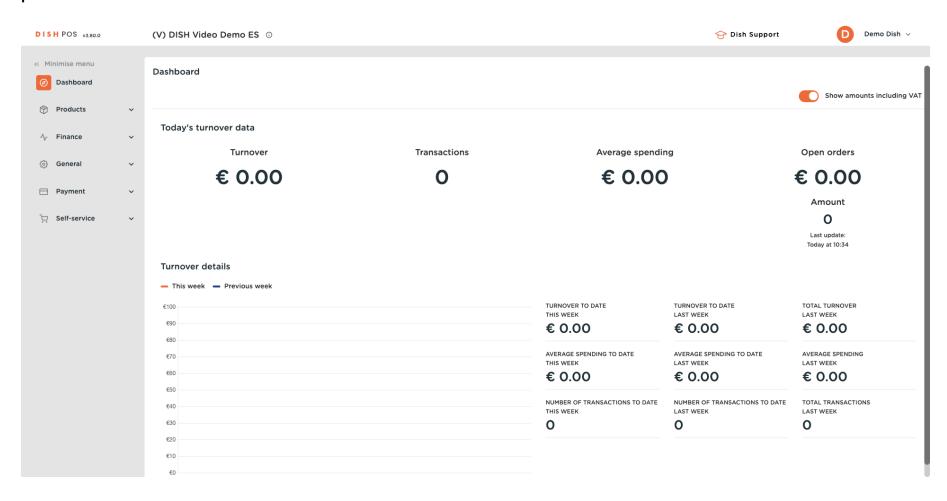
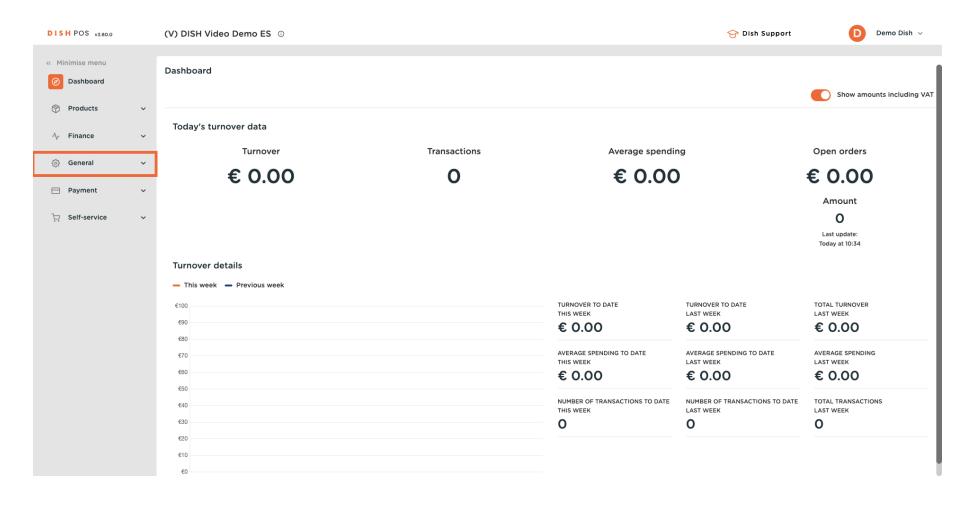


Welcome to the DISH POS dashboard. In this tutorial, we show you how to adjust the layout of production tickets.



