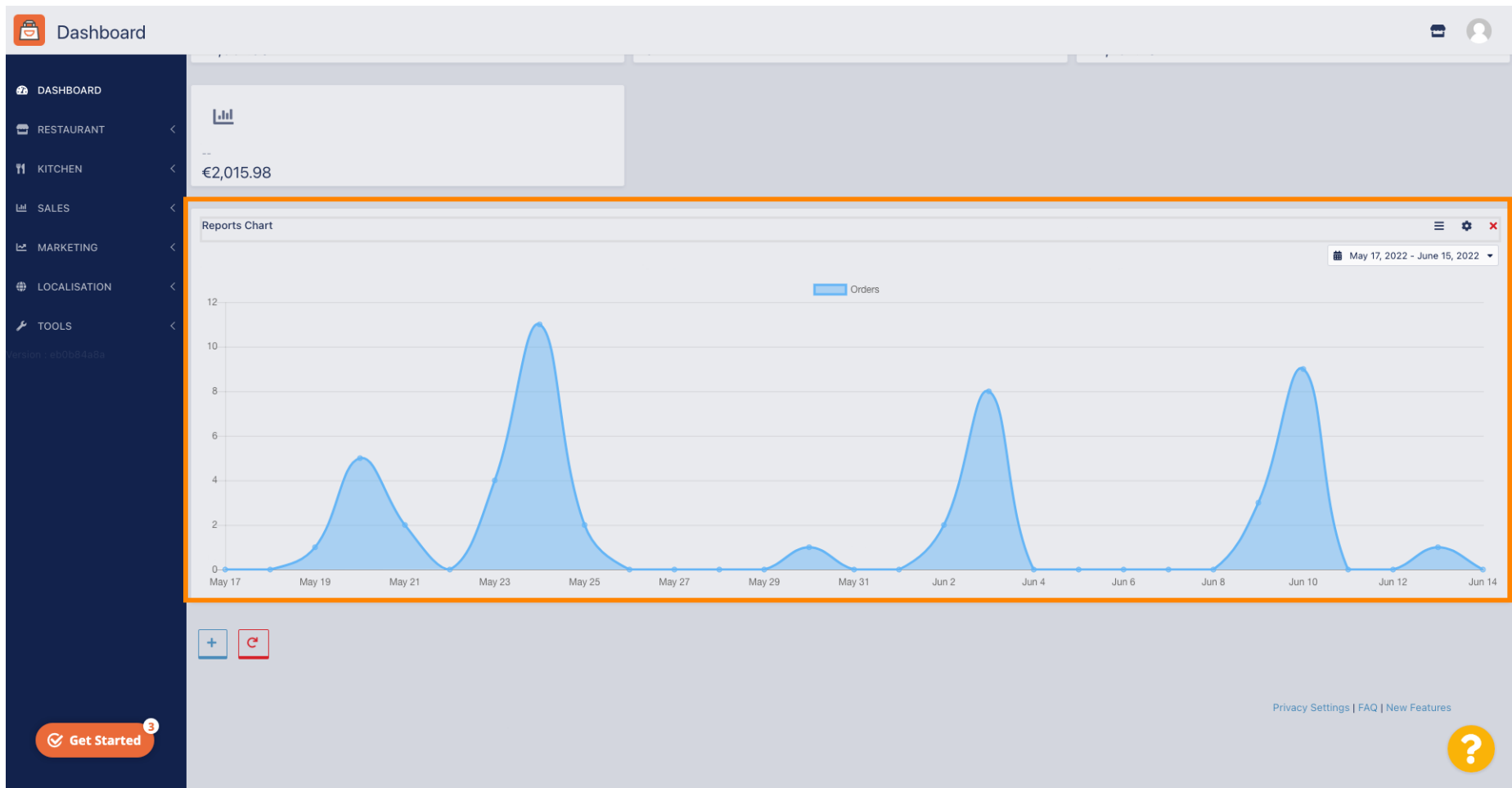

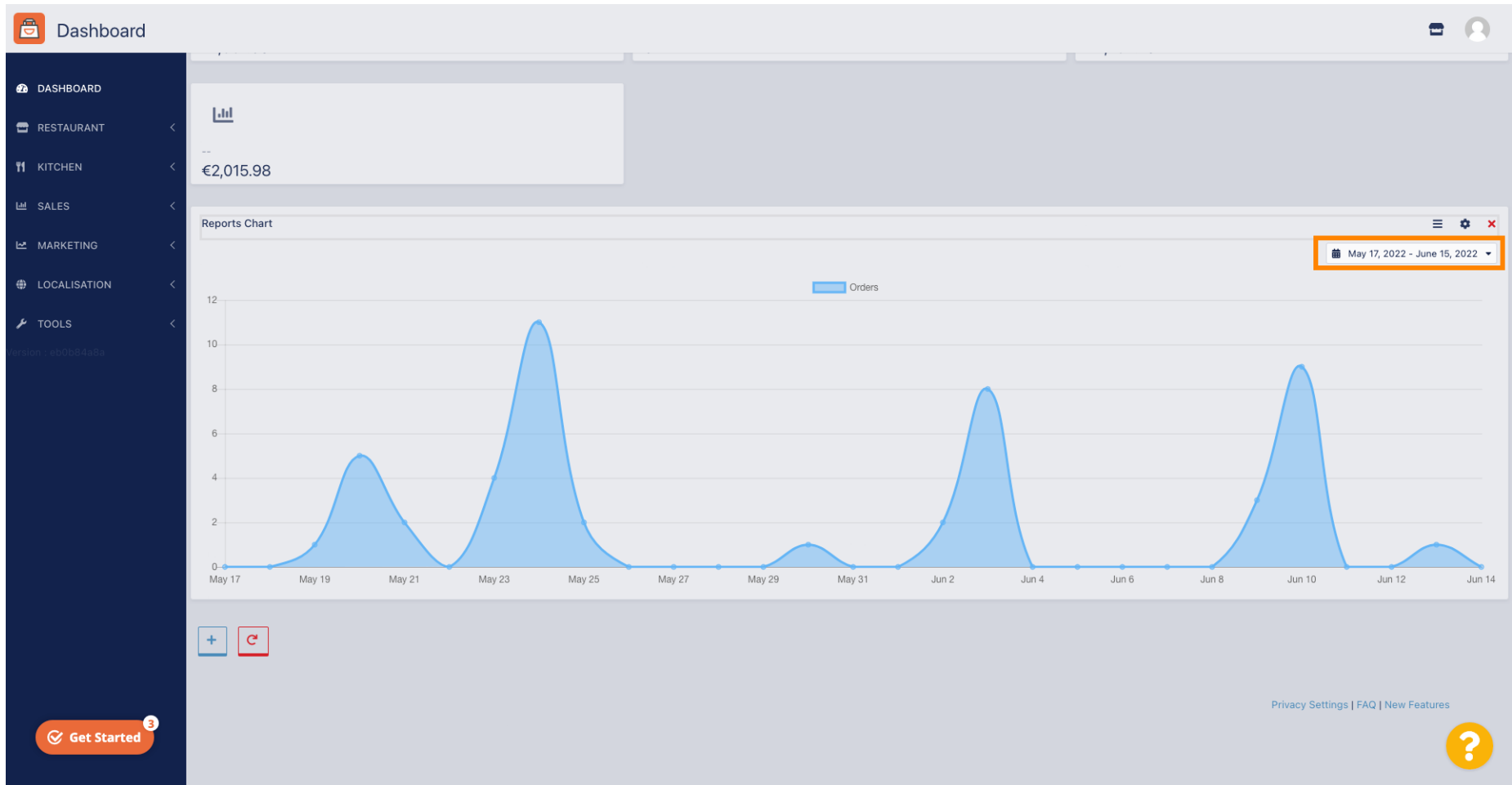




As well reports chart are available on your dashboard, that gives you a visual overview of all the orders in your restaurant in a certain period of time.



Click on the field to select the period of time you want to have a look at.





