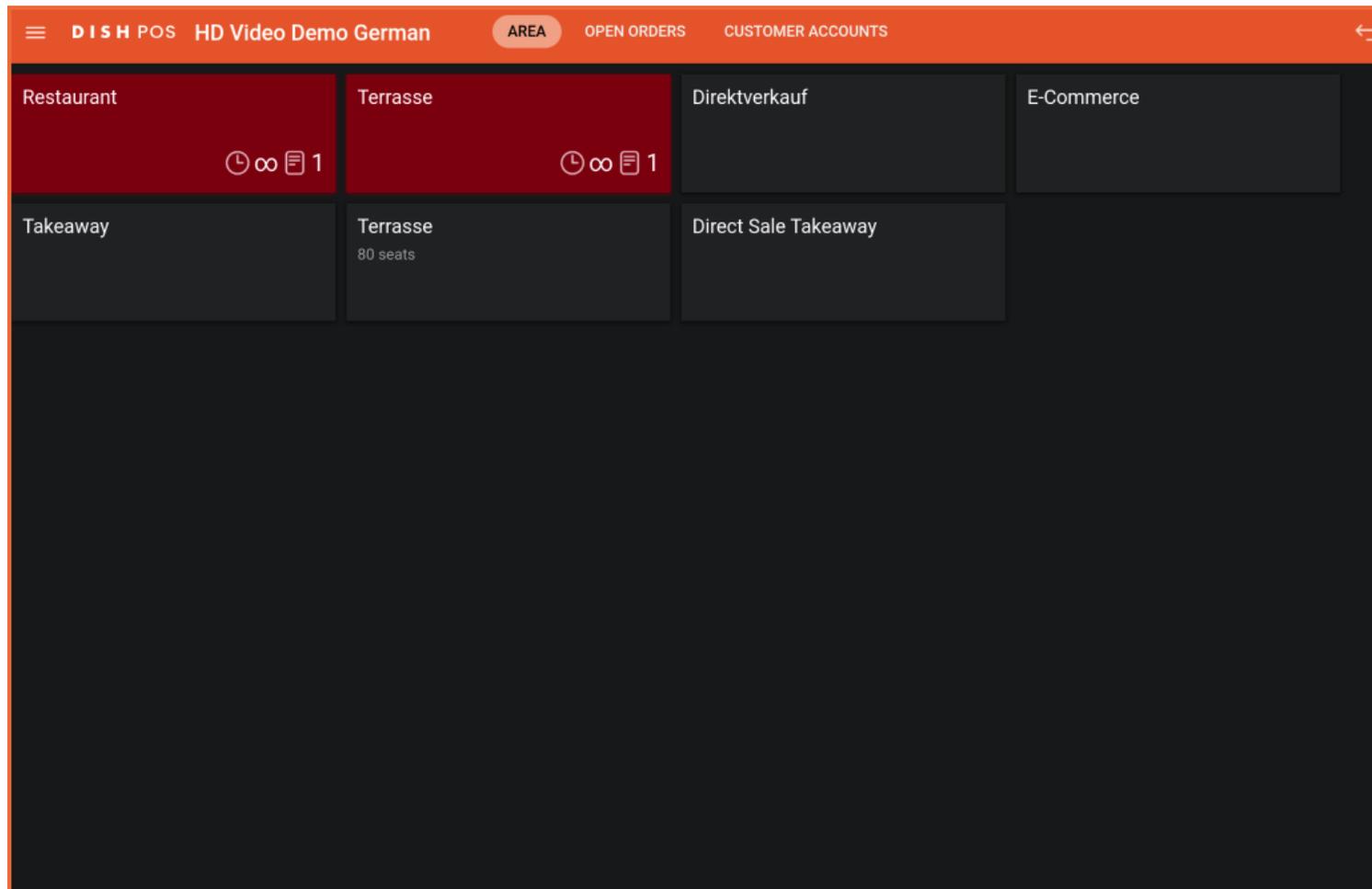


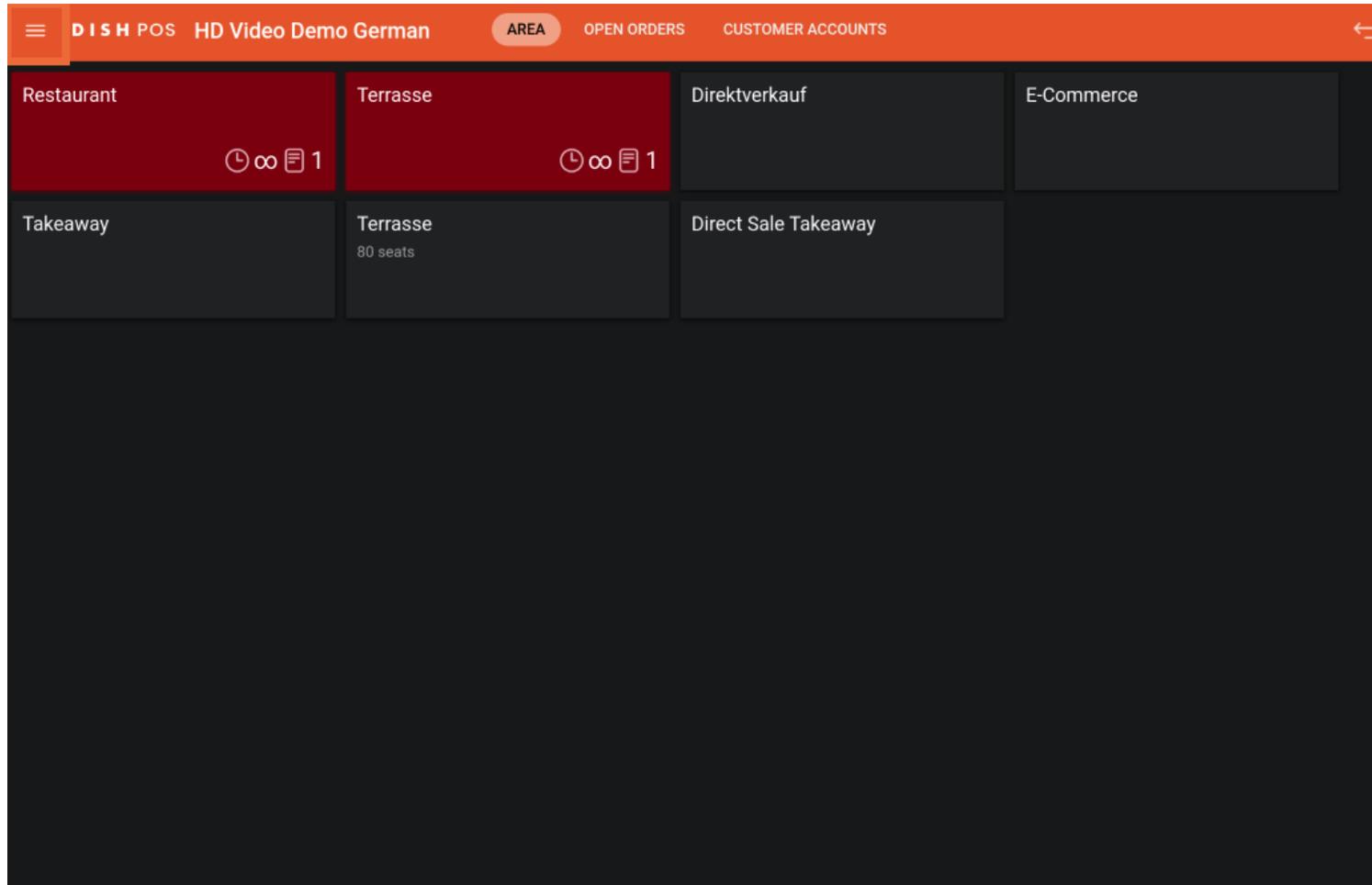


Welcome to the **DISH POS App**. In this tutorial, we will show you how to cancel a completed order and provide a reason for it.

