

After adding the Input, select the Customers preferred payment method. **Note: you can only choose between the payment methods that are available in your restaurant.**

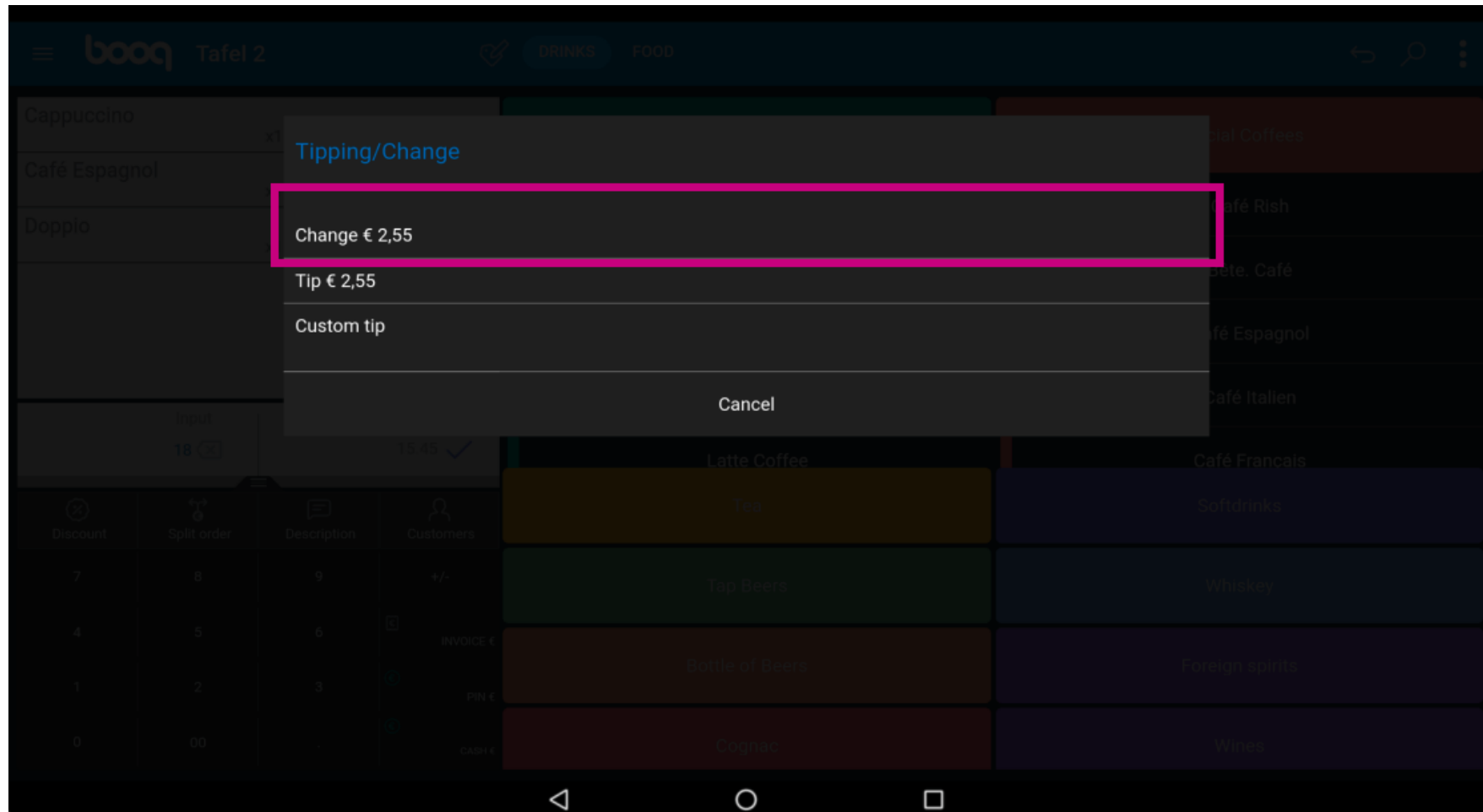

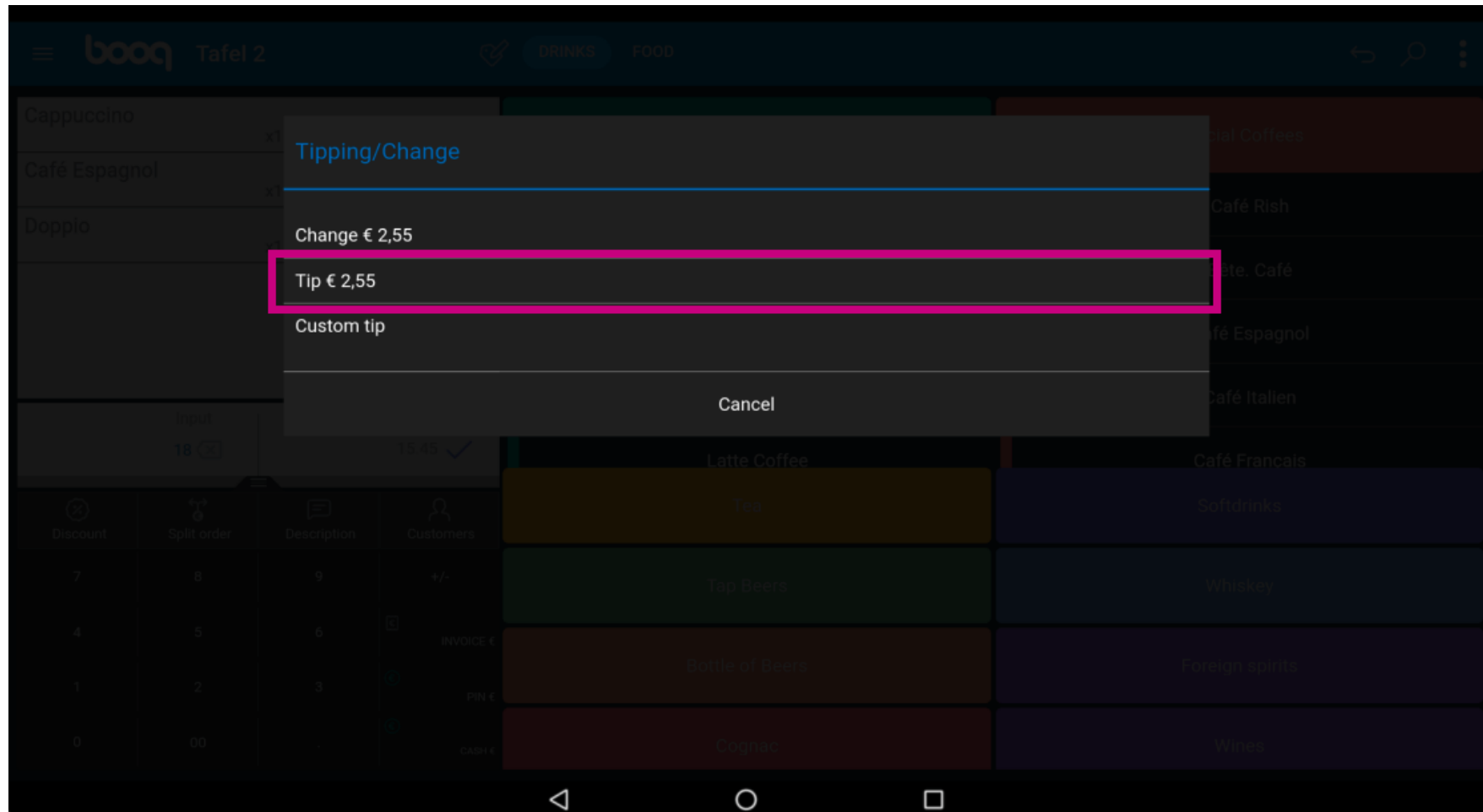


By clicking on **Change € 2,55** you can easily give back the extra Input to the Customer.