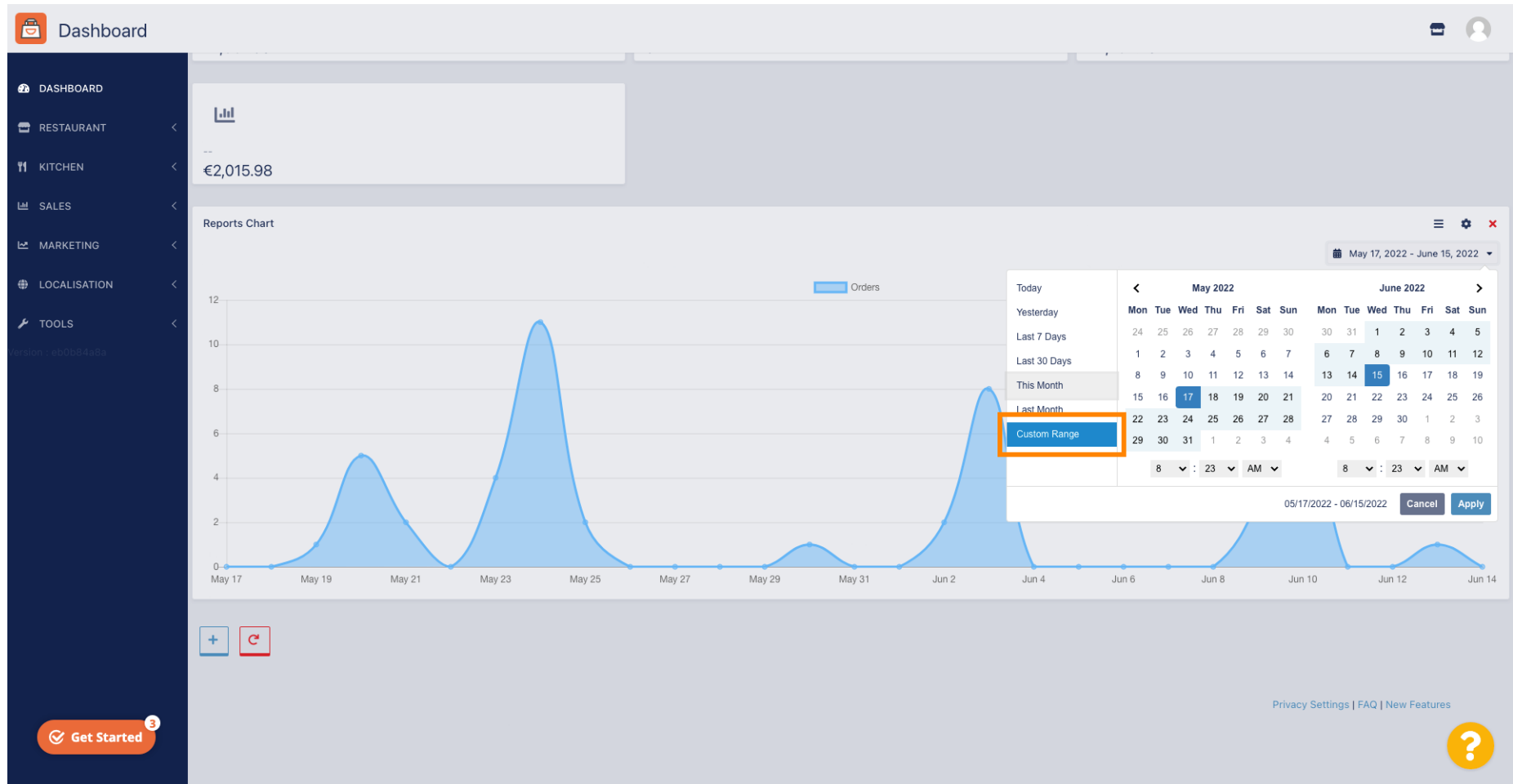

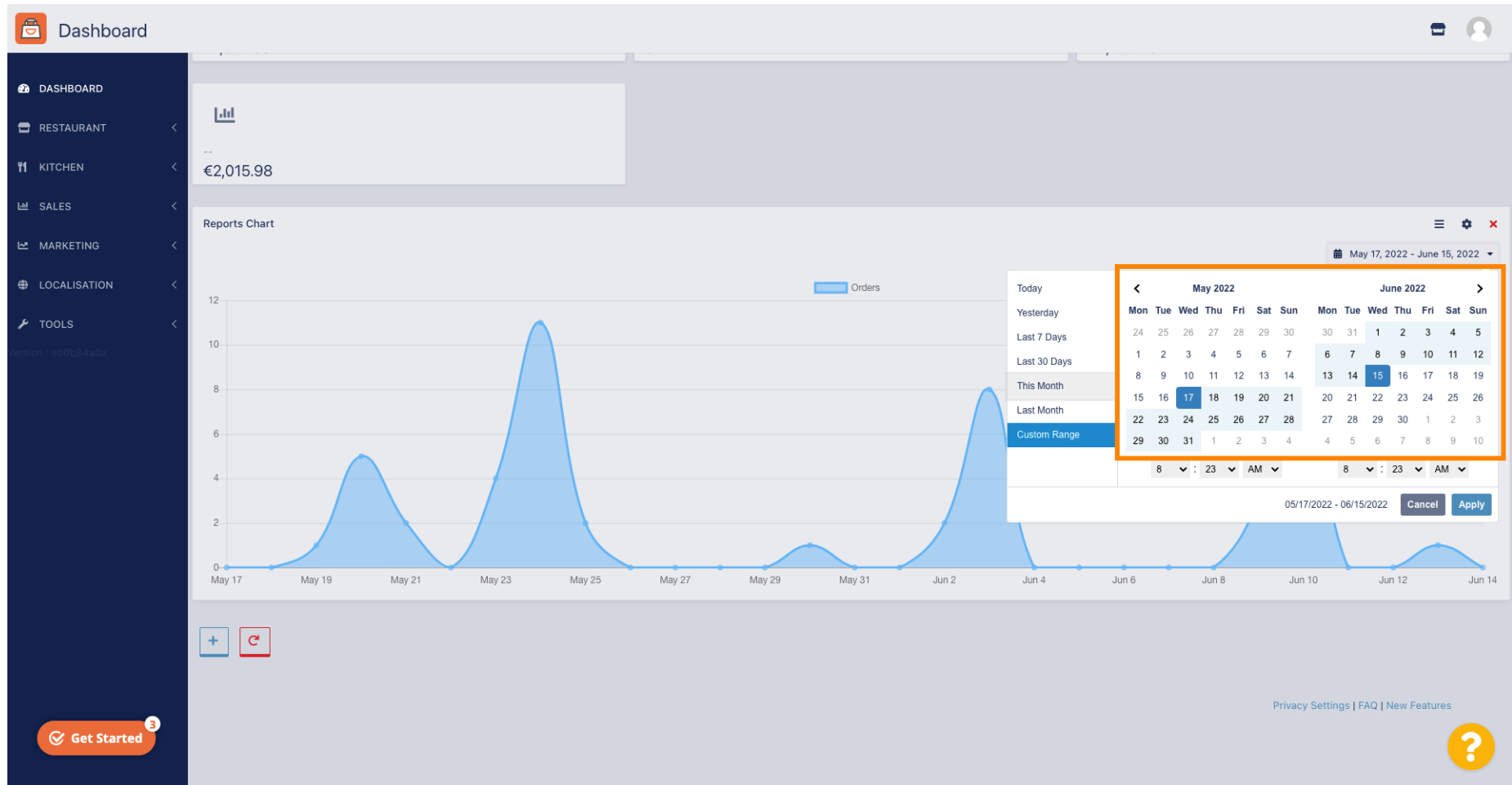

If you want to have a look about the information of an individual time span, click on **Custom Range**.

