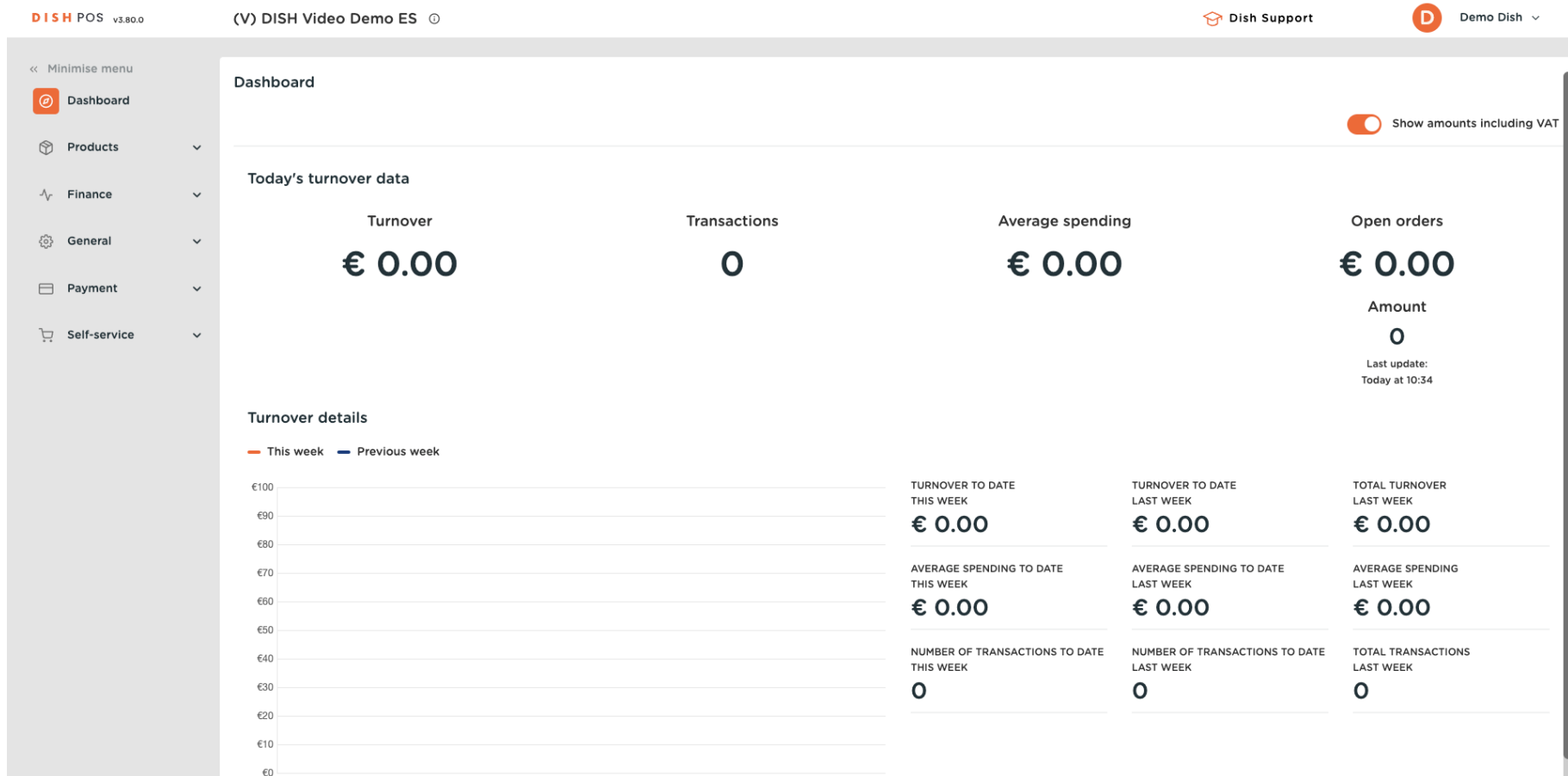




Welcome to the DISH POS dashboard. In this tutorial, we show you how to adjust the layout of production tickets.

