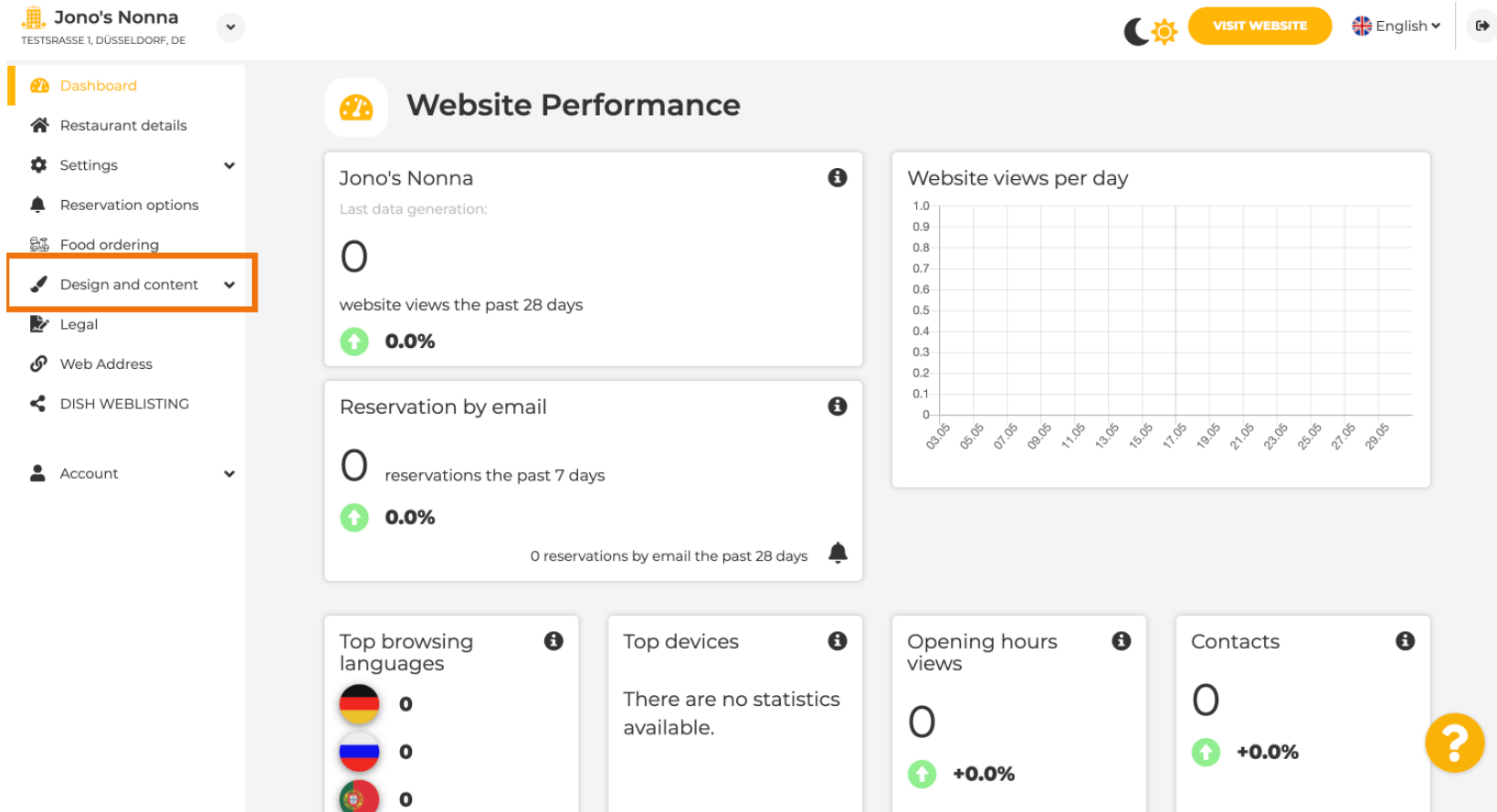

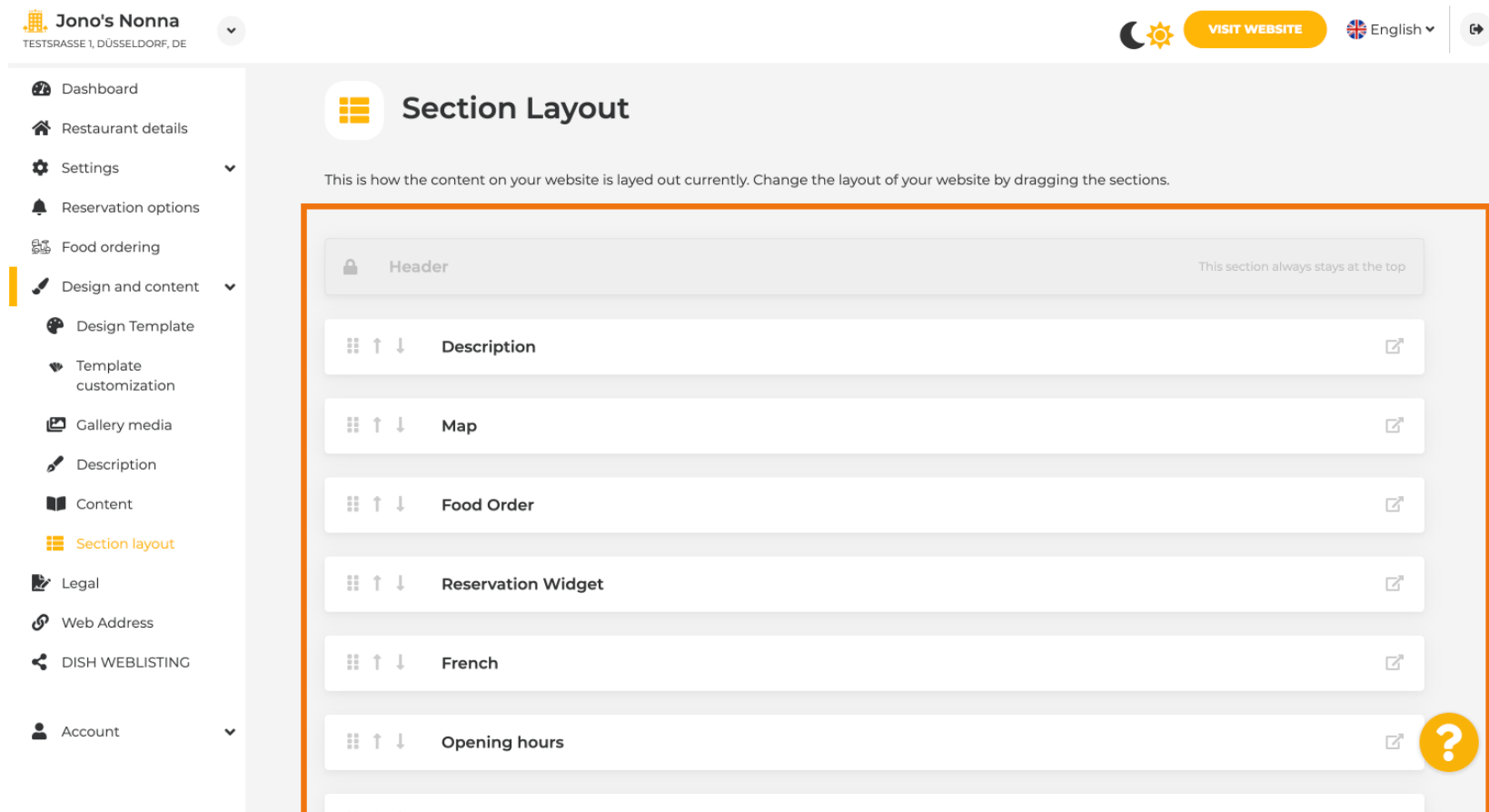