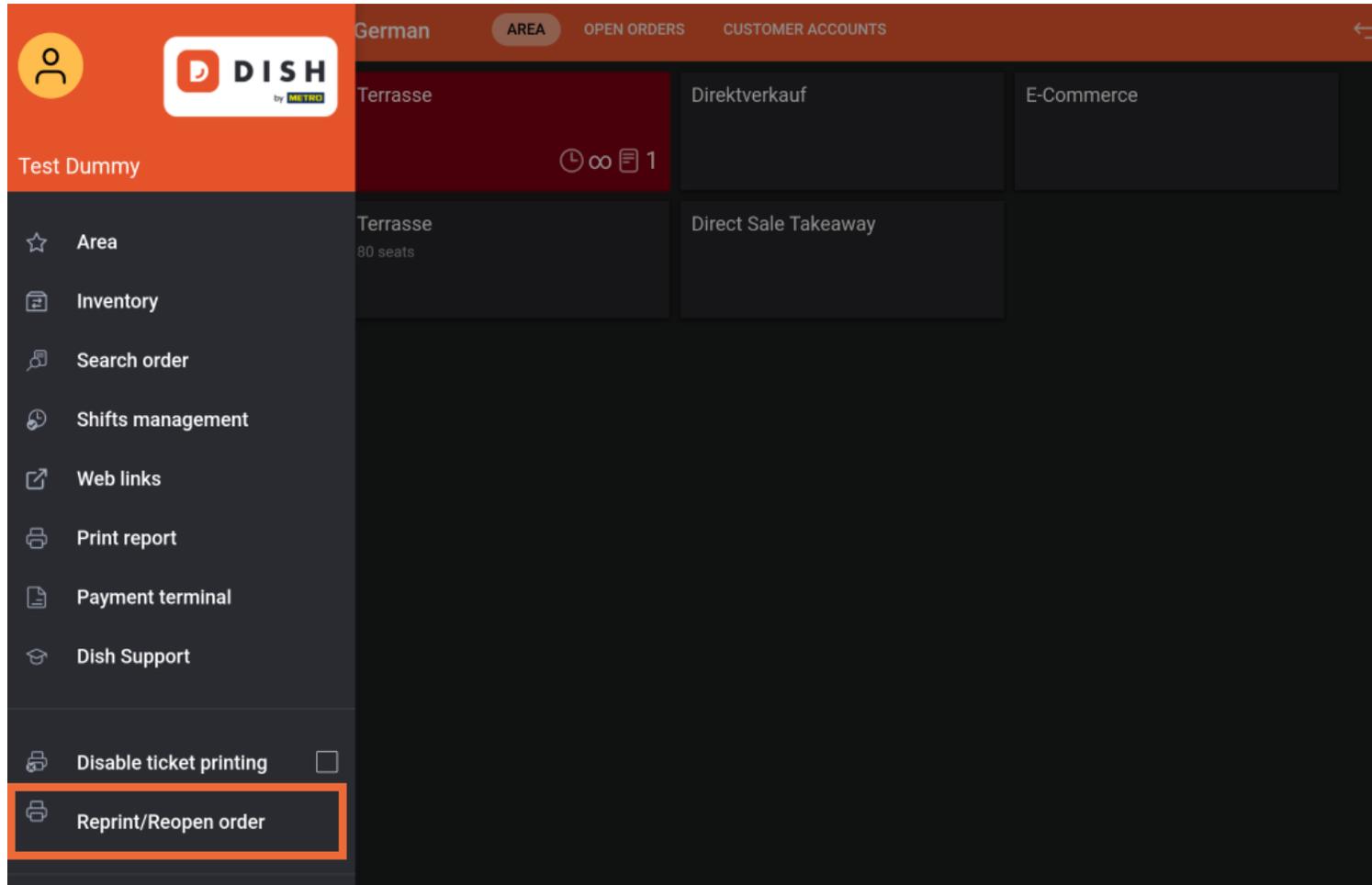




First, click on the **menu icon**.

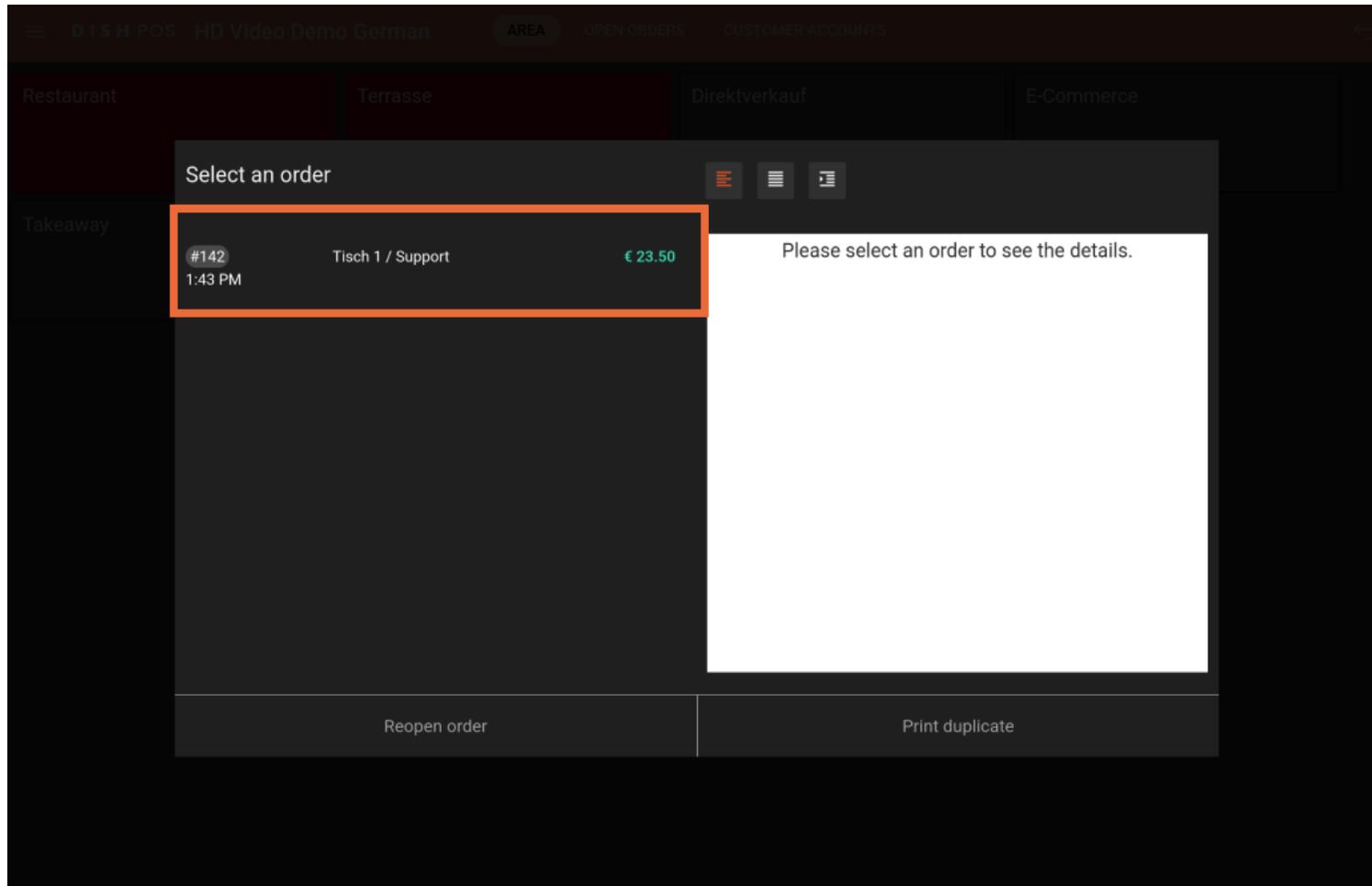


📱 Scroll down and tap **Reprint / Reopen Order**.

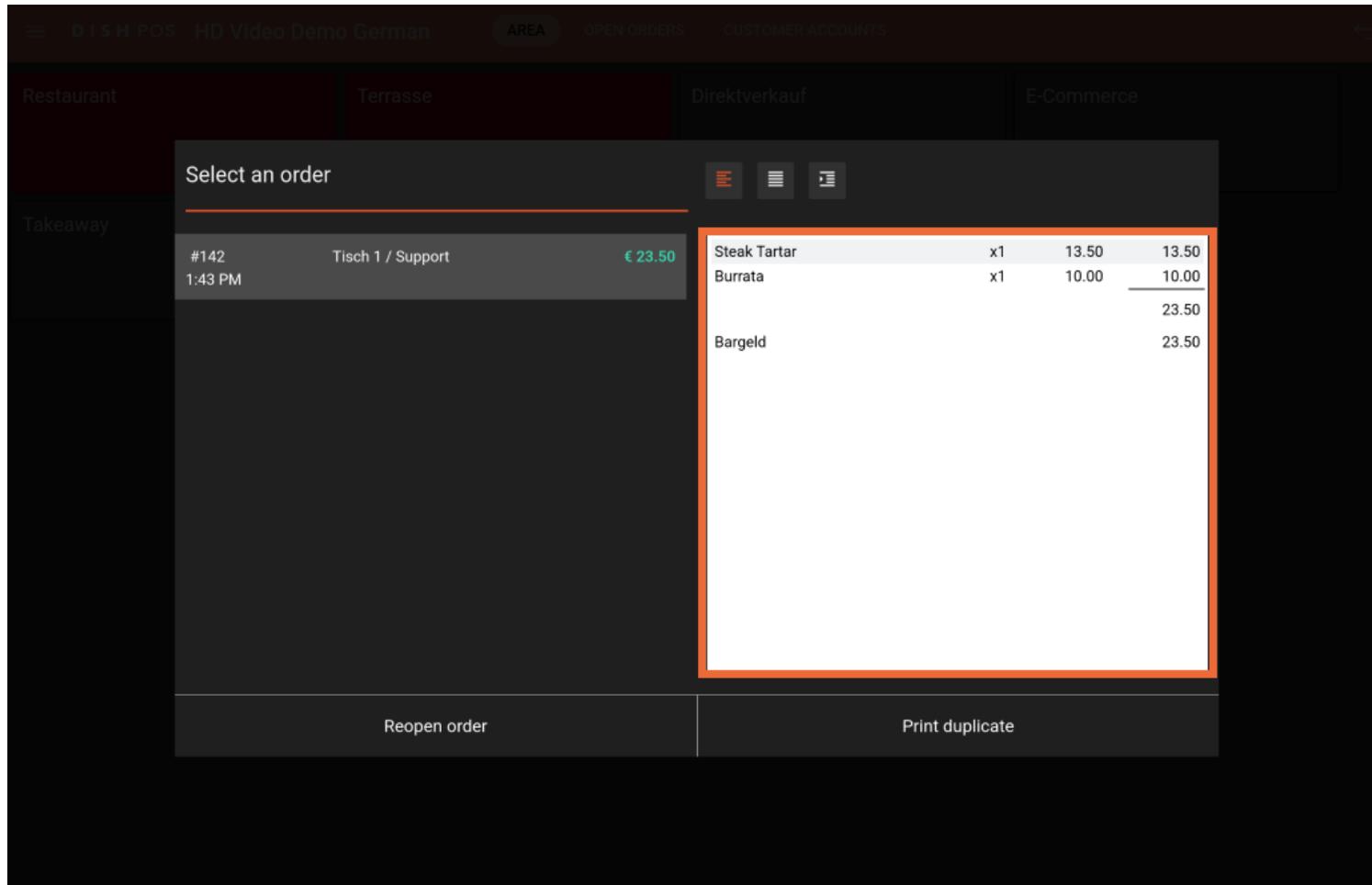




Select the **Order** you want to cancel.