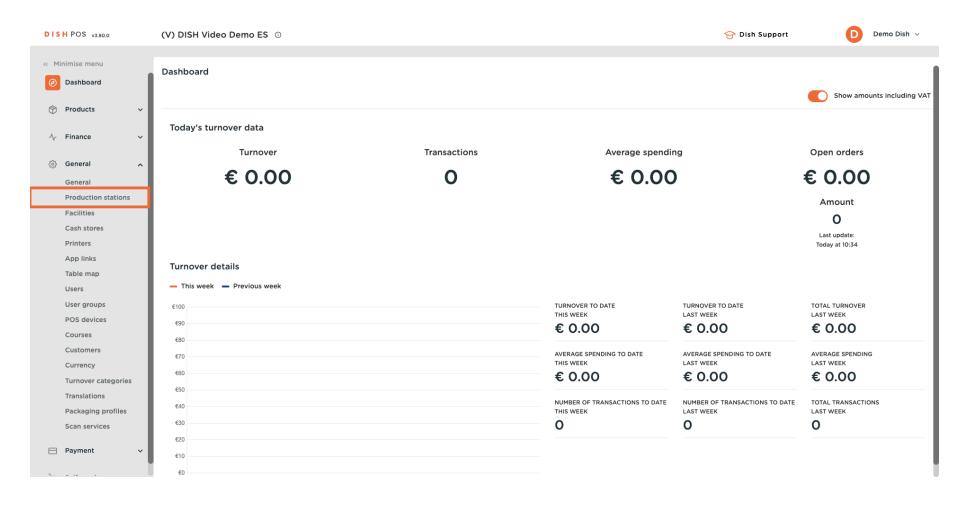


First, click on General.



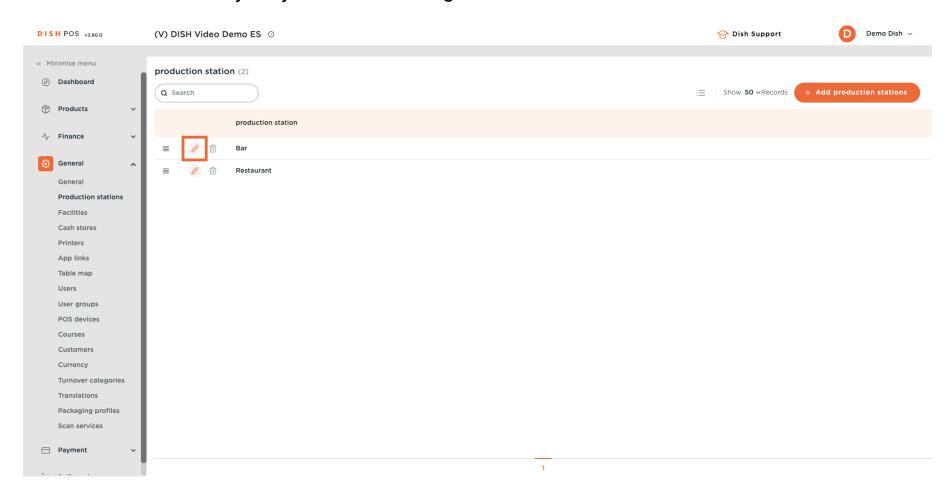


Then go to Production stations.



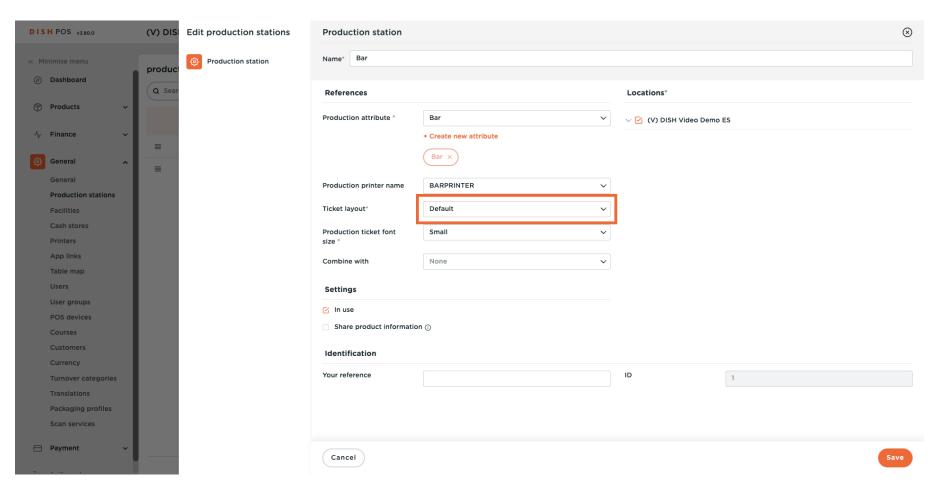


You are now in the overview of your productions stations. Click on the edit icon of the production station whose ticket layout you want to change.