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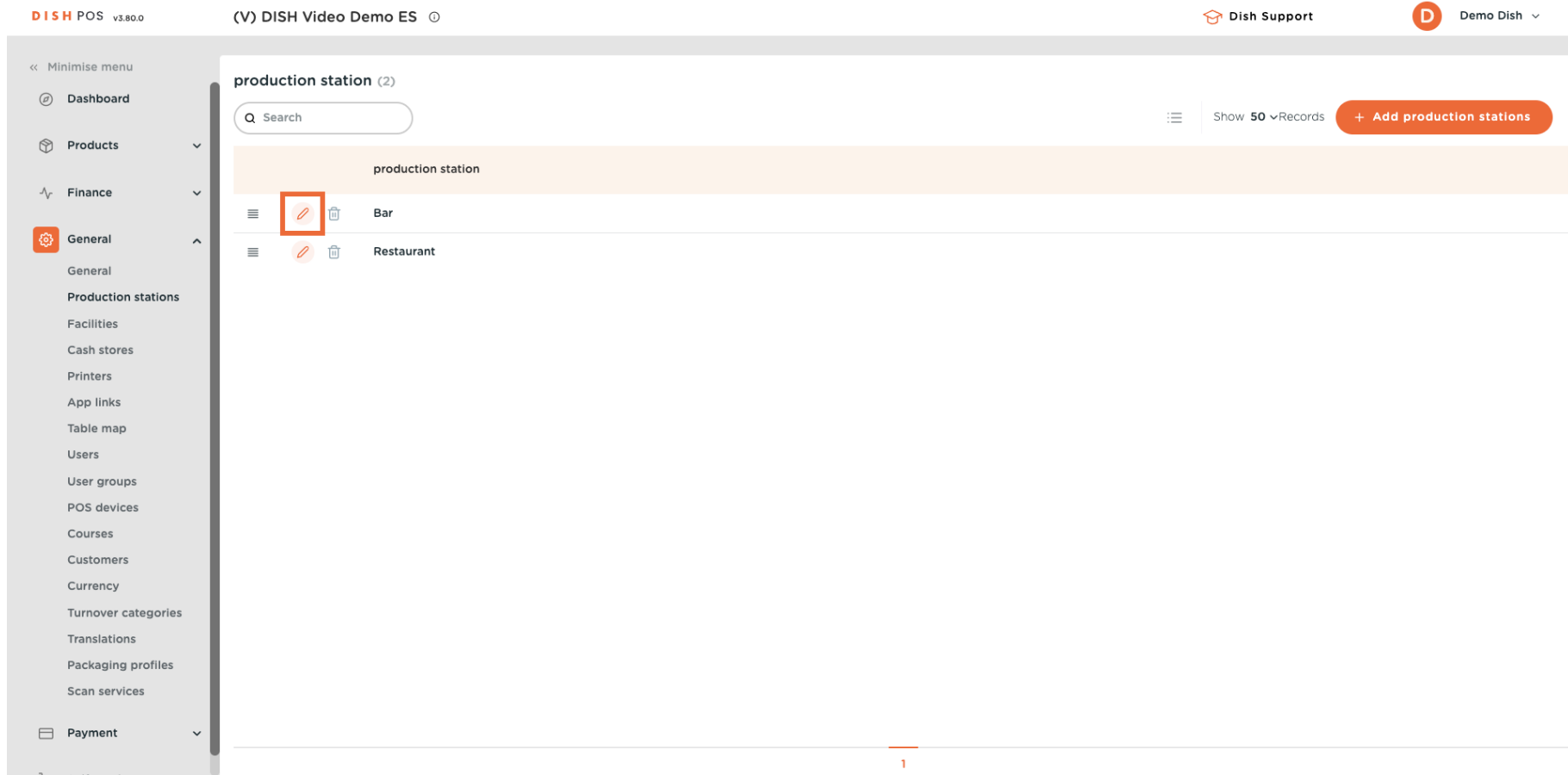

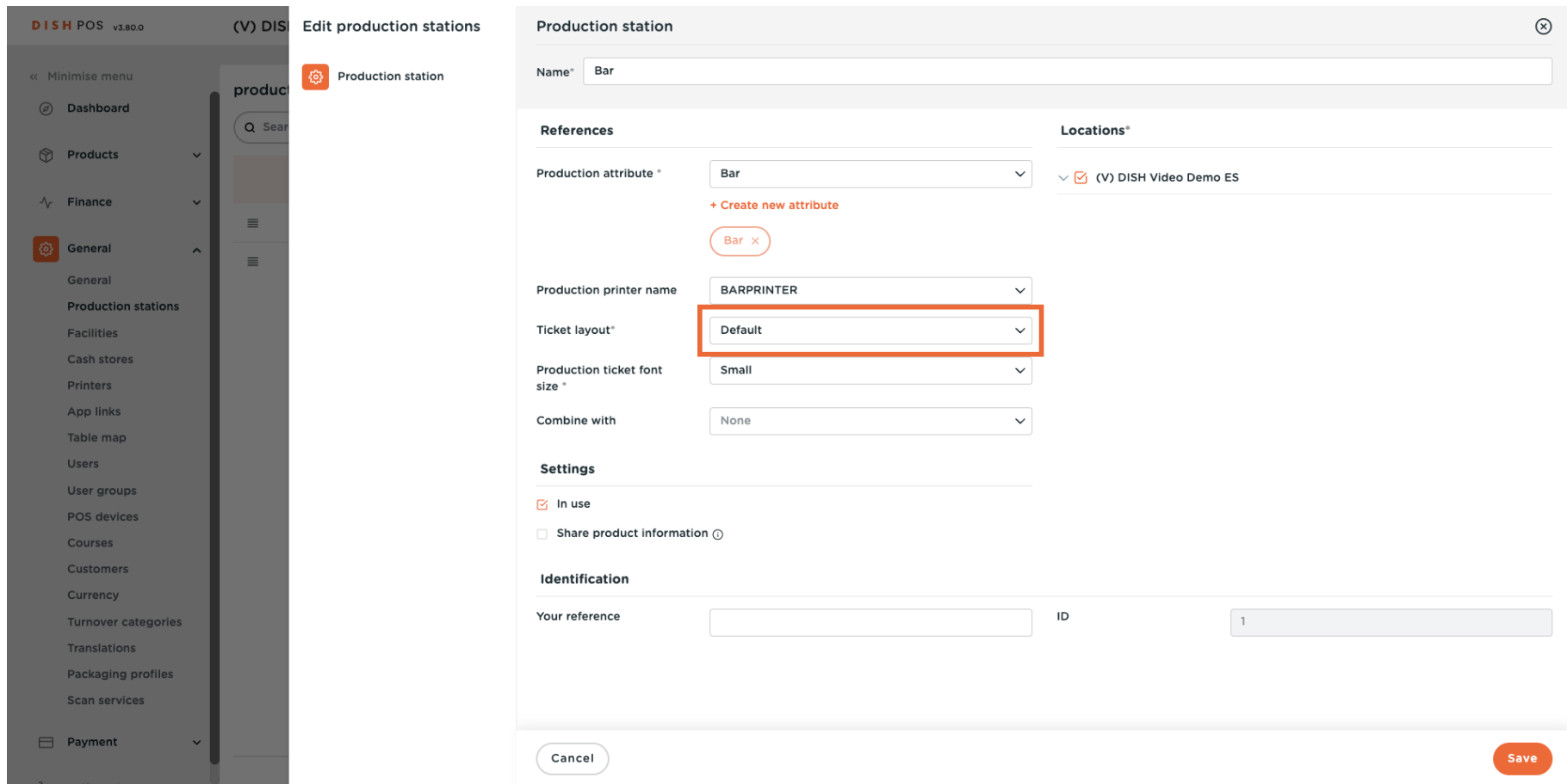
You are now in the overview of your productions stations. Click on the **edit icon** of the production station whose ticket layout you want to change.