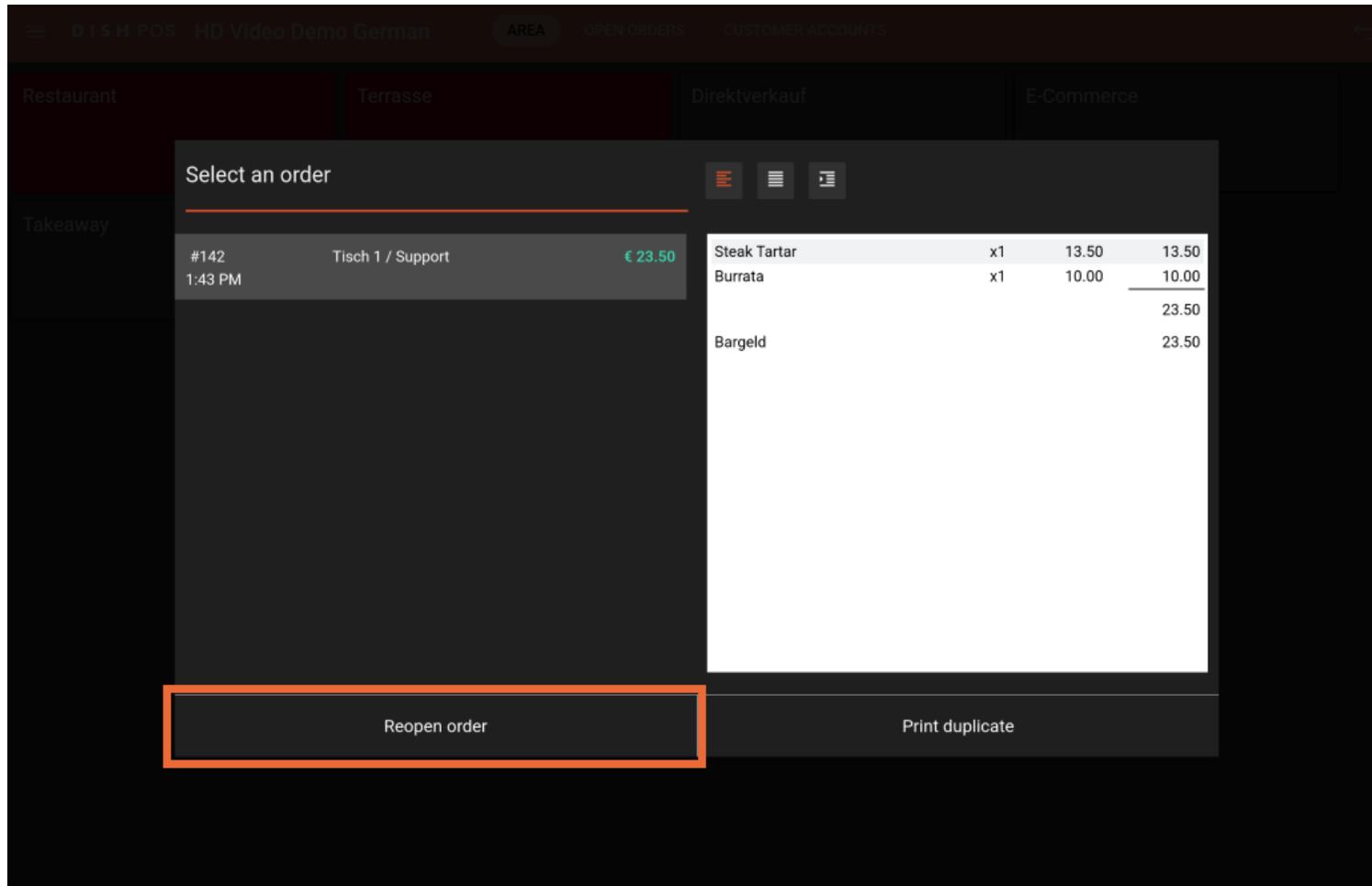


 In the tablet version, a list of all booked items appears in the right area.