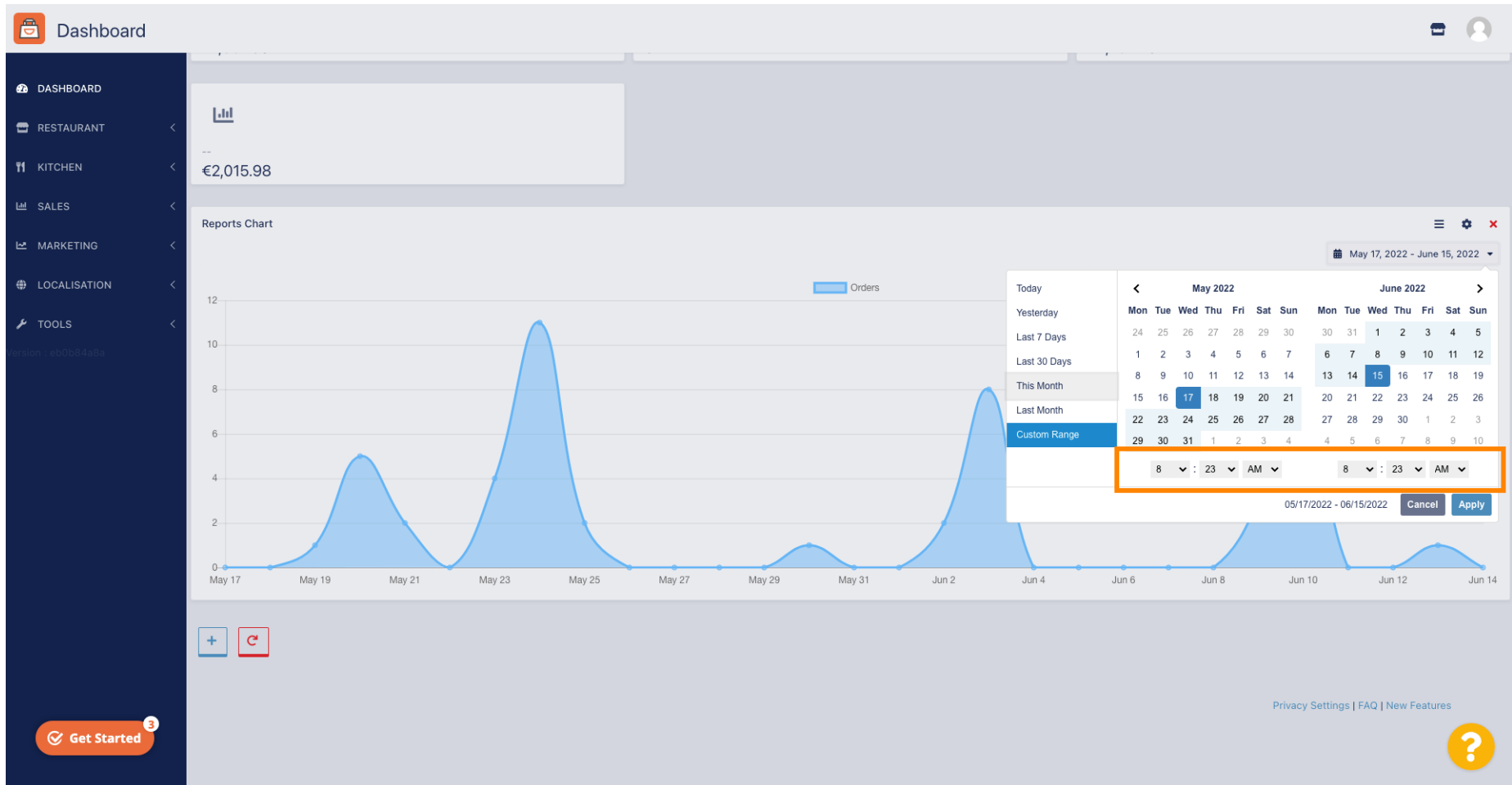


Select the the beginning und the end of that individual time span.