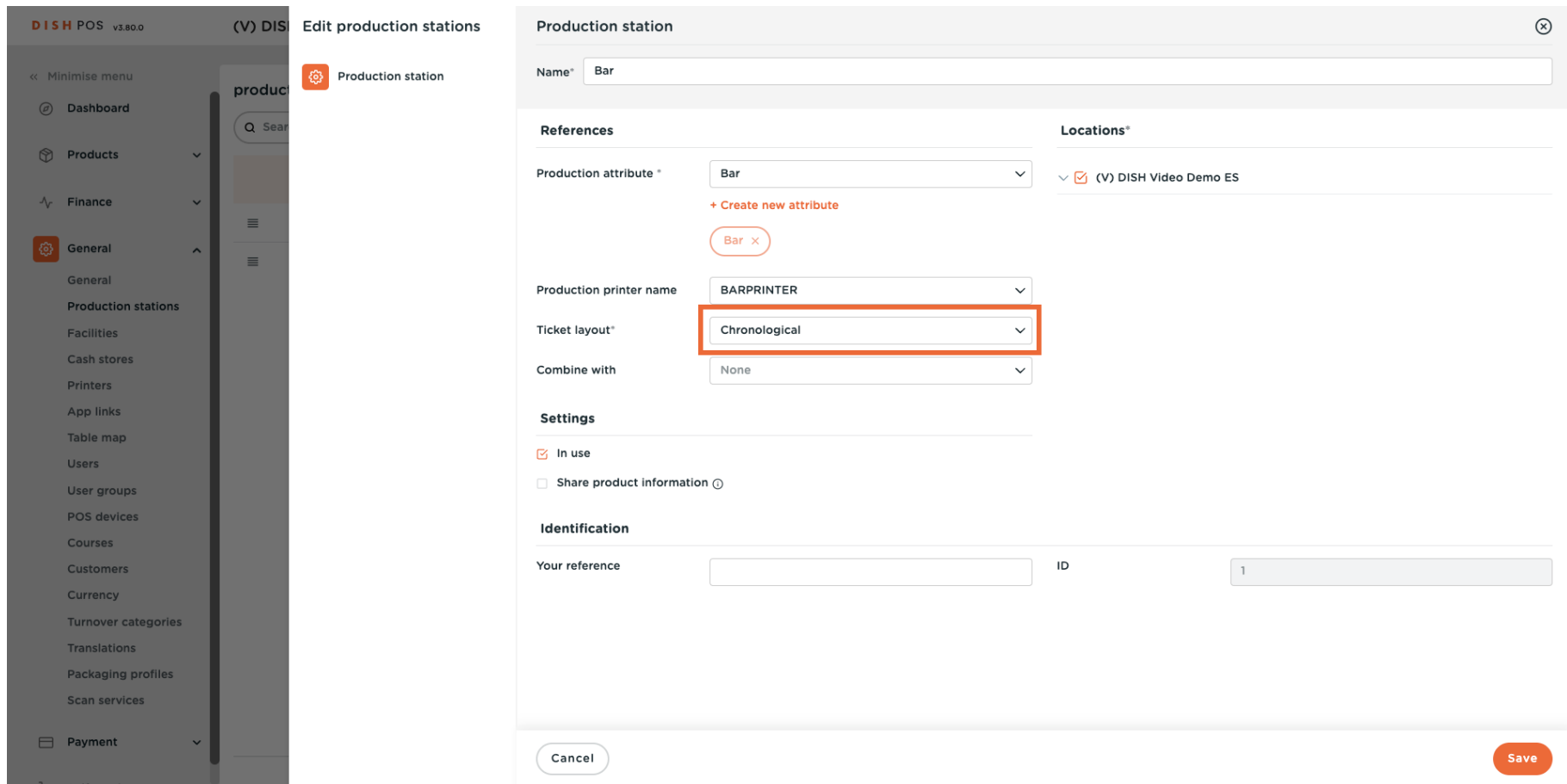

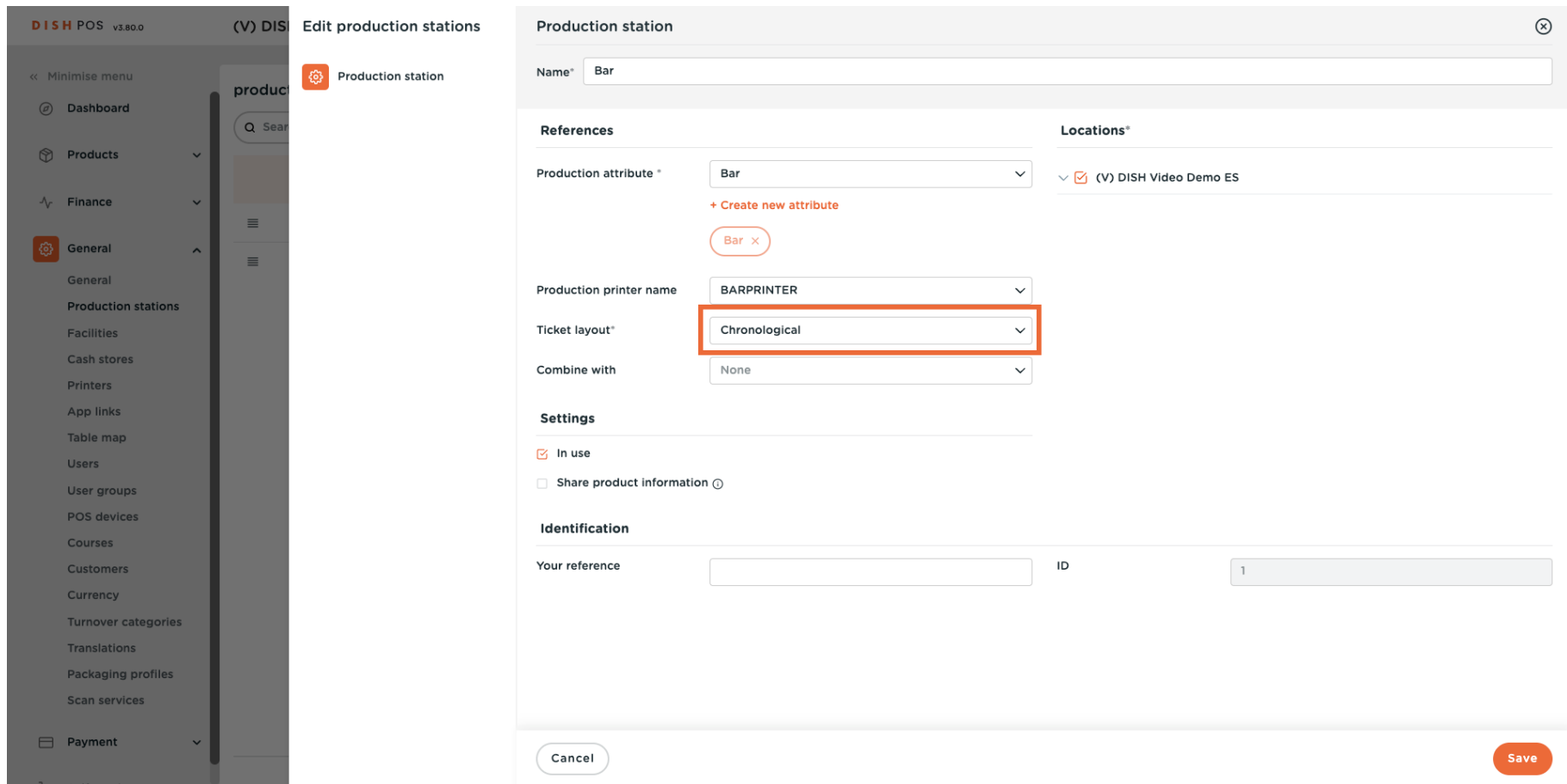
If the ticket layout is set to **Chronological**, the items will appear on the production ticket in order of implementation without being accumulated.