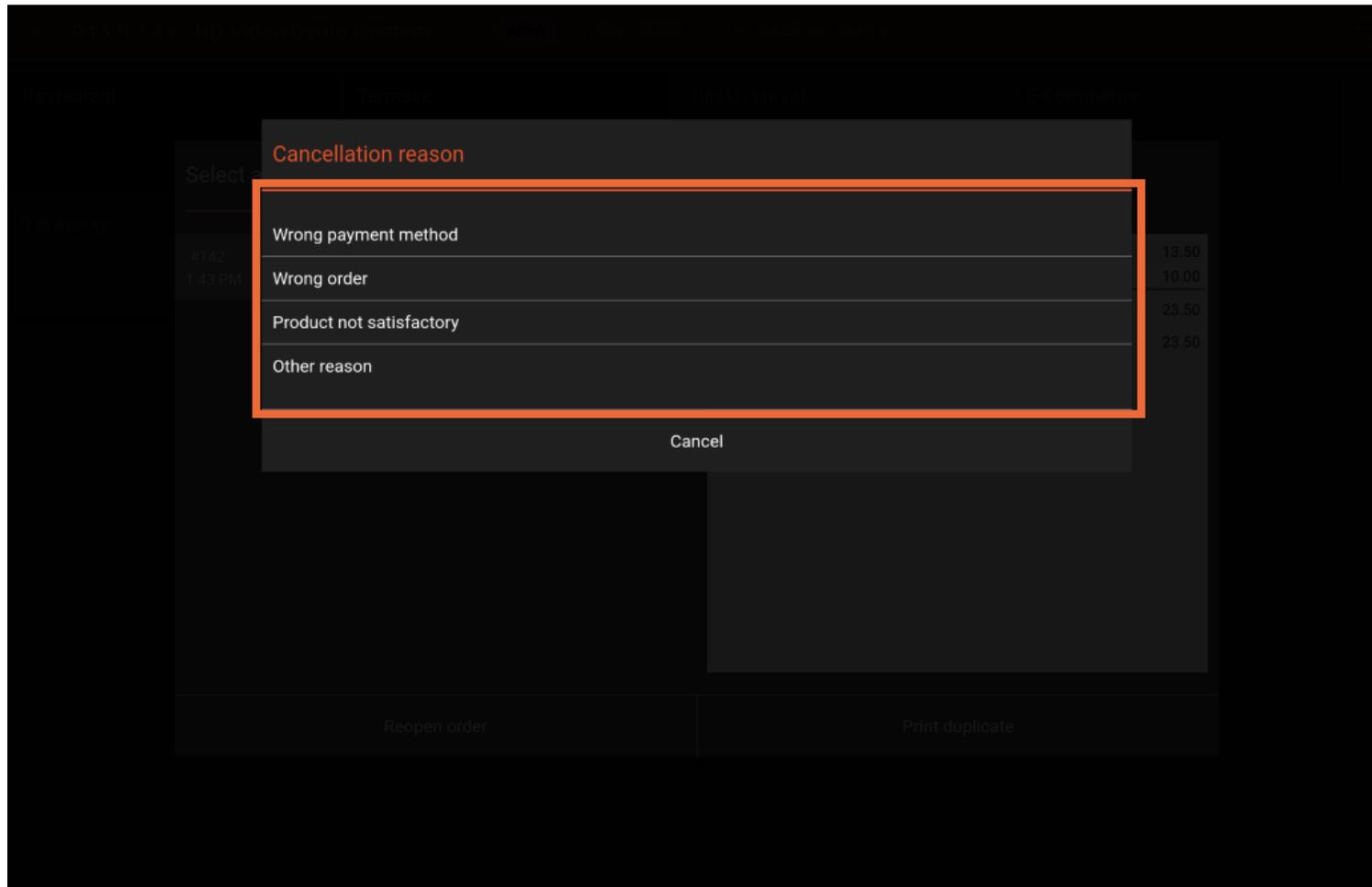




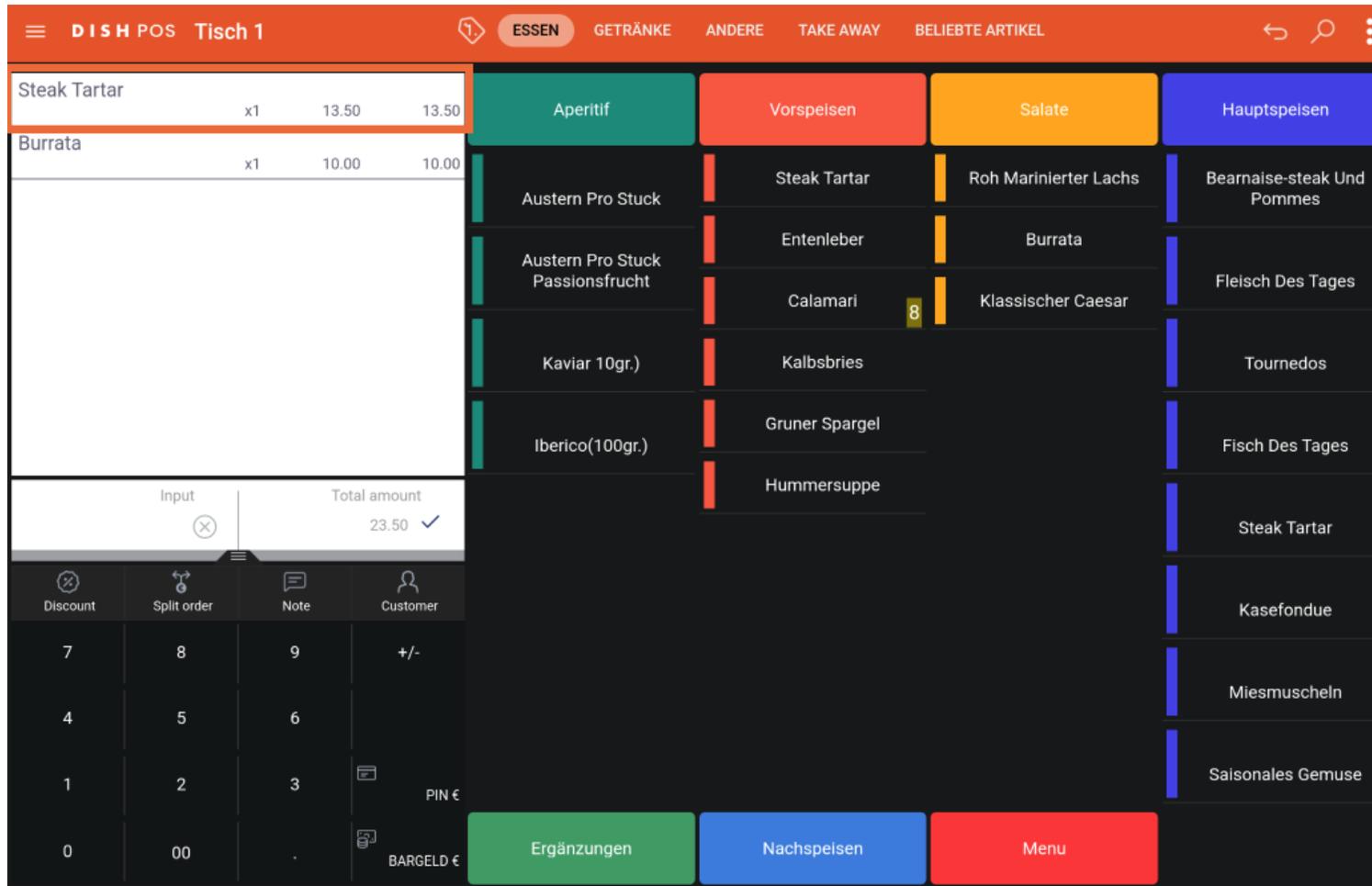
Now click on **Reopen order**.



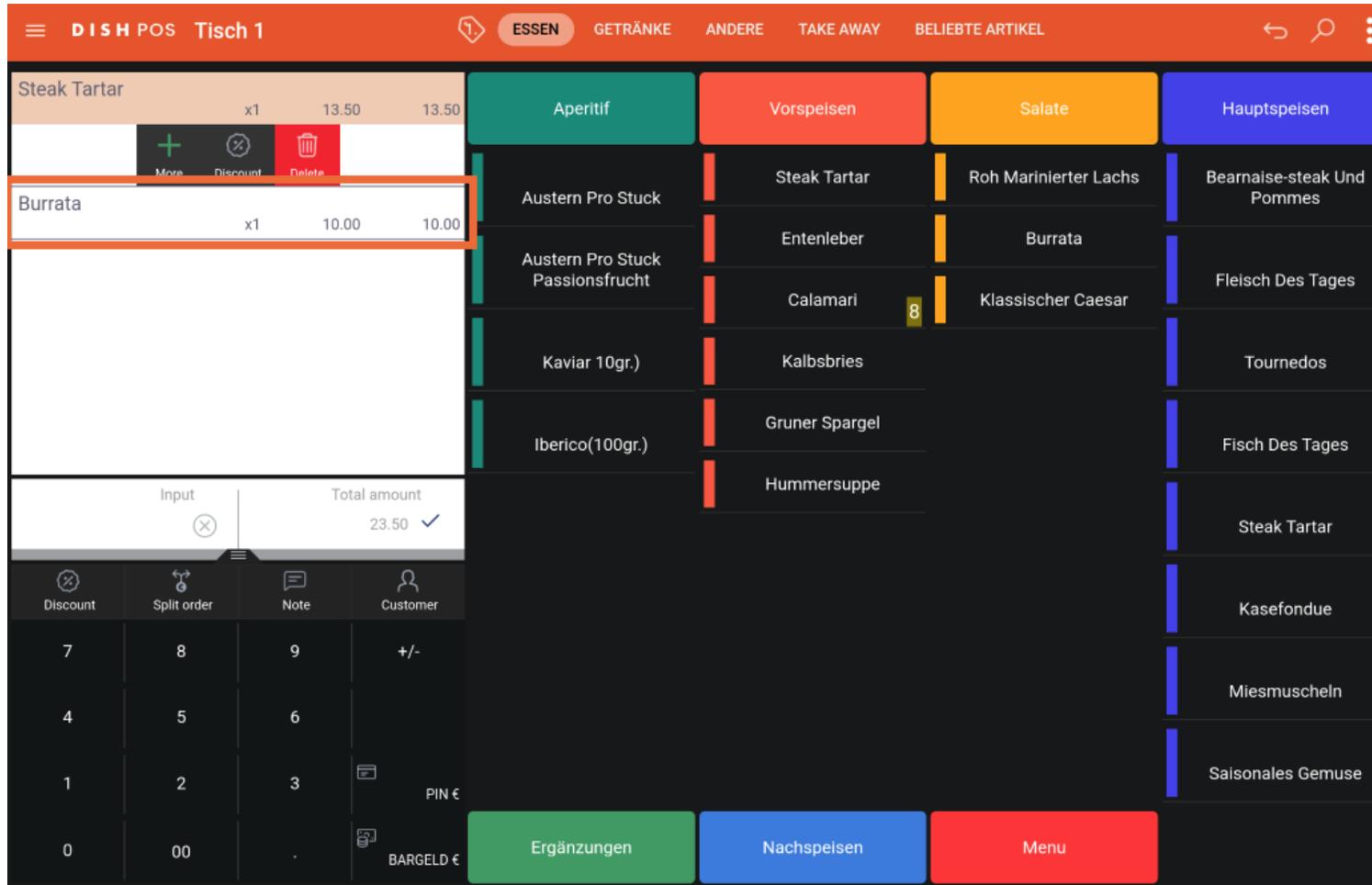
- A window will open from which you can choose a **cancellation reason**. **Note: Select "Other reason" if none of the available three reasons is applicable for you.**



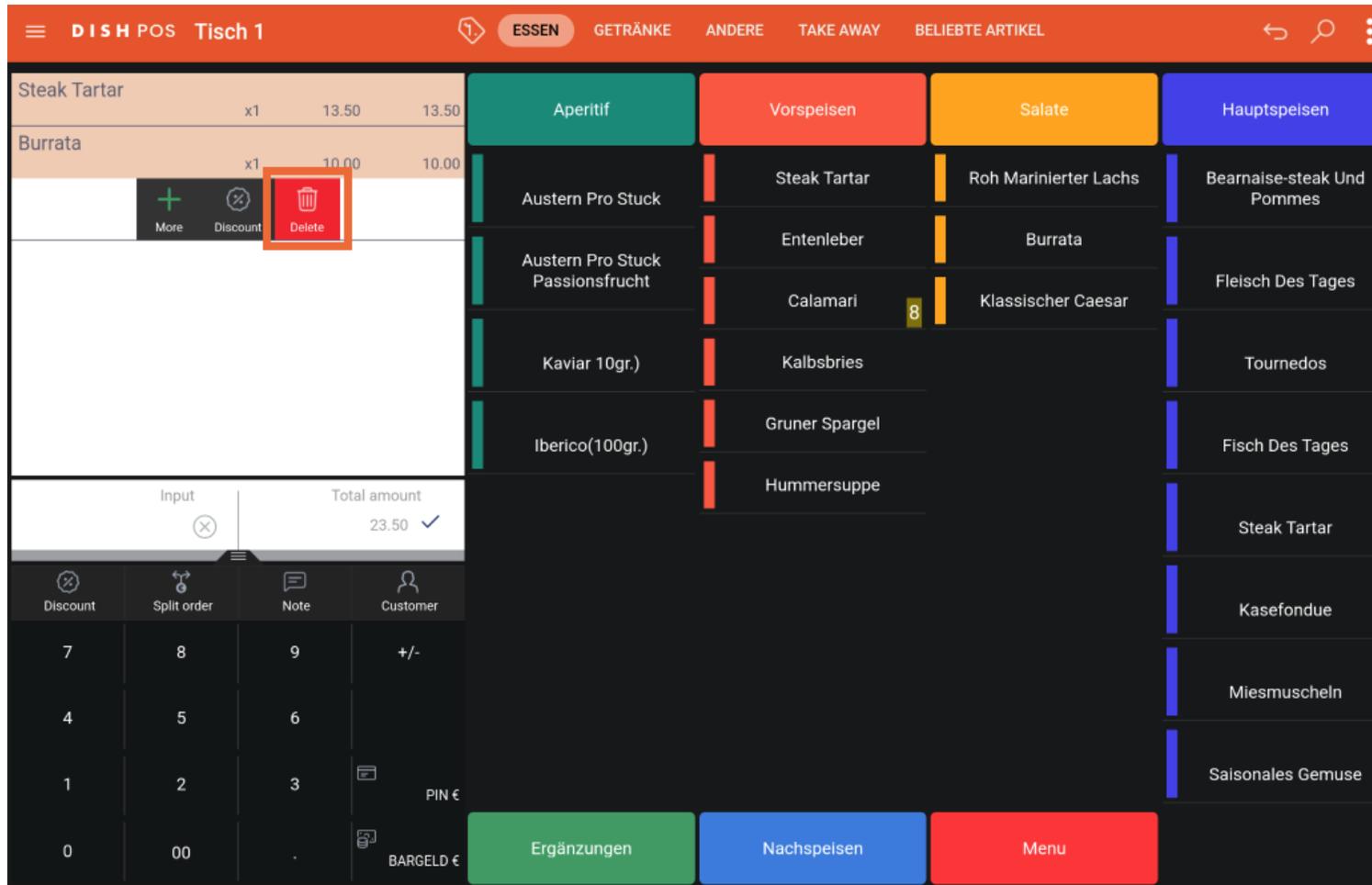
Tap and hold the first article until it is highlighted to delete it.



