



Welcome to the DISH POS dashboard. In this tutorial, we show you how to create composites out of multiple articles.






First, click on Articles.






Then go to Products.






To create a composite, we need to add a new article. Therefore, click on + Add product.






Since this is going to be a composite, give this article a descriptive name by using the respective text field.






Then assign it to a product group by using the corresponding drop-down menu.






Afterward, add the turnover category by using the respective drop-down menu.






It is necessary to add a price. Do so by using the respective field. Note: For this example, we set the price to 0.00, because we want to use the option prices of the components we are going to add.






If you add a price and your components have option prices set, your set price will be added to the sum of your component's option prices.






Then make sure you have the right VAT selected. To do so, use the respective drop-down menu.






Once you set up the necessary information, start adding components by clicking on + Add component.






A field will open for the new component. Enter the name of the component you want to add in the text field and select it.






As mentioned before, for this example, we want to use the sum of all option prices of our used components. If you want to do the same, make sure that an option price is set for your components.






To add more components, click on + Add component.






• If you don't want to have the components be printed on the ticket, set the checkmark for the respective Hide on ticket checkbox.






To apply all changes, click on Save.