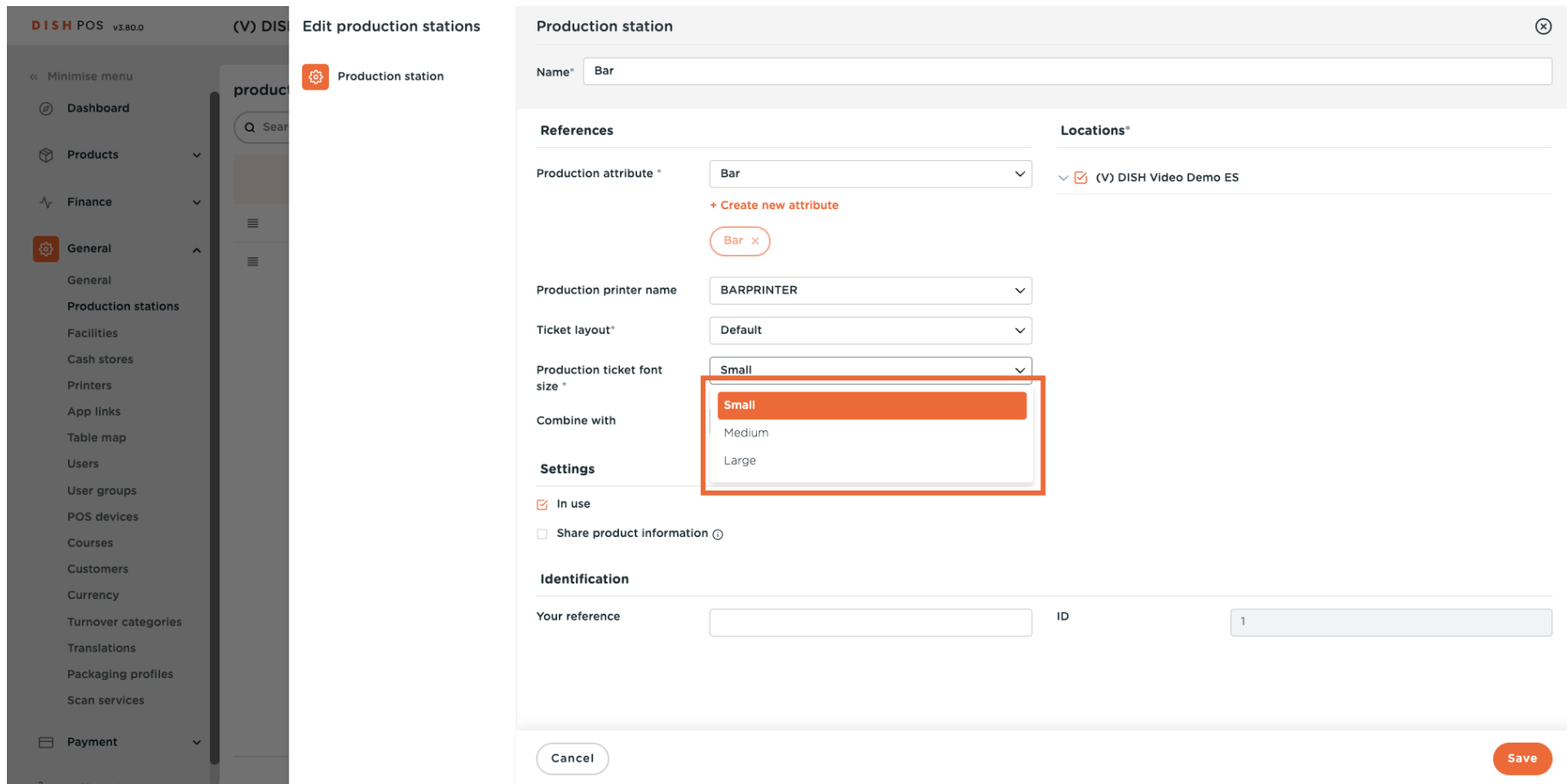

You then can select between the options **Small**, **Medium** and **Large**. The standard font size on the tickets is the small size.