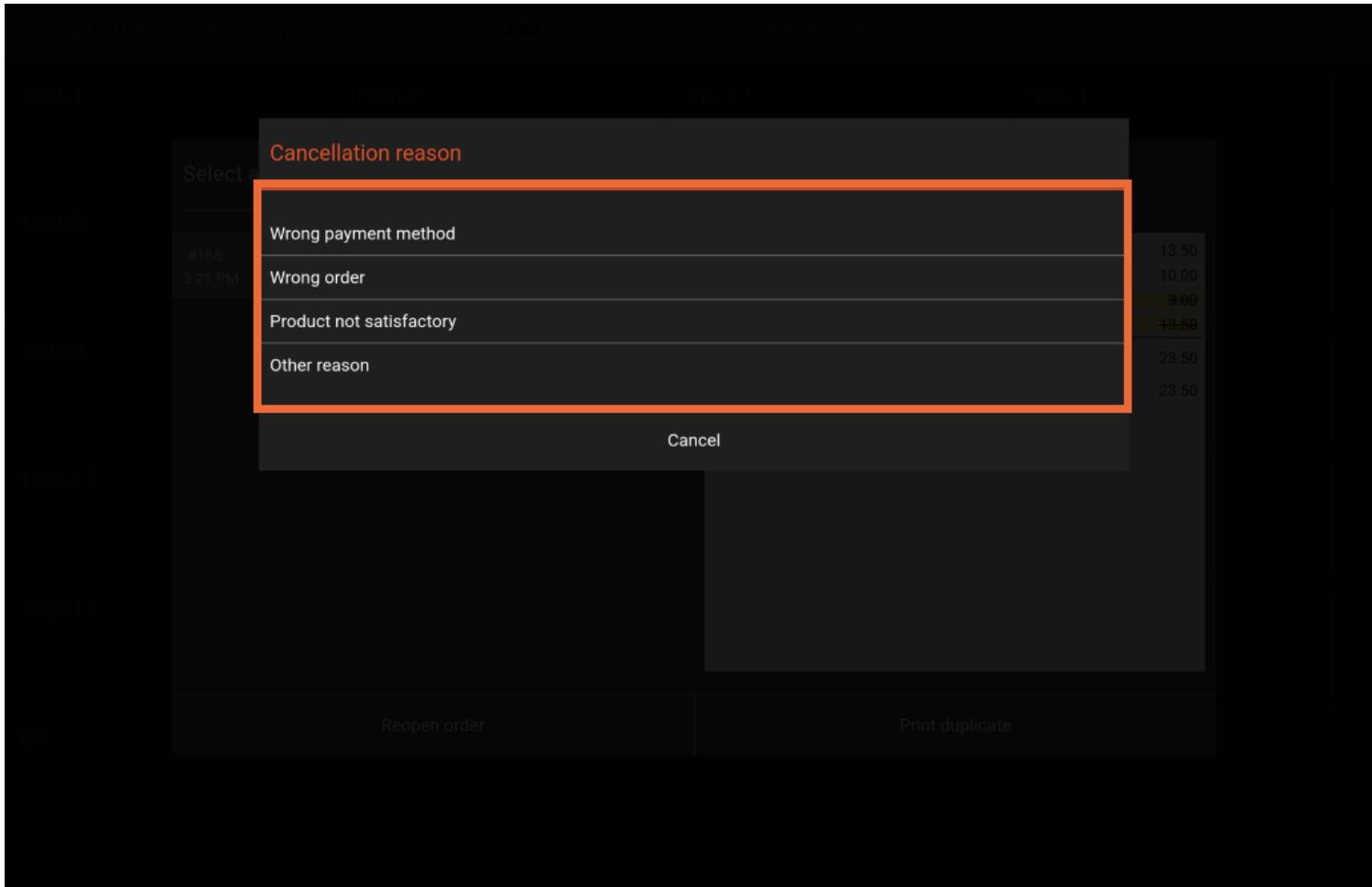
Now mark all the articles you want to delete by simply clicking on them.



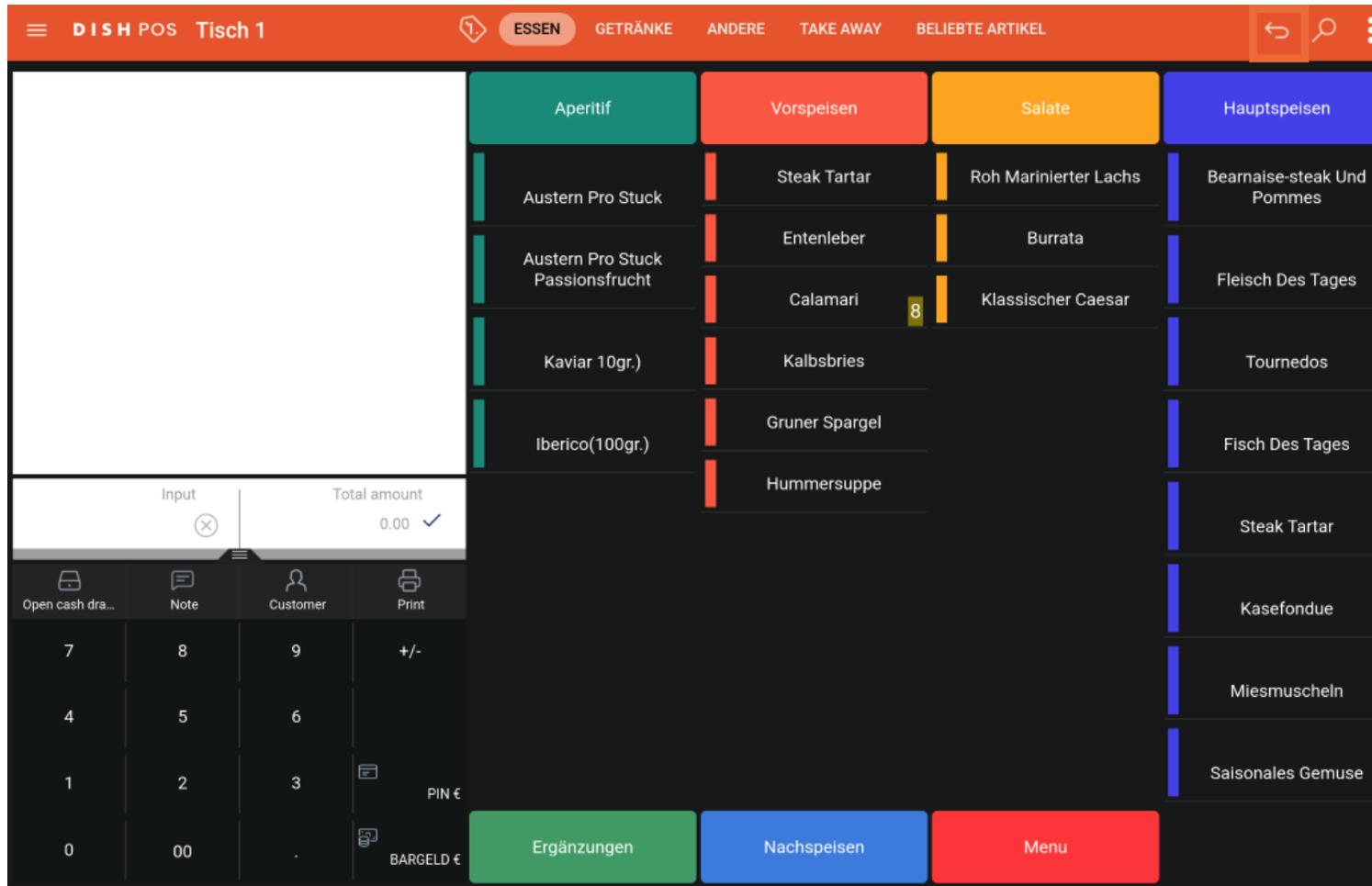
When all items are selected, click on **Delete**.