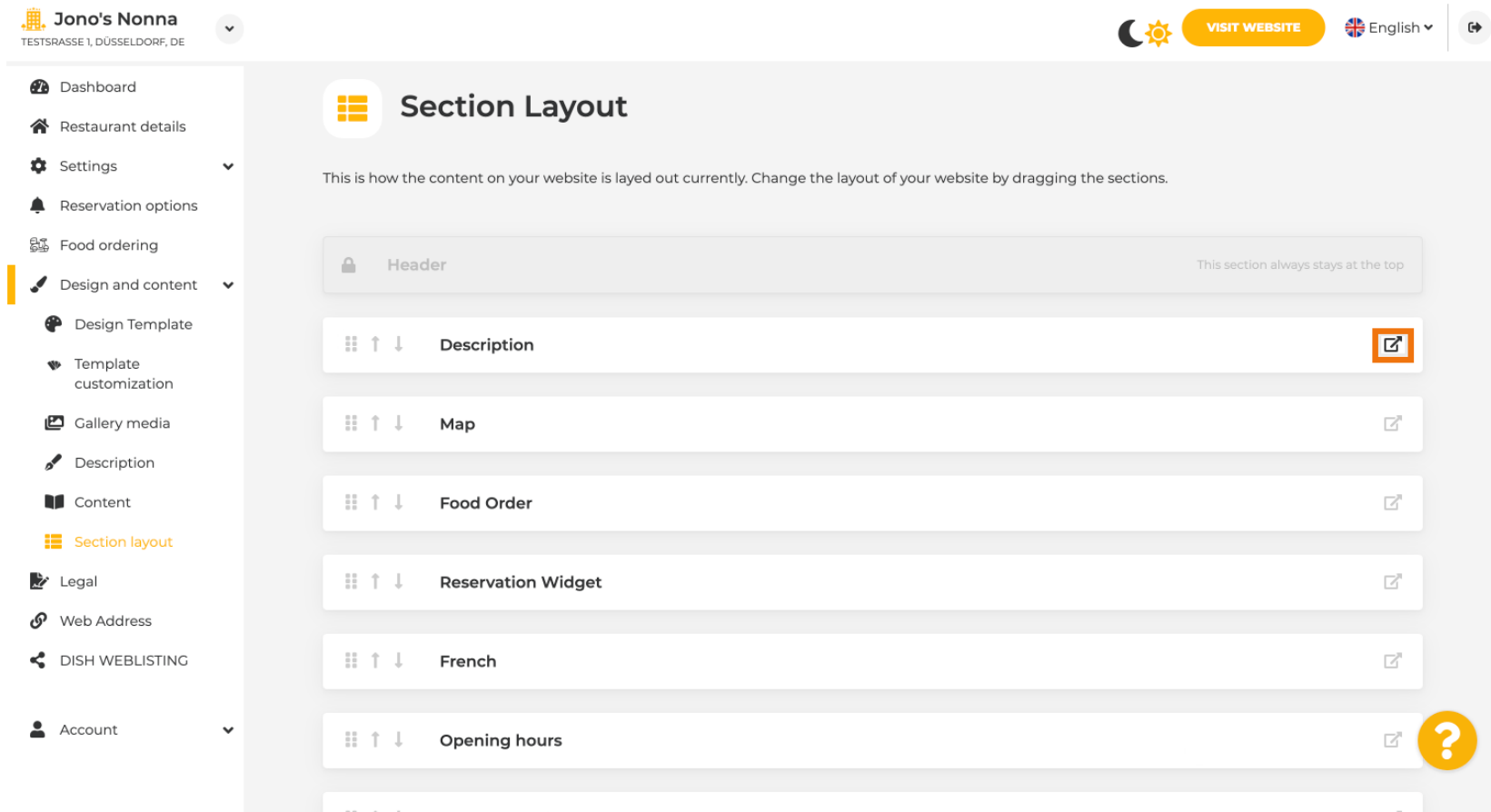