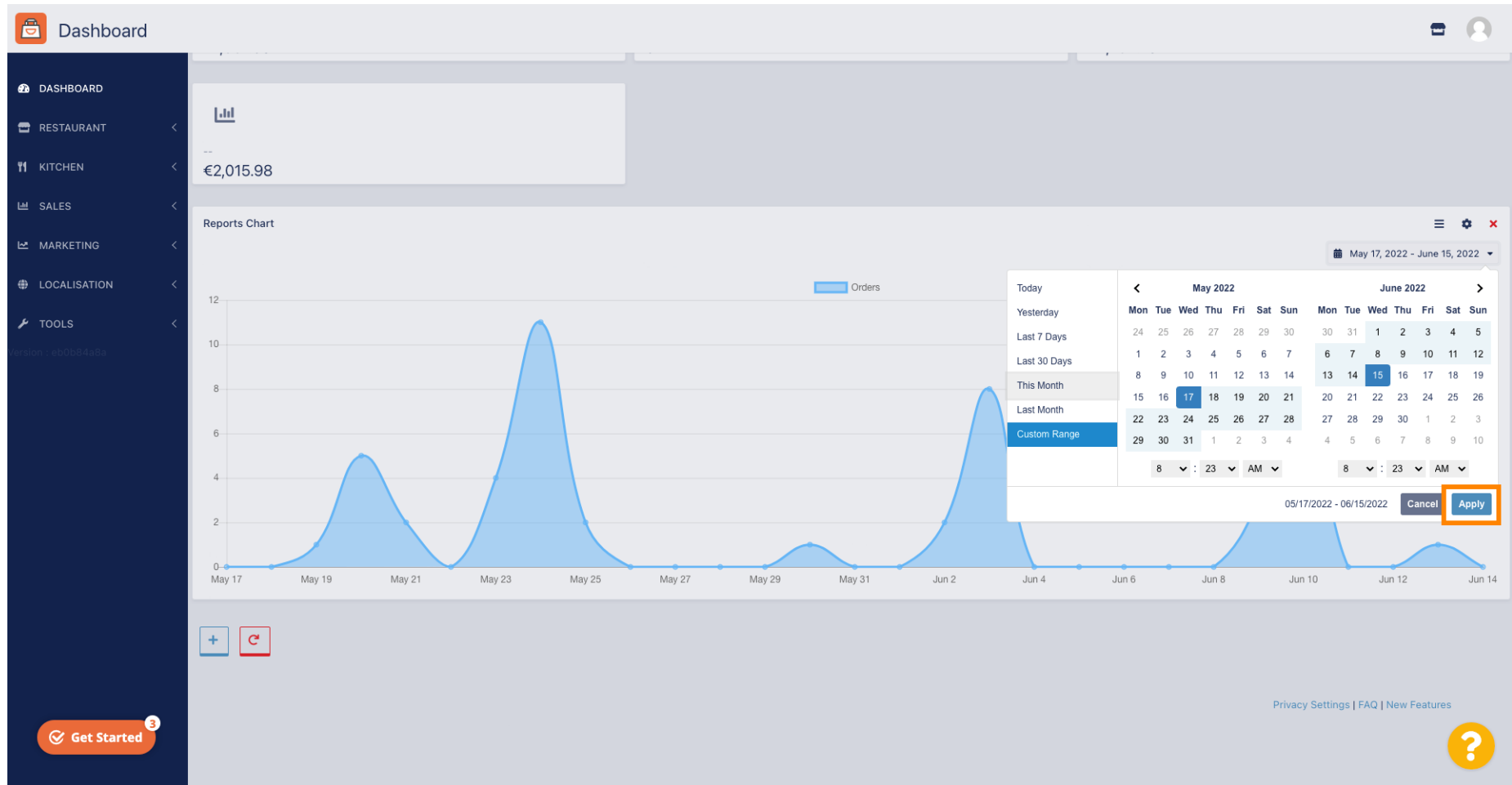


As well you can determine the time.