Here you can select your **cancellation reason**.

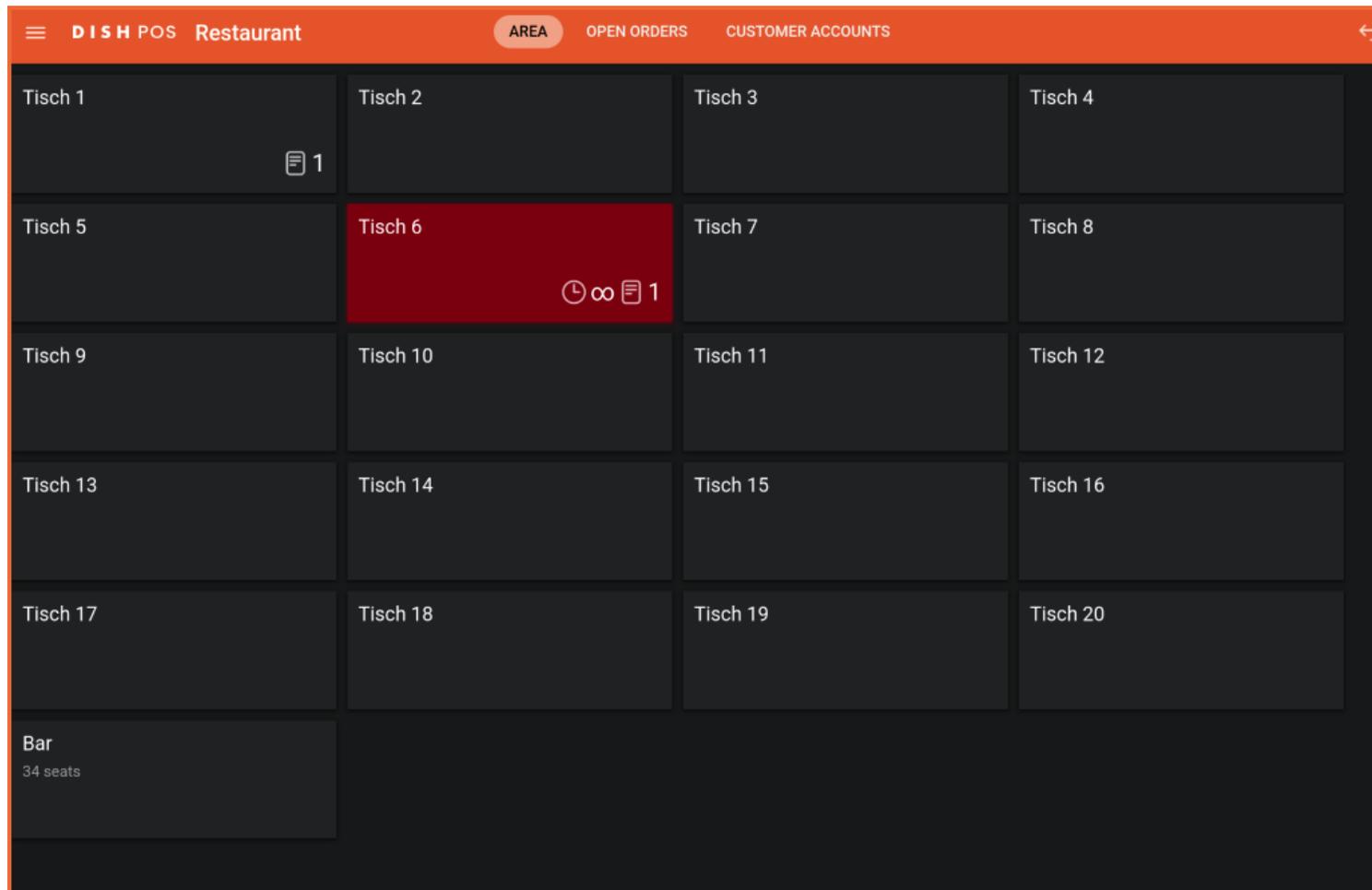


As you can see, the table is now empty. Leave it by clicking on the **back arrow**.

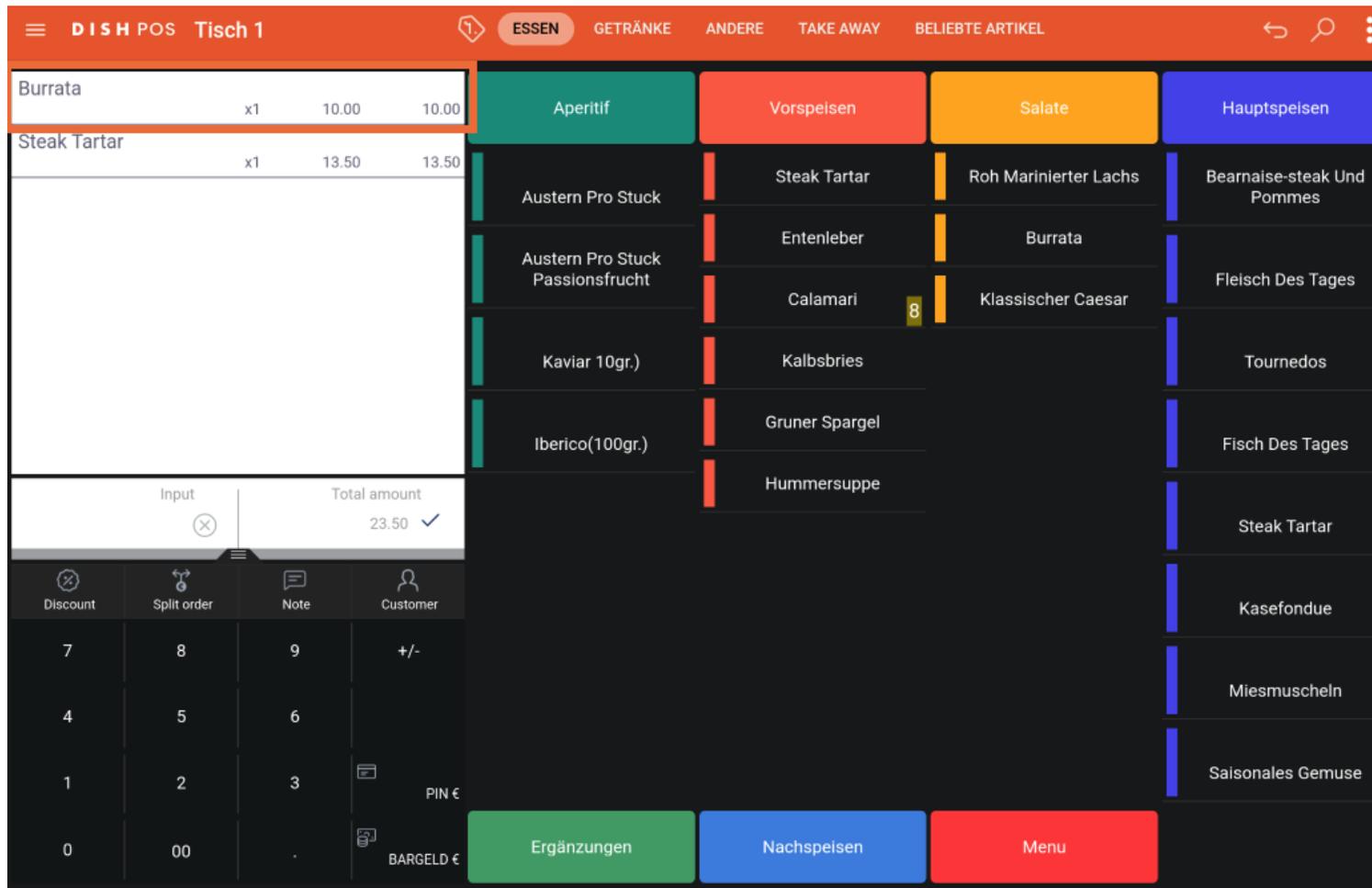




Now your entire order have been cancelled. If you would like to cancel 1 or few items of a certain order, and not the entire order. Please repeat the **steps 2-7** to reopen the order.