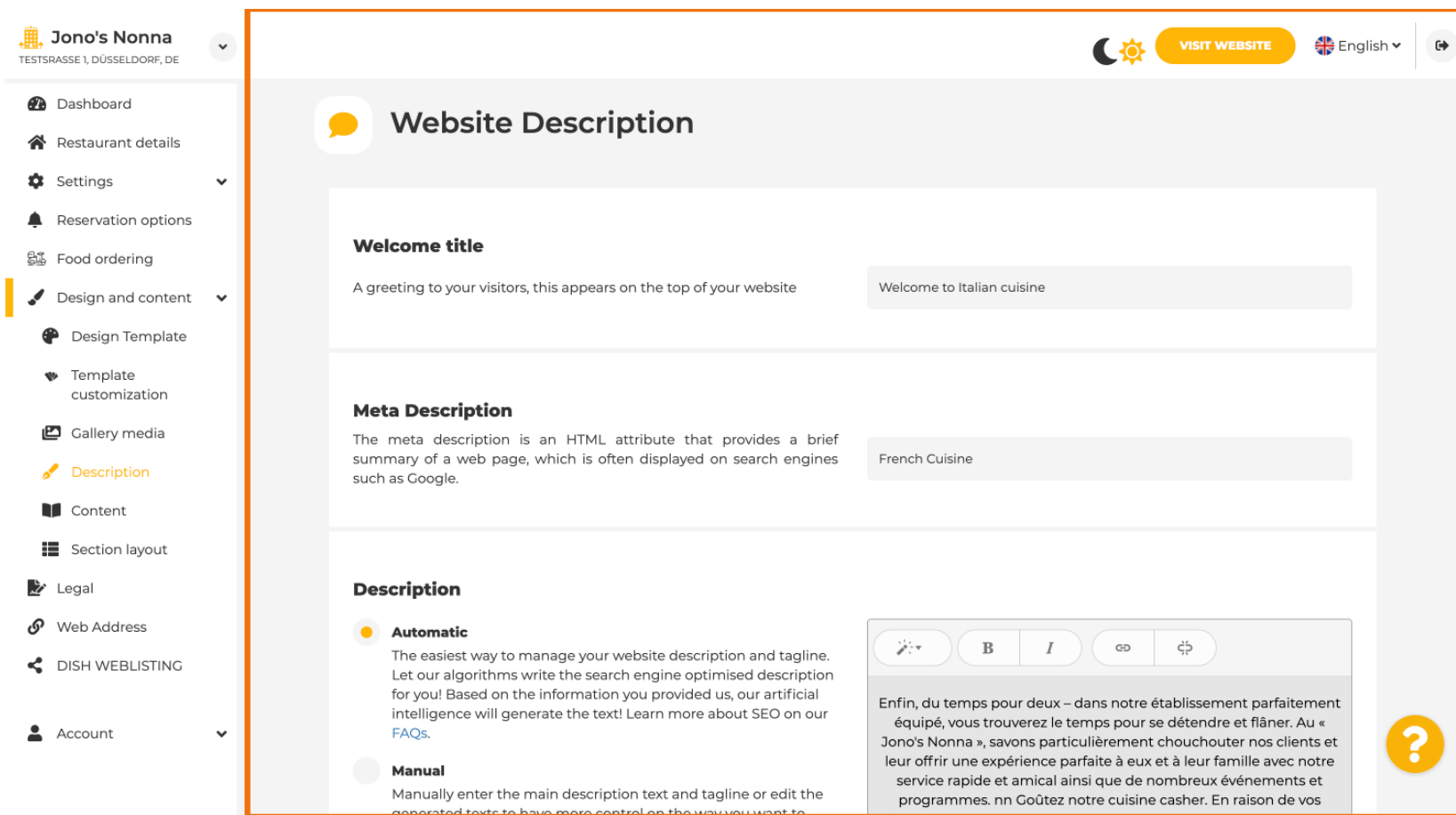

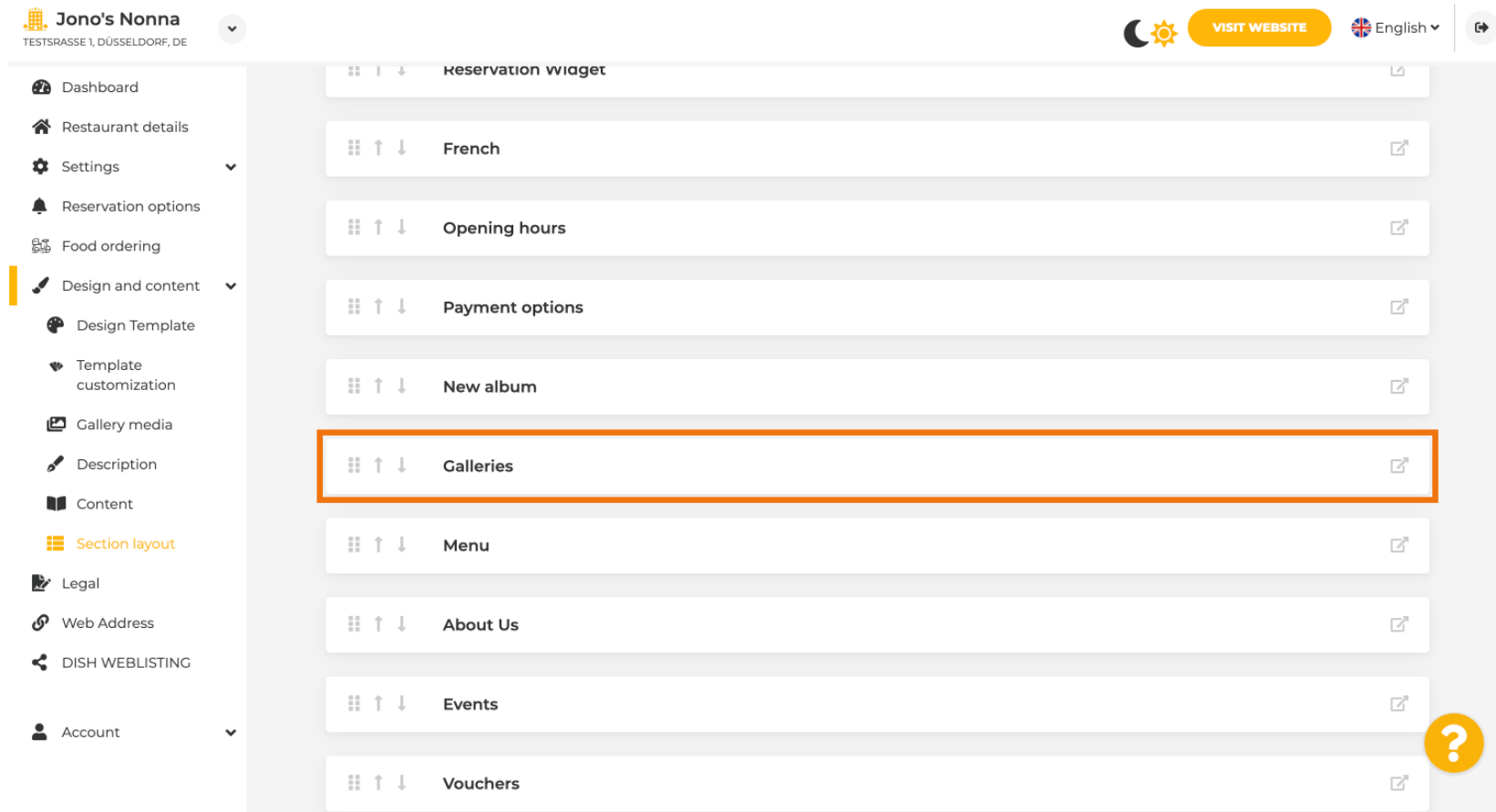


Each gallery will be displayed individually and moved around separately so that each one of them can appear exactly where you want it to.