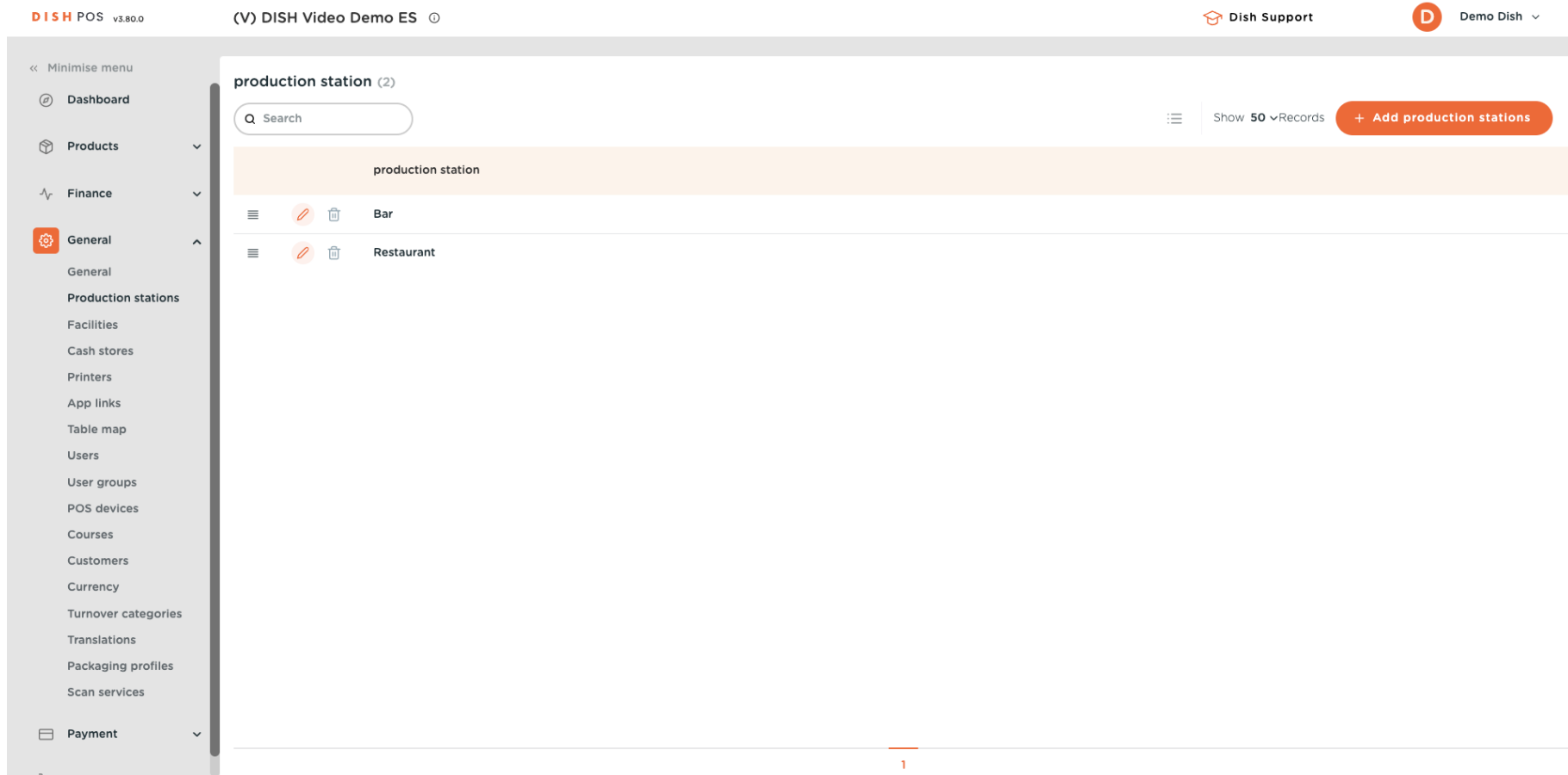
