



Welcome to DISH POS. In this tutorial, we are going to show you how to enter a tip when cashing out.






After adding the Input, select the Customers preferred **payment method**. **Note: you can only choose between the payment methods that are available in your restaurant.**




By clicking on **Change € 3,05** you can easily give back the extra Input to the Customer.




By clicking on **Tip € 3,05**, the extra Input can easily be tipped at the Customers request.

By clicking on **Decide later** you can keep the order open for now.







Click on **Order incl. tip:**.


 **Type** in the Order amount including the tip.

Click **OK**.