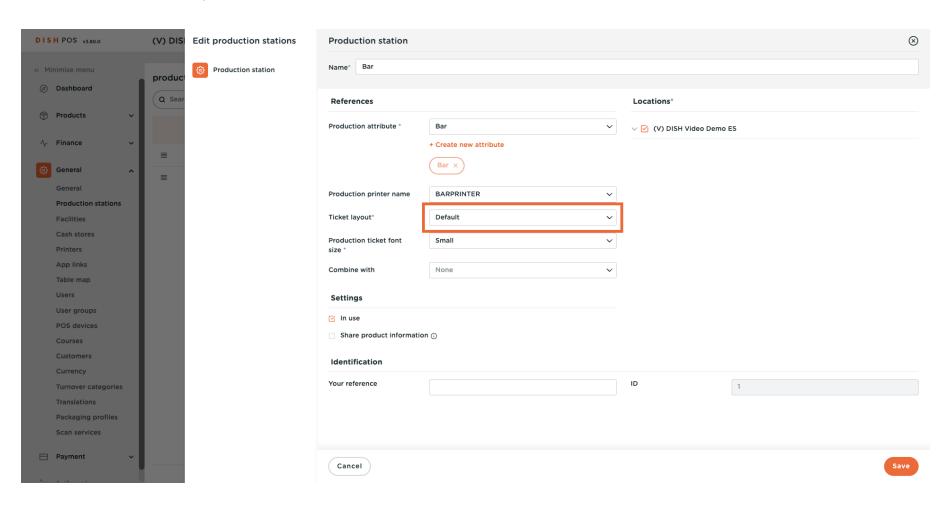


A new window will open with the settings of the chosen production station. To set a ticket layout, use the corresponding drop-down menu.



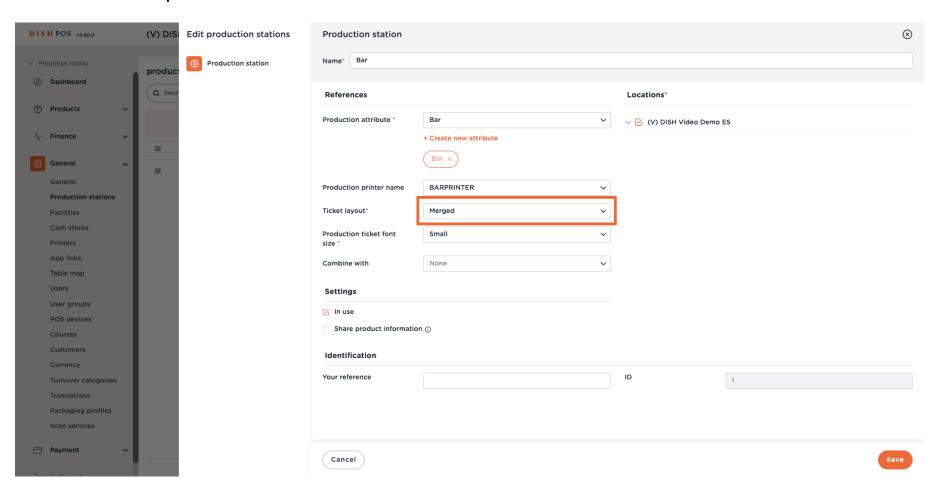


When setting the layout to Default, same items on the ticket will be printed accumulated.



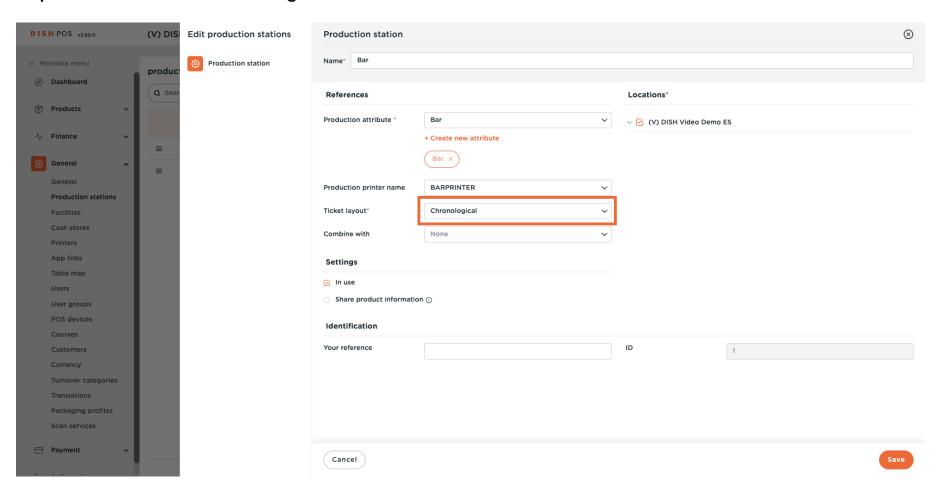


Setting the ticket layout to Merged will accumulate the same items on the ticket and sort them based on courses and production follow order.