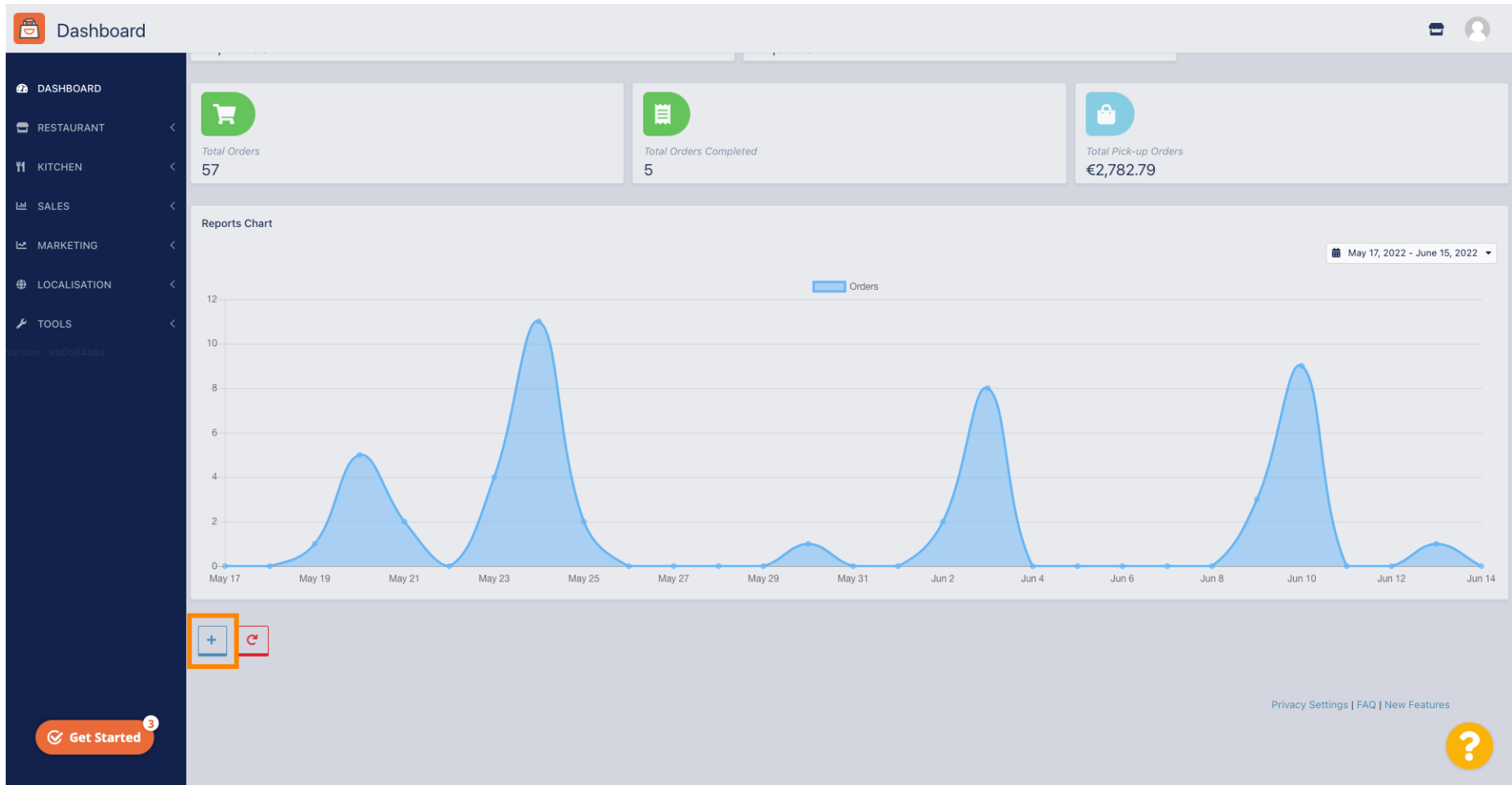




Once everything is set up click on **Apply**.