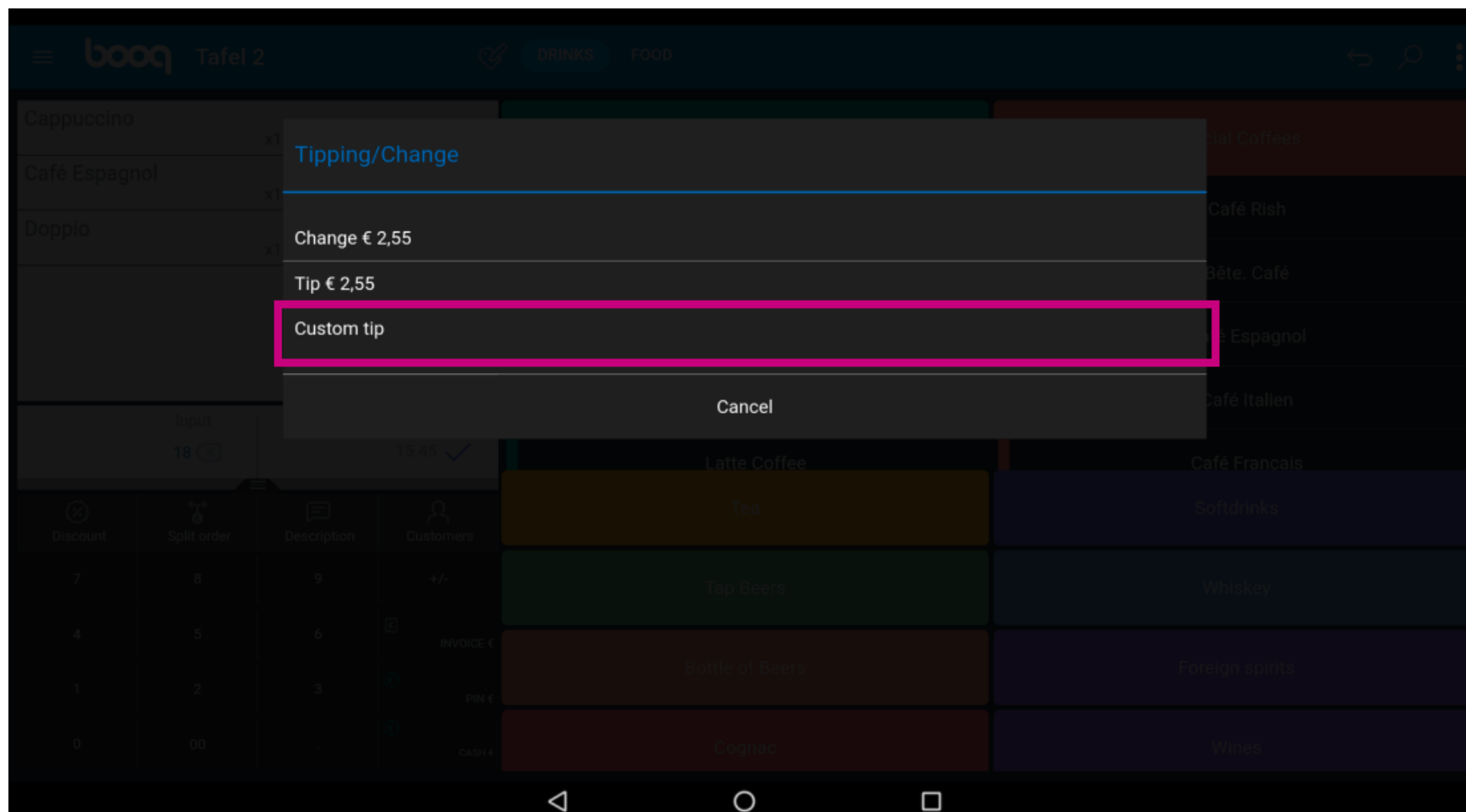




By clicking on **Tip € 2,55**, the extra Input can easily be tipped at the Customers request.