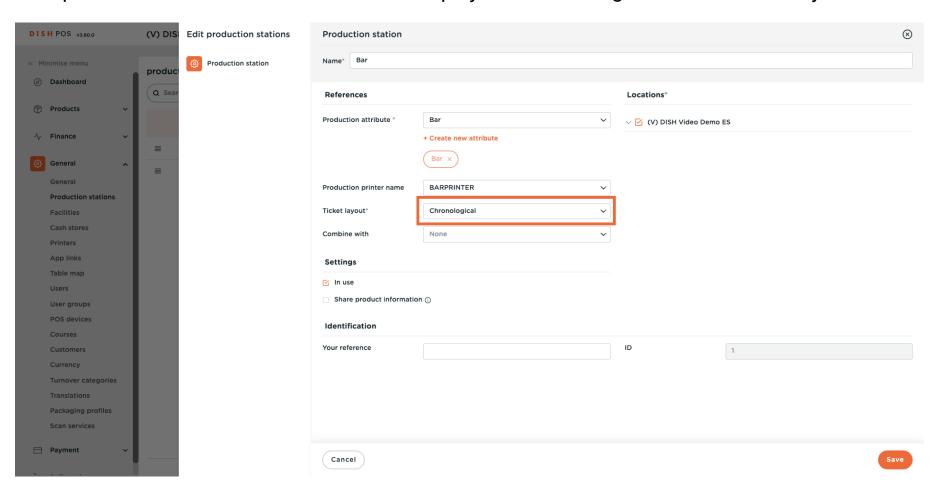


If the ticket layout is set to Chronological, the items will appear on the production ticket in order of implementation without being accumulated.



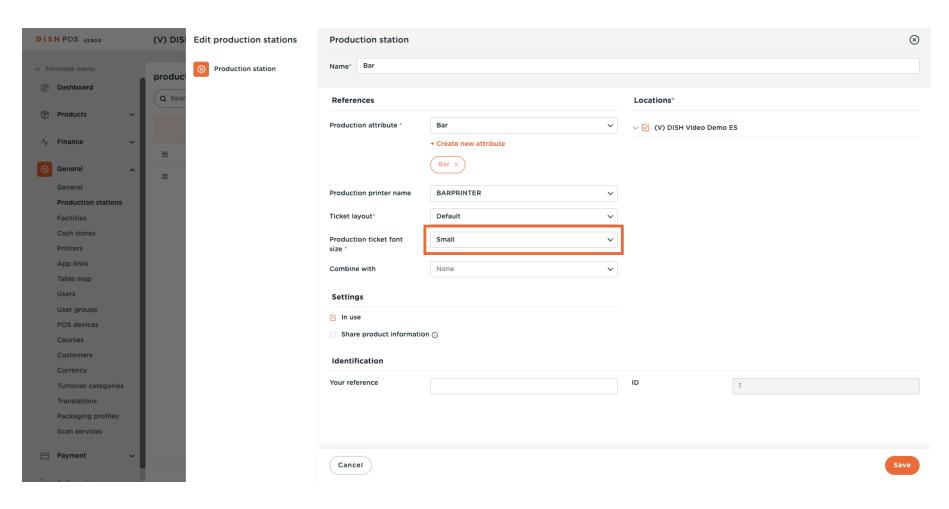


A note in addition when setting the ticket layout to chronological. When ordering in the POS, selecting multiple instances of the same article will display them as a single accumulated entry.