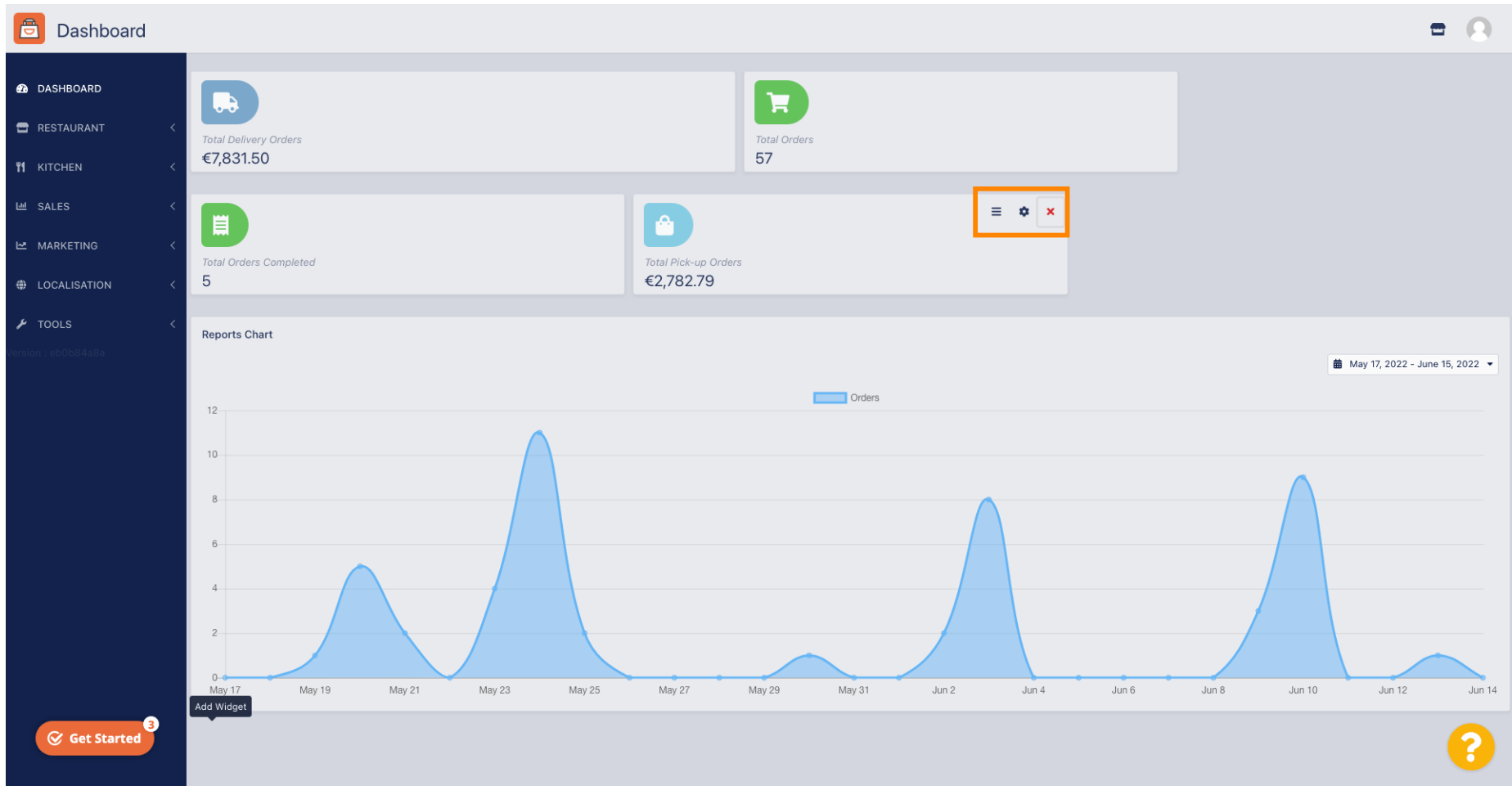

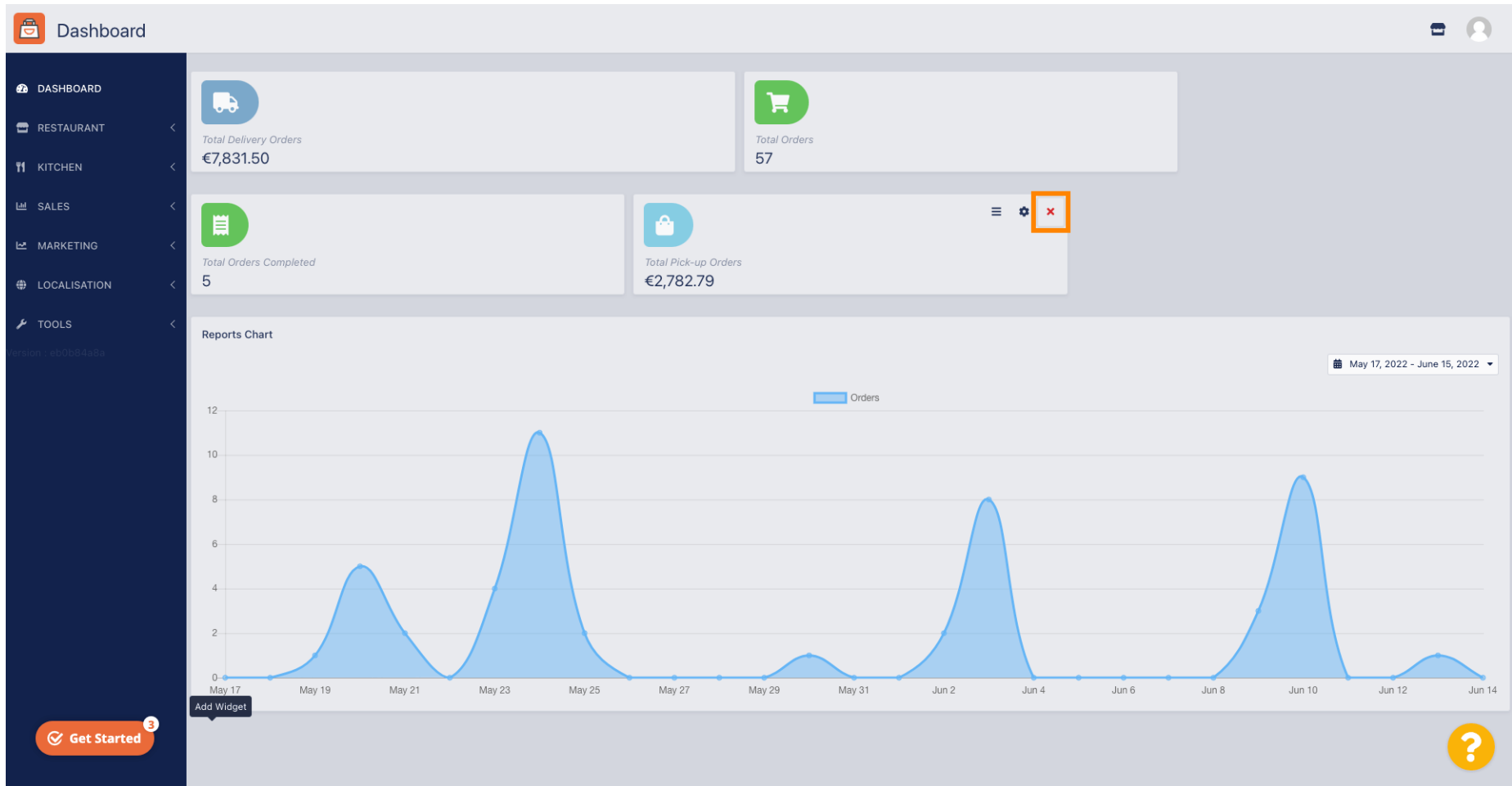


To remove a widget of your dashboard hover over the top right corner of the widget.