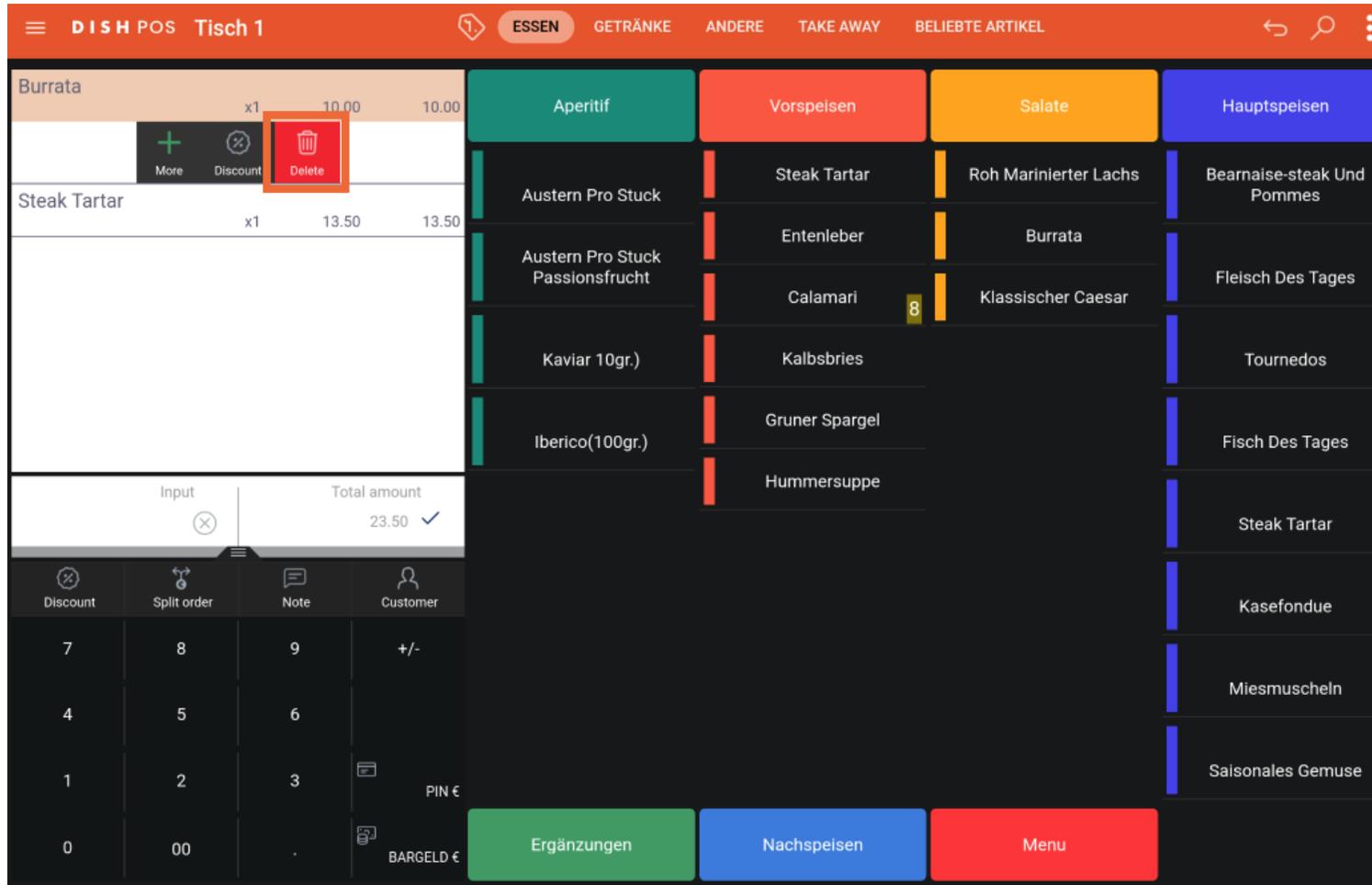


- Once you reopened the order. **Tap** and **hold** the item(s) you want to cancel until it is highlighted to delete it.



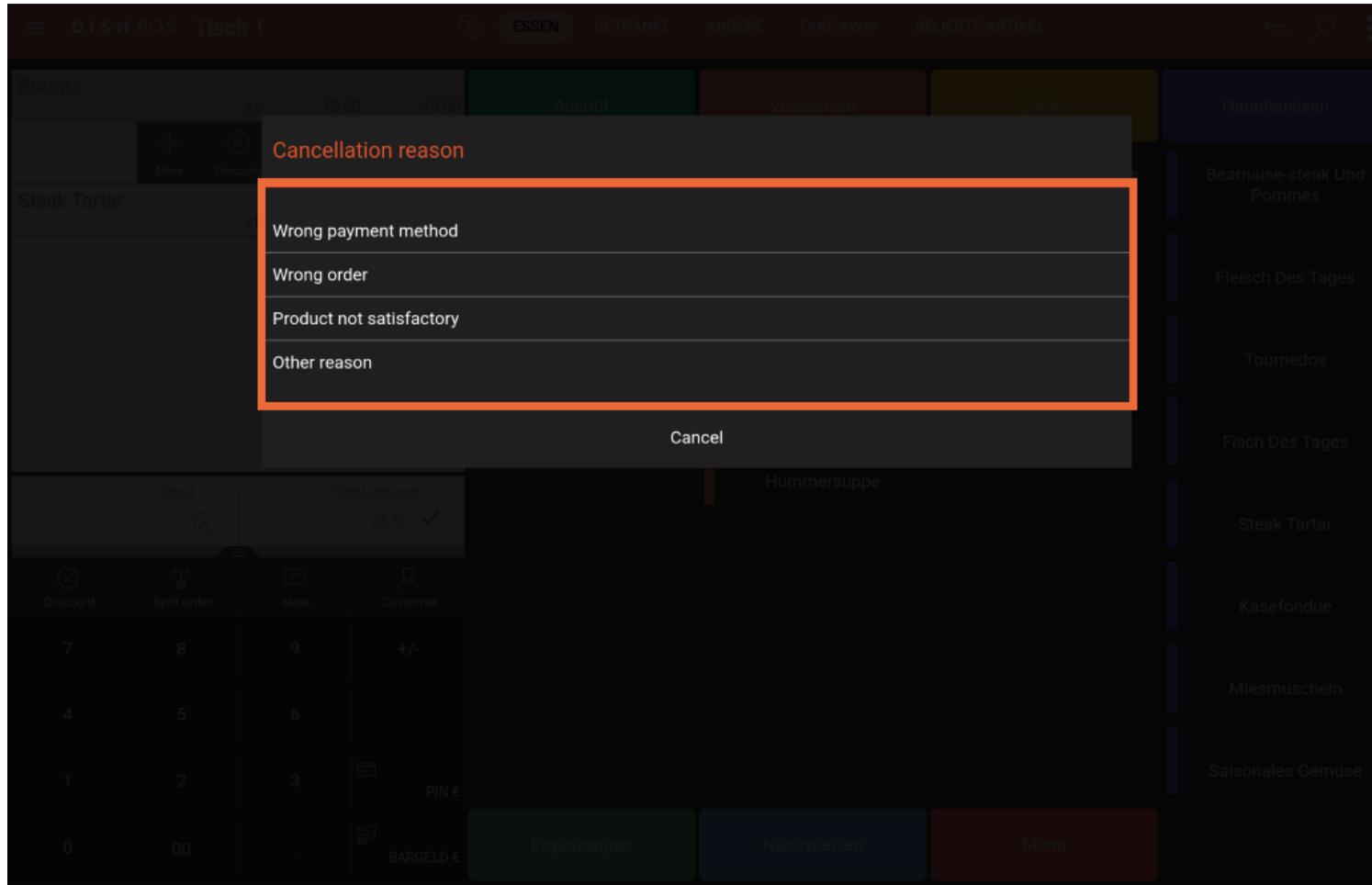

Now, click on **Delete**.