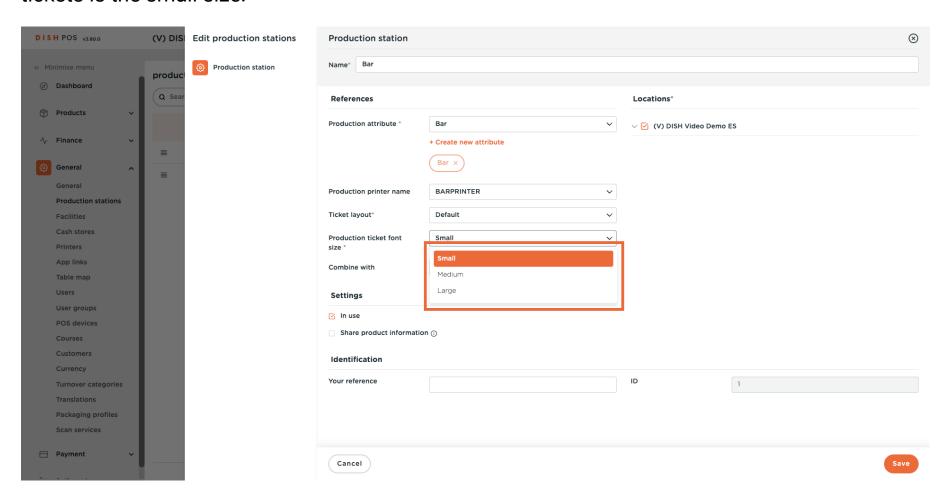


To change the font size on the production ticket, use the given drop-down menu.



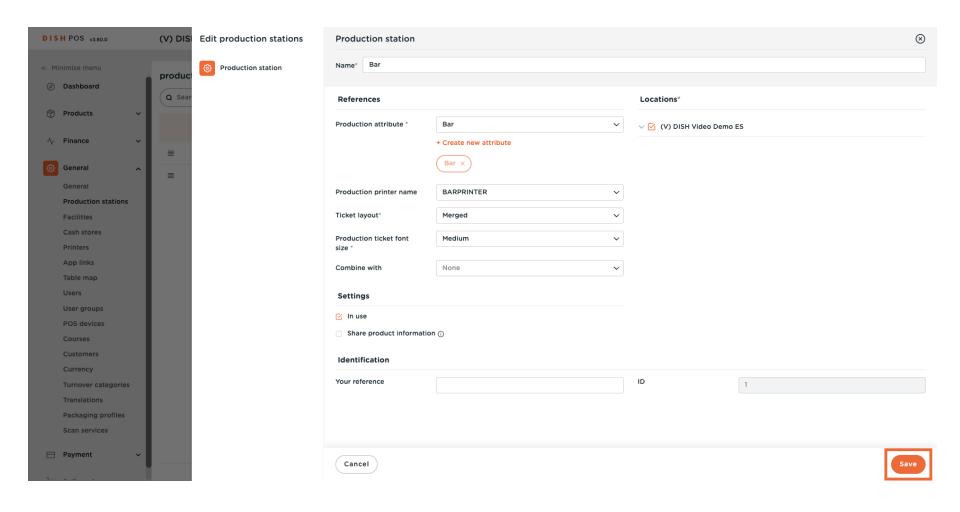


You then can select between the options Small, Medium and Large. The standard font size on the tickets is the small size.



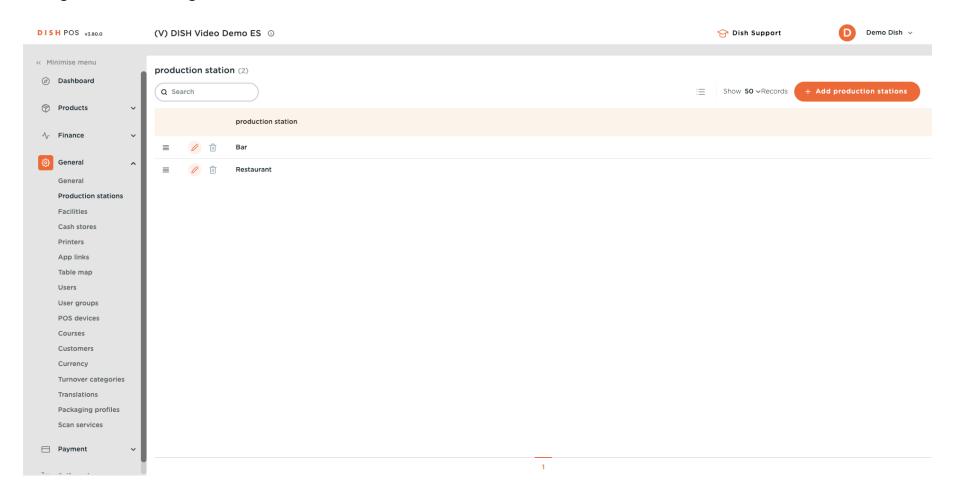


Once you are done, click on Save to apply the changes.
