




Welcome to the DISH POS App. In this tutorial, we show you how to split and move a table.




Start by long tapping the **table** with the order you want to manage.




-  Then a pop-up window will appear with multiple options. Tap on **Move order**, to move the items to another table.




Afterwards select the table you wish to move your order to, by setting the respective **checkmark**.




And confirm your choice by tapping on **OK**.



 Now a **pop-up** will appear notifying you that your order has been moved successfully.




To split a table, first tap the **table** you want to split.






You are now in the open order of the selected table. From here, open the **options' menu** in the top right corner.





Now select **Split/move**.



- To split the items on the handheld and let them be paid separately, you need to move the according items to another table. To do so, select the respective **items**.




And tap on the **move order icon**.




Then select the table you want to move the selected items to, by setting the respective **checkmark**.




Then proceed, by tapping on **OK**.



- i** Again, a **pop-up** will appear notifying you that your order has been moved successfully. Now, the selected item has been removed from the original order and is assigned to the new table.
