
To add a new menu, simply click on **+ Add menu**.



Since this is a derived menu, you can't fully delete items of the menu. You only can deactivate or activate them. To deactivate an item, use the **bin icon**. **Note: Only items you added to the menu and are not included in the base menu can be deleted.**