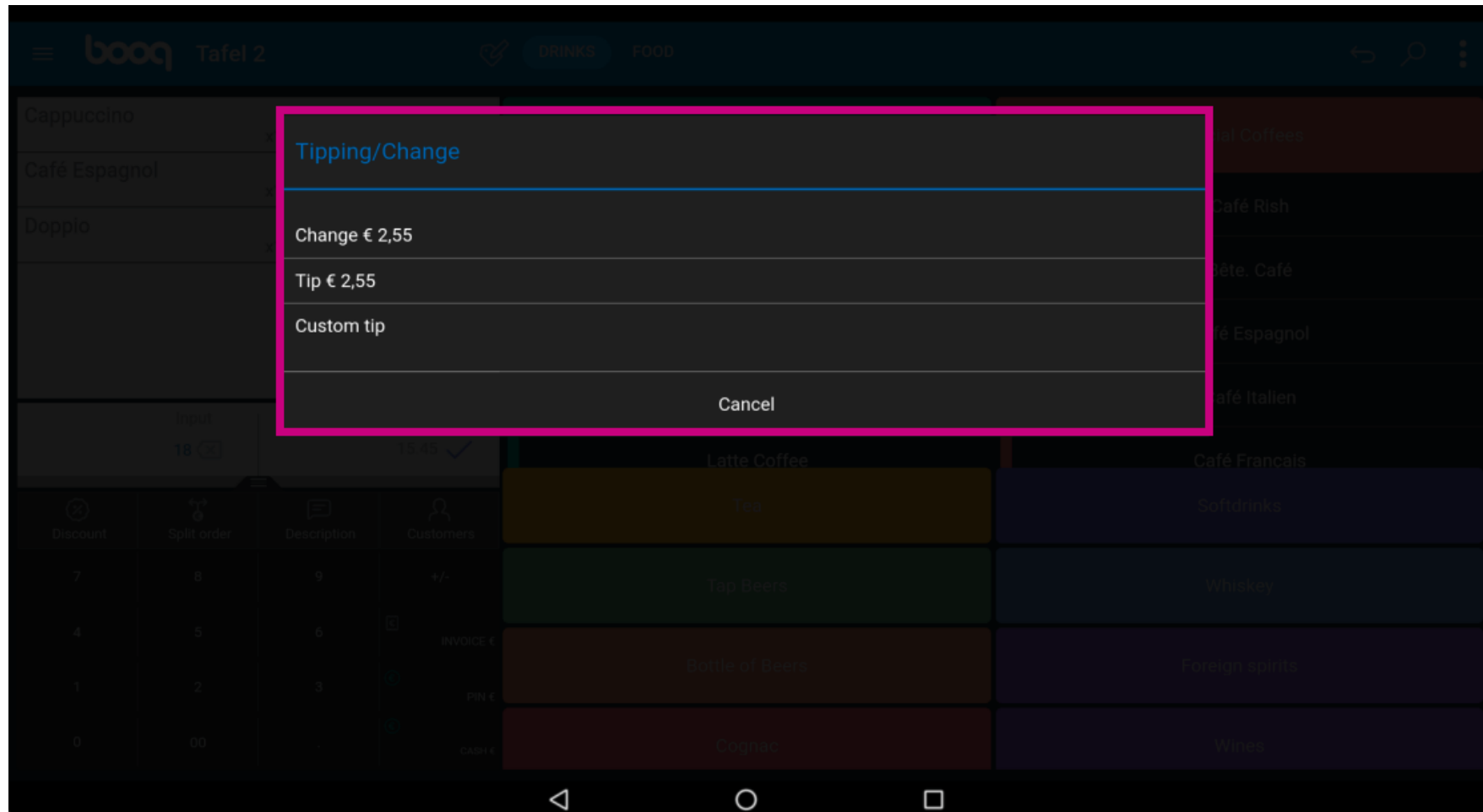