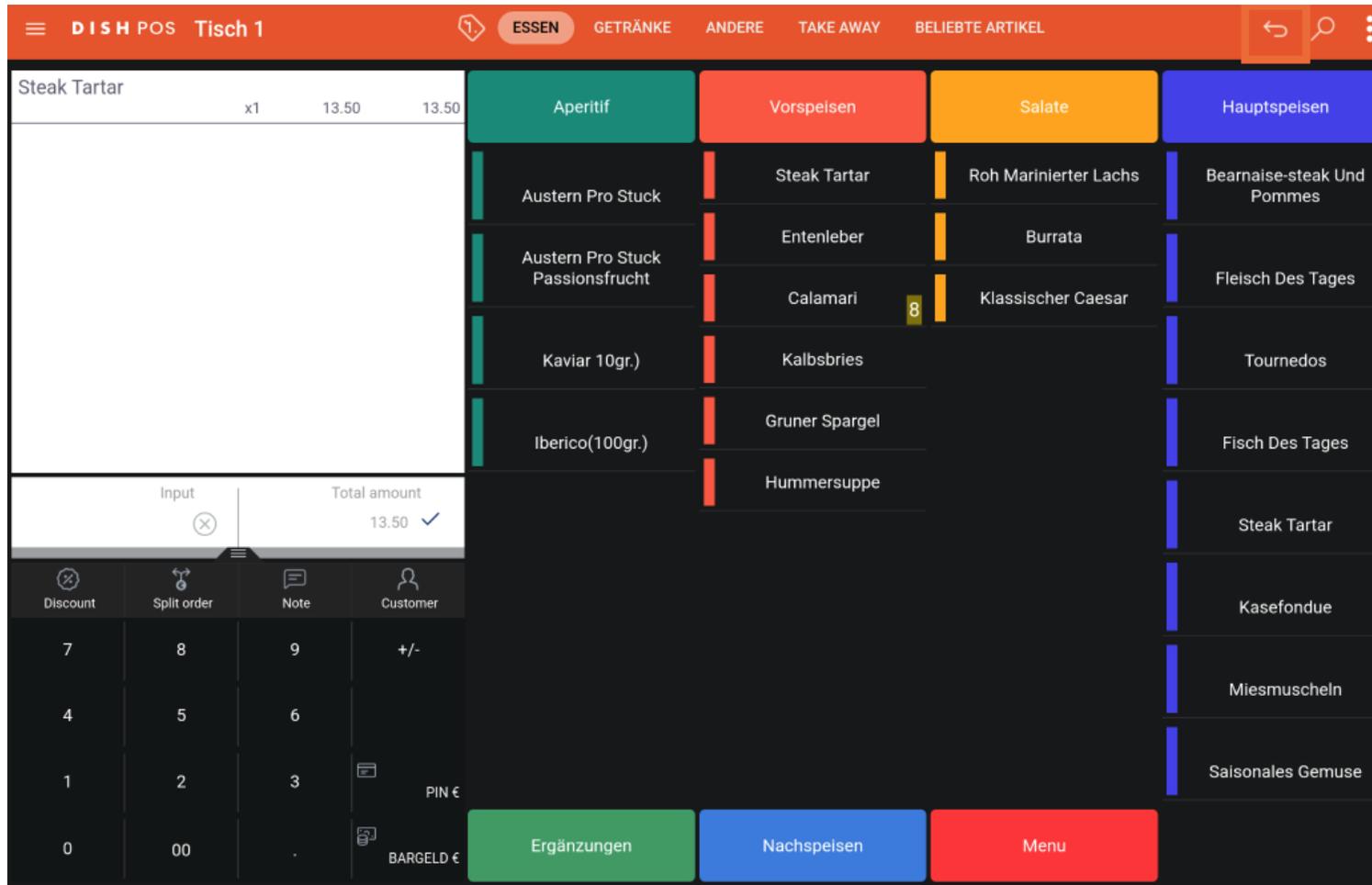




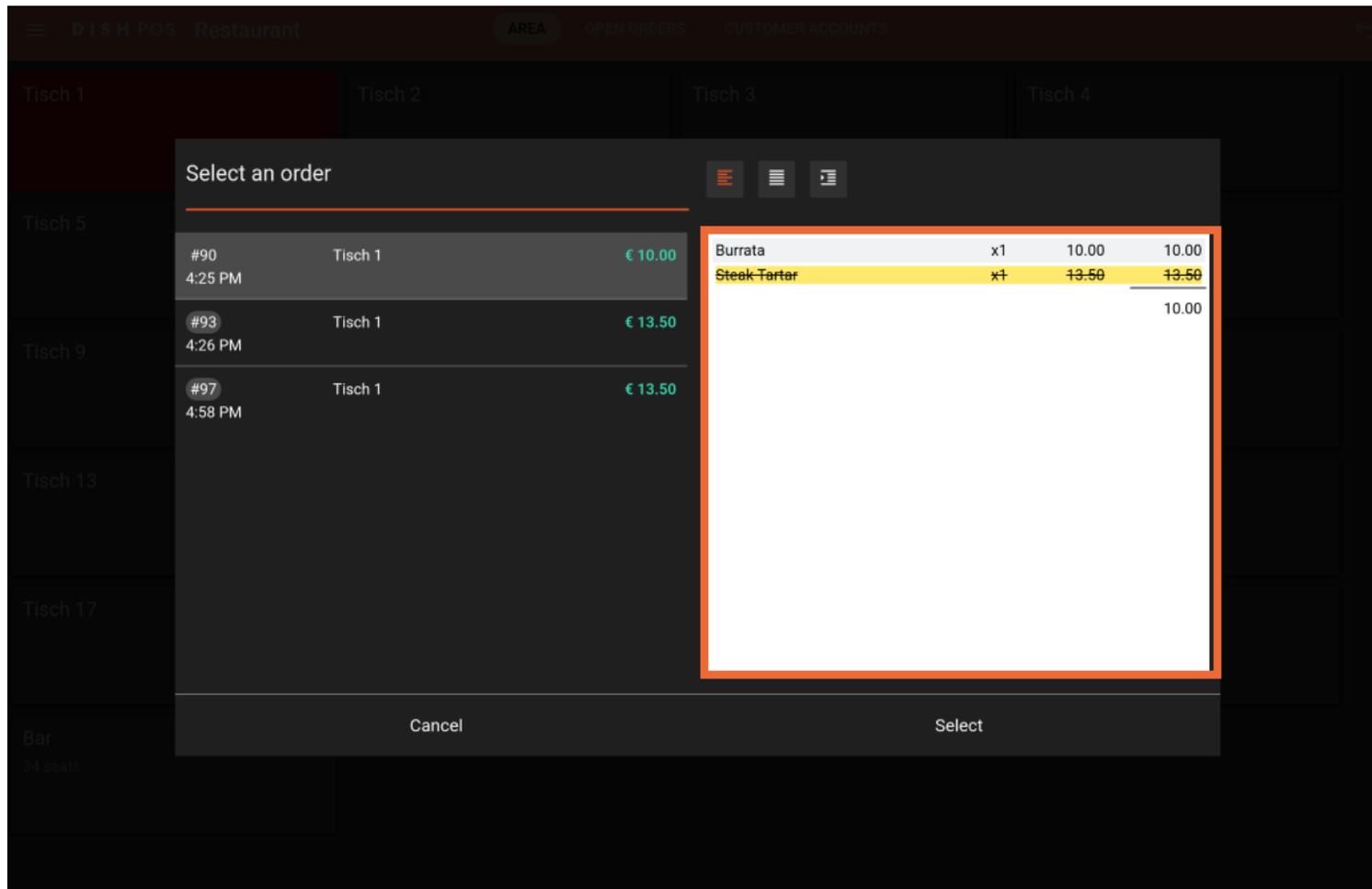
Select your **cancellation reason**.



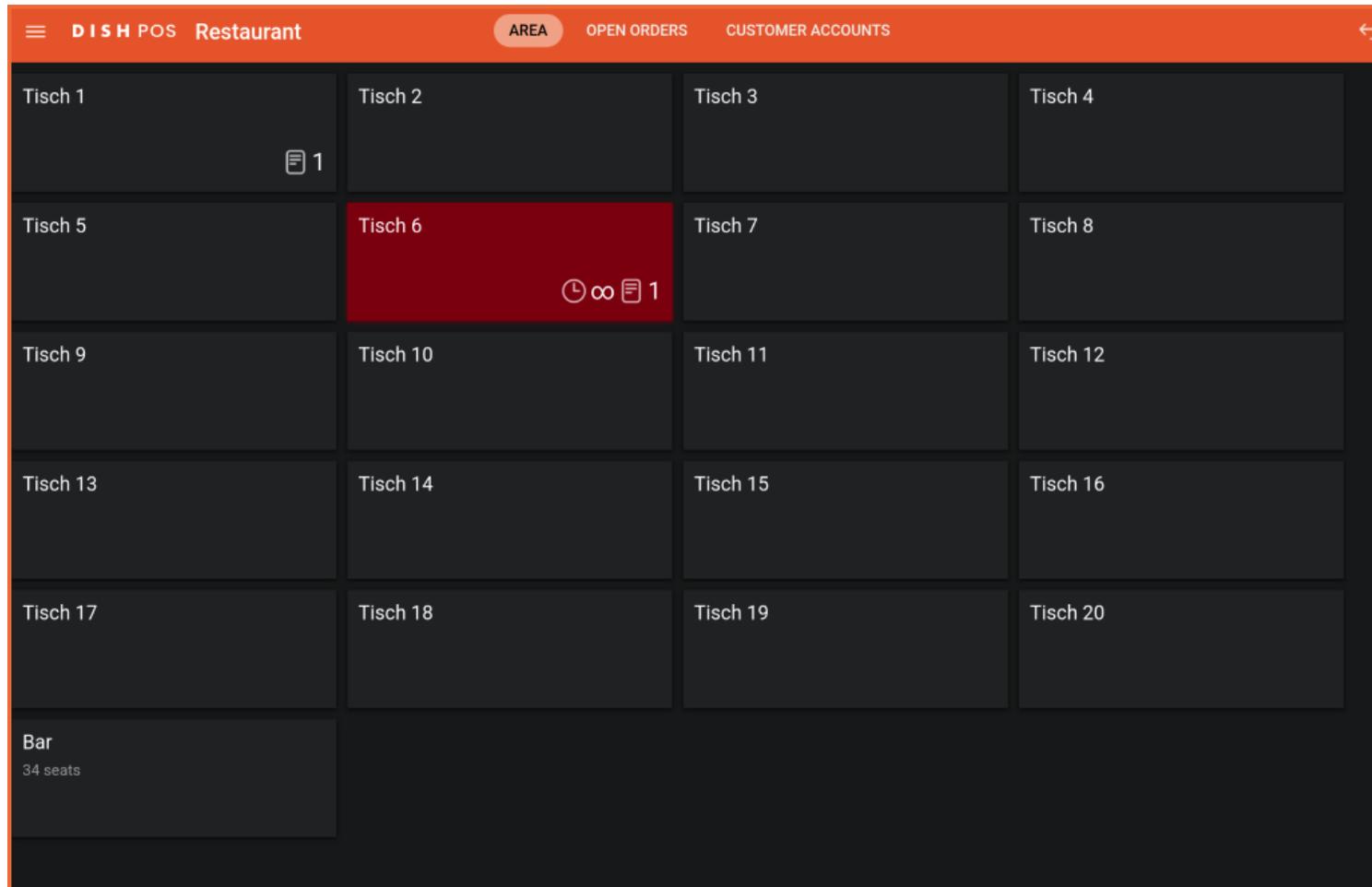
The item has now disappeared from the table. Leave it by clicking on the **back arrow**.
