






Welcome to the DISH POS app. In this tutorial, we show you how to adjust a product in the ordering process.




When you are in an order, tap on the **information** of an item to open the respective functions.




- You now have several functions (adjusting the amount of the item, discounting it or completely remove it) to choose from. Tap on the respective **function** you want to execute.




By tapping on the **name** of the item, you open the functions regarding the itself.




- You now have several functions to choose from. By tapping on **Note**, you can add a remark to the item that will then be printed on the ticket.




- 1 A pop-up will then appear. Enter the remark into the corresponding **text field** and confirm the note by tapping on **OK**.




- If the item you selected is set to a course (in the Backoffice), you can tap on **Modify** to change the course of it.




- 1 A pop-up will then appear with a list of the available courses. Select the preferred course by setting the respective **checkmark** and tap on **OK** to confirm the change.



- By tapping on **Extra** you can add pre-defined options of the item. **Note: A pop-up window with the options is then displayed.**



- To mix items together, tap on **Mix articles**. Then simply select another article. It will be then added to the existing item.



-  For example, you have an Octopus and then opened the functions for the corresponding item and mixed it with the Lobster Soup. Now those items are displayed as one item. **Note: The price of the additional item will be added accordingly.**