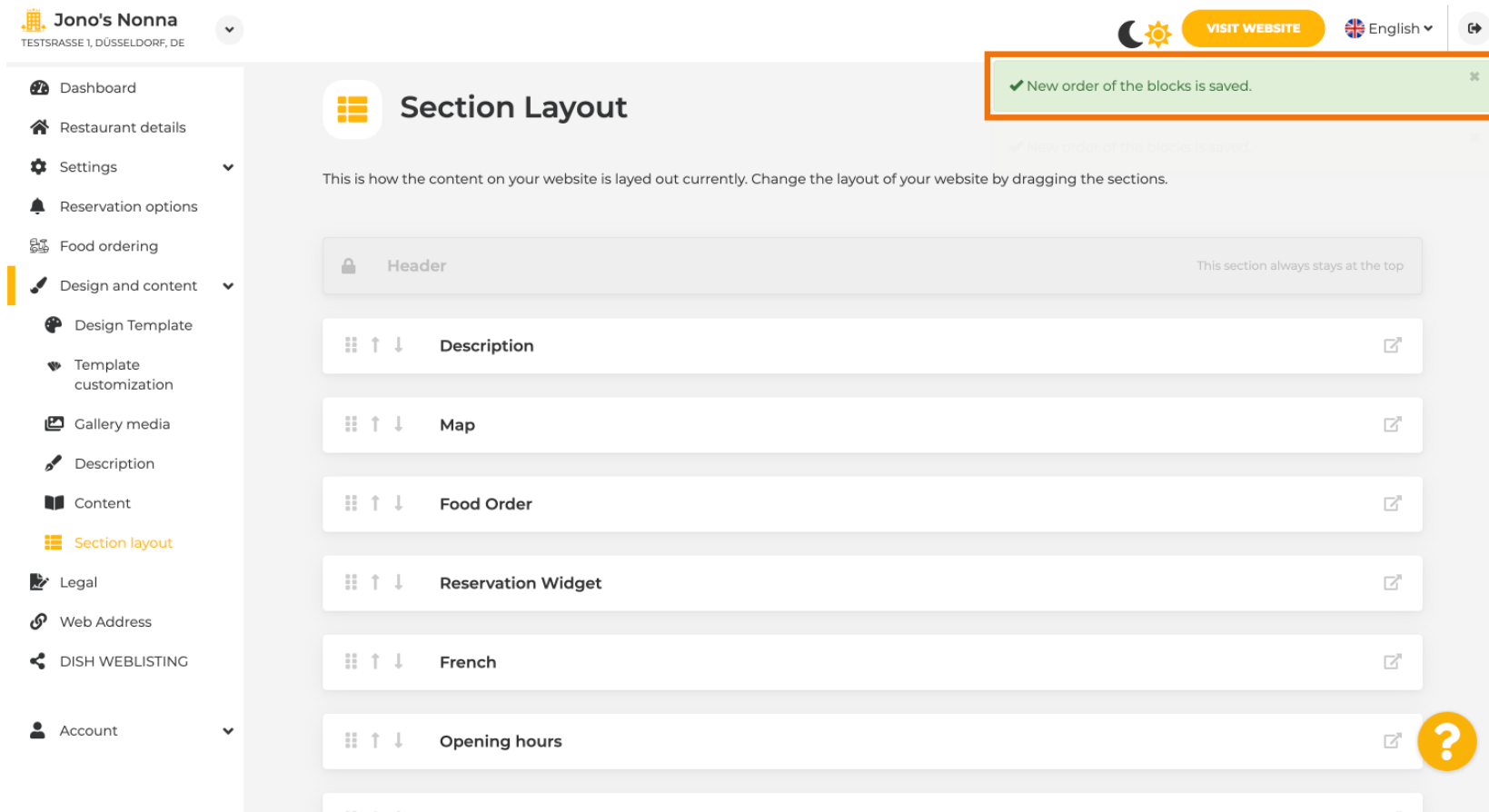

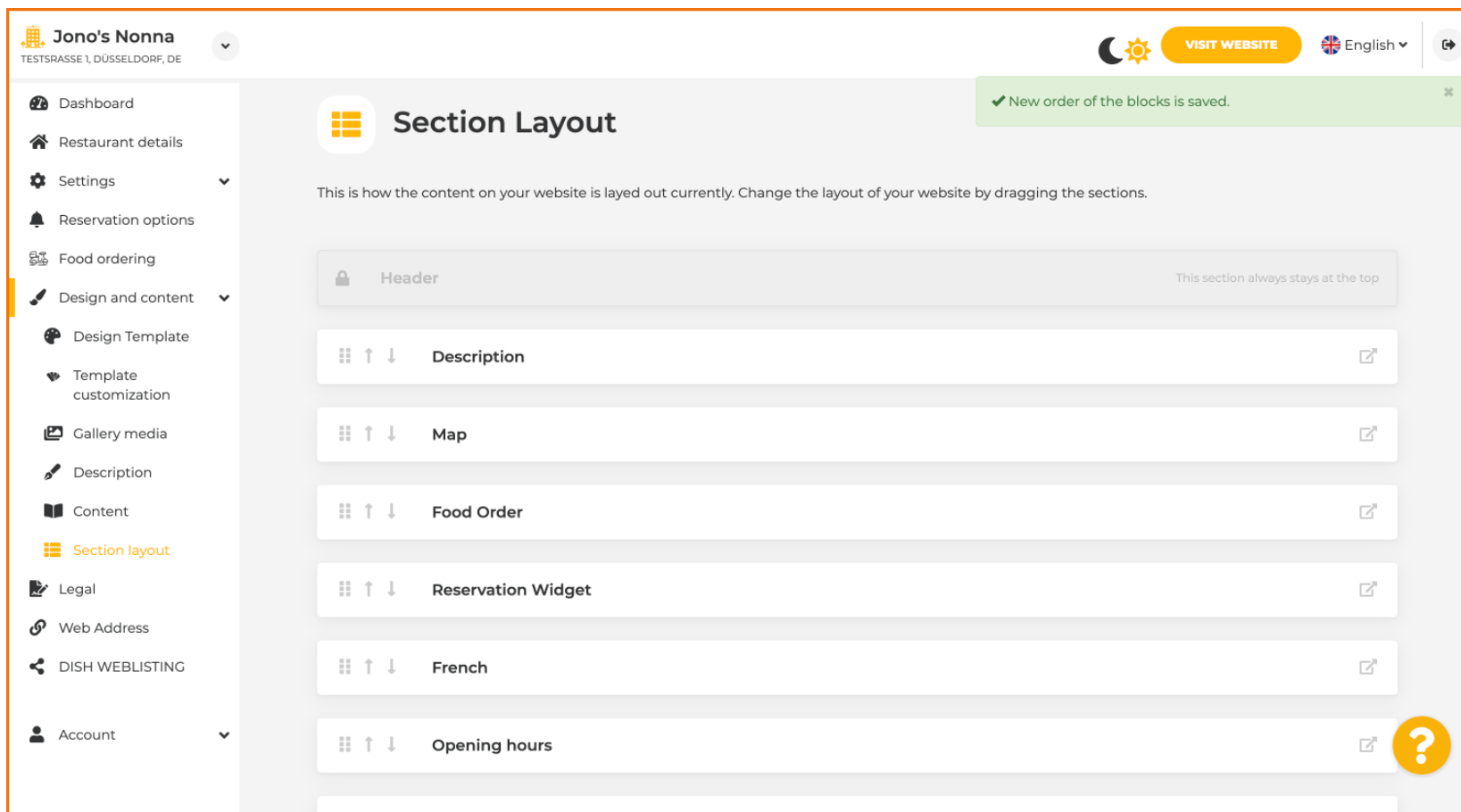
